



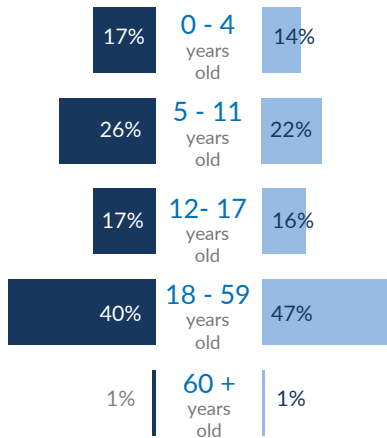

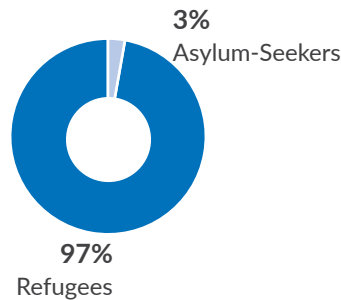

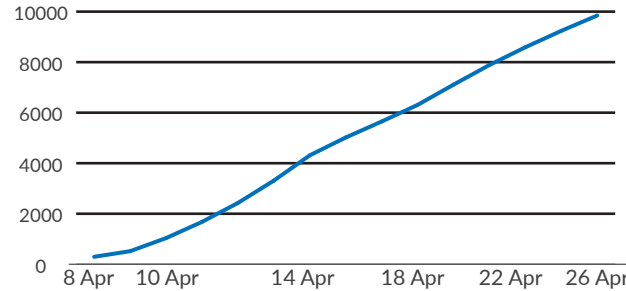

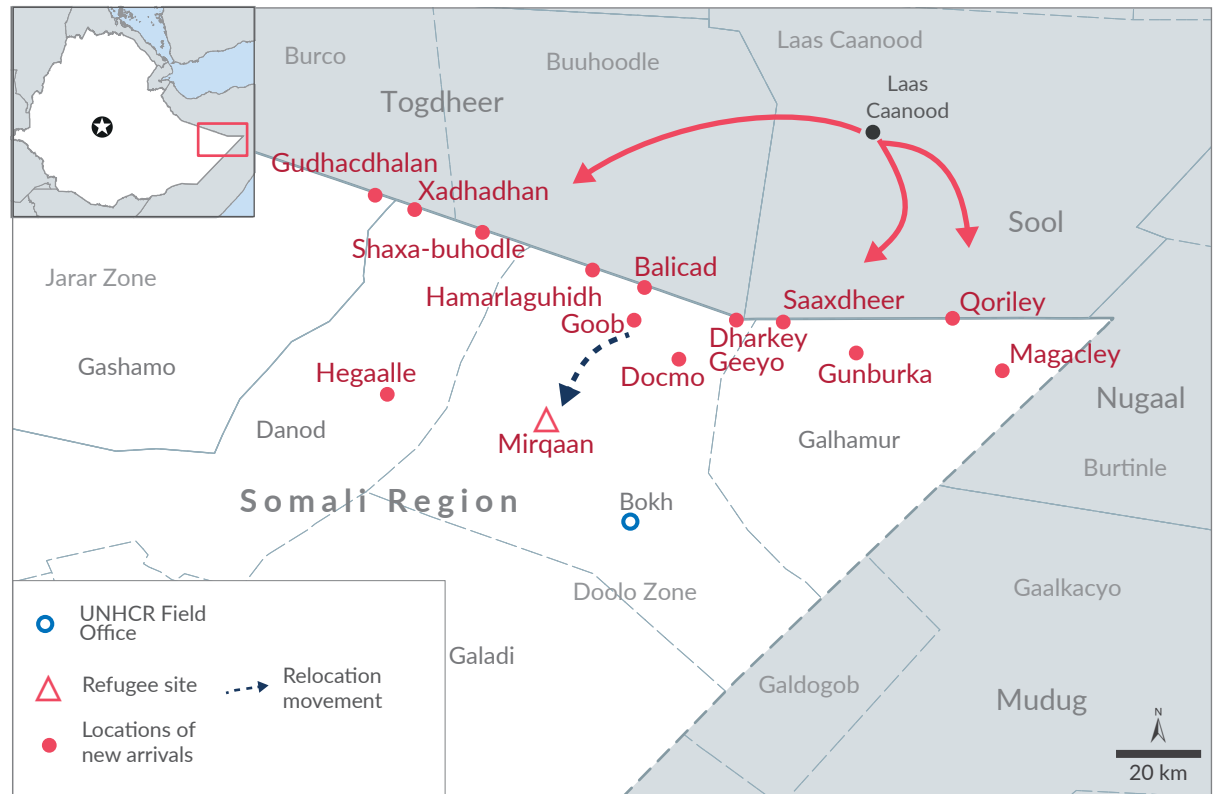
Nationality Screening of Individuals in Mirqaan



Number of people relocated to Mirqaan Settlement (cumulative)

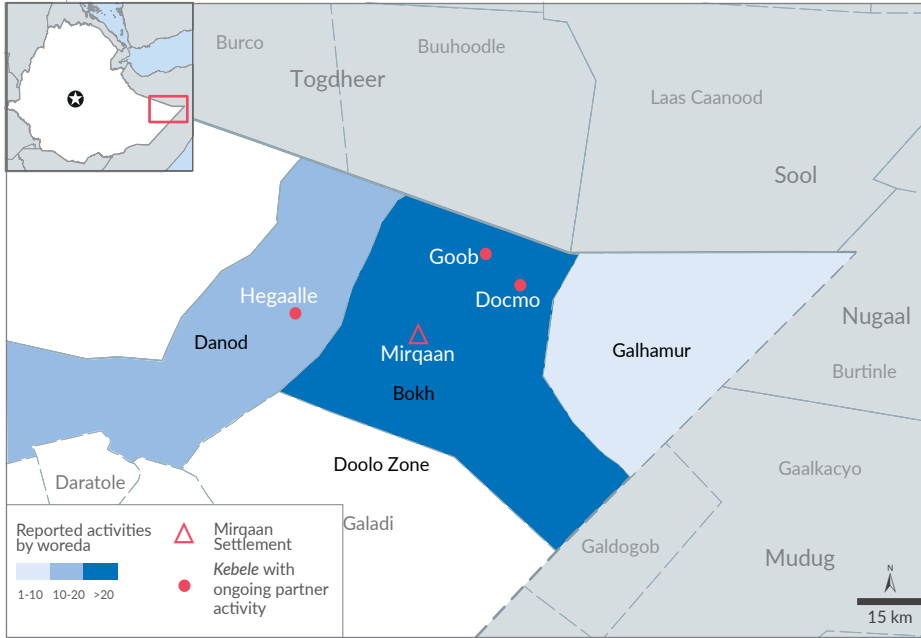


Gender of Head of Household of Relocated People

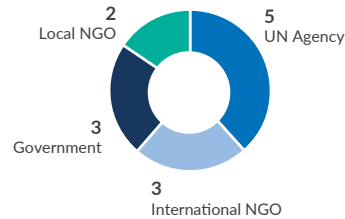
