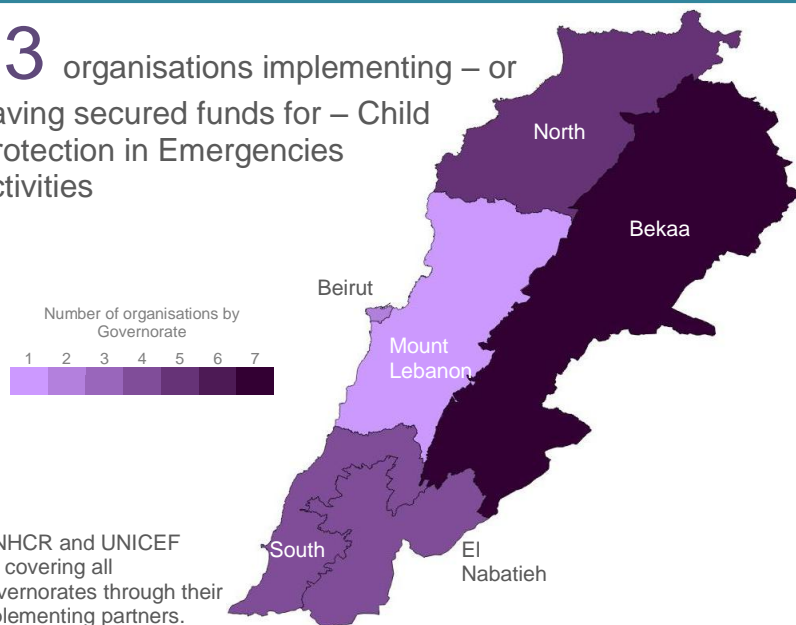

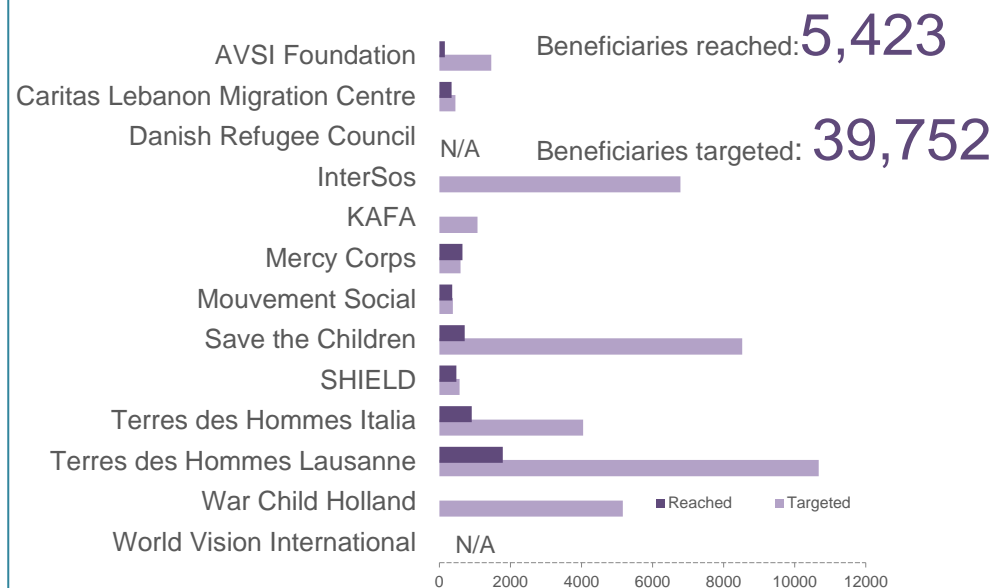

13 organisations implementing – or having secured funds for – Child Protection in Emergencies activities



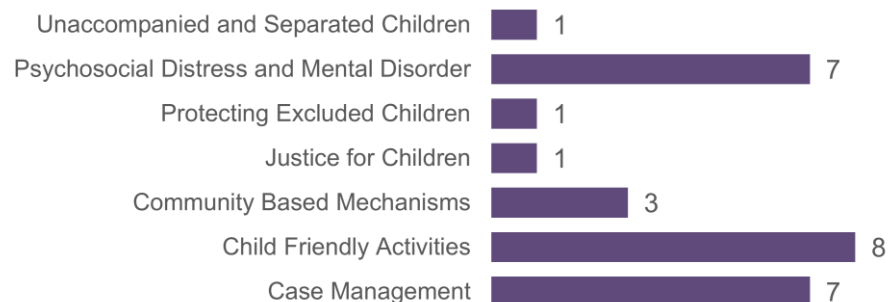
Targeted and reached beneficiaries by organisation (ongoing and planned activities)

