1. Katsikas – Non formal and Formal Education	Arsis with REC have already started mapping – not finalized yet; there is a paediatrician that would like to volunteer but not confirmed yet. In Katsikas Habibi Works and second tree is supporting the refugee community of Katsikas which has established an educational programme (mother tongue classes – Arabic, Farsi, Sorani –maths and sport activities) Nevertheless there is an important issue with the lack of available space. The refugee community does not want to use the two community buildings (one is used as CFS and the other for community activities) All volunteer teachers of the community school were previously school teachers/ educators in their own countries. There is need for stationery items and for suitable educational books (mother tongue, math)

Update on continuation of non- formal educational activities – overview by sites and urban accommodation	 Update on continuation of non-formal educational activities – overview by sites and urban accommodation Second Tree volunteers: In Agia Eleni and Community Centre Second tree provides English classes to 148 students) – Classes have stopped for Konitsa and Doliana. There are conversations with ARSIS for Katsikas. 7 UASC accommodated in the Safe Zone are enrolled in formal education In Agia Eleni there are in total 20 children, including high school, pending to be enrolled in formal education. This include mostly new arrivals In Doliana ARSIS coordinates with REC for every important issue that arises. Kindergarten is fully operating in Doliana At the moment there are Greek classes for adults provided by municipality workers ARSIS most probably will be fully operating by the 15th of March. The plan is to prioritise Doliana and Katsikas
