

Situation Update: Unaccompanied Children (UAC) in Greece

2,000 Estimated number of UAC currently in Greece based on analysis from referrals to EKKA (as of 17 March 2017)


1,352 Total number of places available in UAC shelters (filled, pending assigned cases as of 17 March, including 90 vacant places in the process to be filled)

891 Total number of UAC on waiting list for shelter (as of 17 March) including:
•130 in Reception and Identification Centers
•18 in protective custody

Waiting list does not include referrals of unknown location carried out during pre-registration exercise. Waiting list includes also separated children.

5,976 Total number of UAC referrals to EKKA from 1 Jan 2016 to 17 March 2017. Out of the total: •5,505 boys (92%) •471 girls (8%) •394 <14 years old (7%)

Figures dynamically change and may be adjusted based on verification by EKKA.




Number of places available in UAC shelters (filled, pending assigned cases) vs.


Numbers of additional requests for placement on waiting list

Number of UAC placed in Protective custody/Reception and Identification Centers 11 July 2016 – 17 March 2017 (based on requests by referral agents)



*Referrals from open facilities are carried out by referral agents including Asylum Service, NGOs, INGOs, Public Prosecutors.