- **372,902** Most vulnerable host community

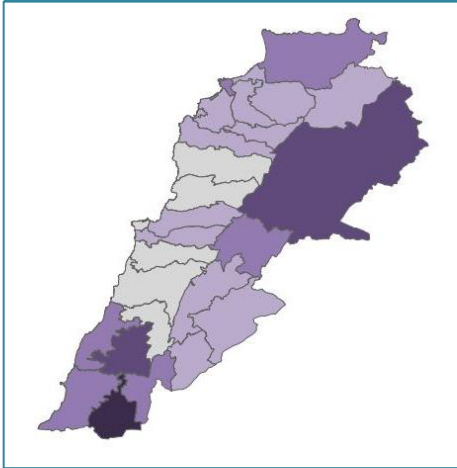
Number of organisations by domain of activity



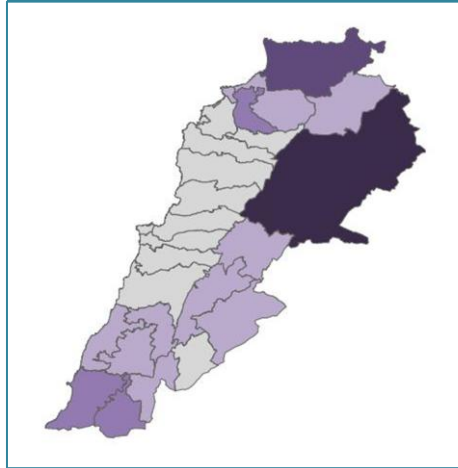

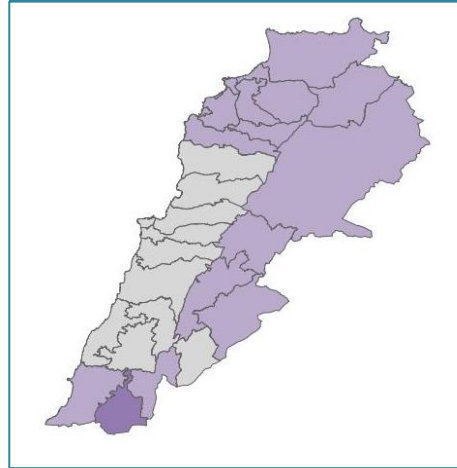

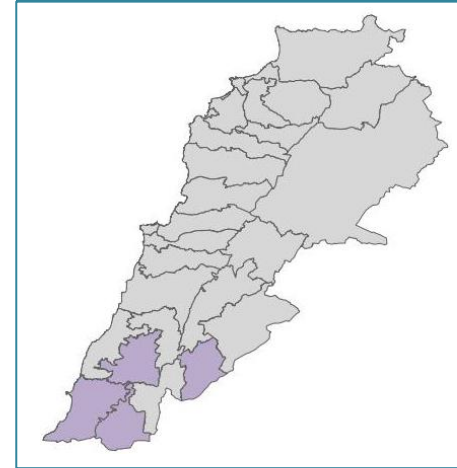
Organisations implementing activities in Child Friendly Activities



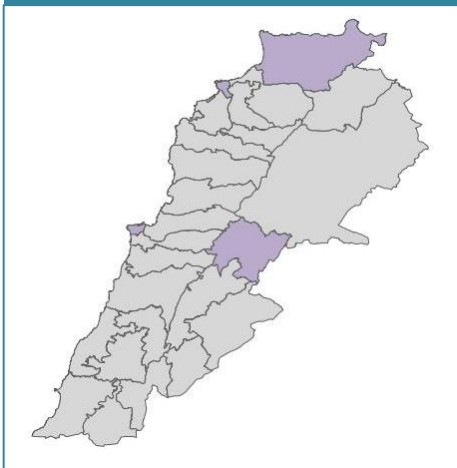
Organisations implementing activities in Community Based Management



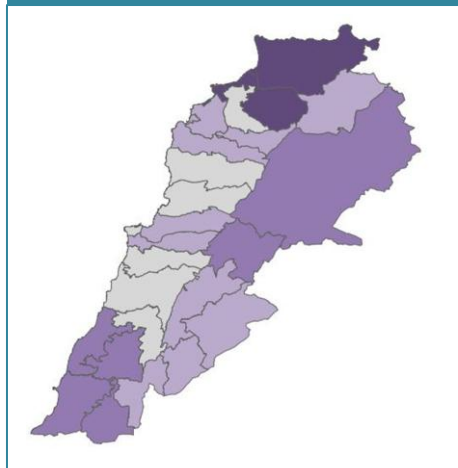
