



SUDAN: Arrivals from South Sudan | 15 December 2013 – 3 June 2015



Over **157,088** persons have arrived in Sudan from South Sudan

- 88,783 persons have received humanitarian assistance (specific assistance only)
- Sudan hosts an estimated 350,000 Southern Sudanese individuals following the separation of South Sudan from Sudan
- * Abyei PCA Box is estimated to have received 2,496 (IOM)
