

Update on UNHCR Activities in Sudan for Refugees

- UNHCR <u>has not forgotten about you</u> and we aim to continue to deliver protection and assistance to you – security and access permitting.
- Due to the ongoing situation, UNHCR is not involved in exit procedures or evacuations of any refugee from Sudan.
- UNHCR continues to be present in Sudan and will continue to provide protection and assistance services to the extent possible.
- Due to the volatility of the situation, UNHCR continues to advise you to shelter in place and not undertake unnecessary movements that could jeopardize your personal safety. If you have fled your location to a safer place, please use the hotline numbers for counseling/information on available services.
- Please remember that in these times, there are many people who might want to take advantage of your situation under the promise of transporting you to safety. These people may charge large amounts of money and transport you through dangerous routes, while also restricting your freedom. UNHCR advises you not to engage with persons offering to illegally transport you to different states or countries, as you might fall victim to exploitation and abuse.

We are unable to meet the cash demands of refugees and asylum-seekers due to the closure of banks and the overall safety situation in the country, which creates dangers around giving and receiving cash for those carrying it. We will continue to work with partners to ensure alternative ways to deliver cash to eligible persons in safety and dignity.

Information on food assistance

Safe access to food for refugees is at the top of UNHCR's priorities. UNHCR is closely working with partners to find possible ways for refugees to safely access food assistance. You will be informed once distribution dates are confirmed.
