### Construction of transitional shelters

#### **NGUENYYIEL CAMP**

- 820 shelters completed
- 1,442 shelters under construction
- 644 shelters completed
- 266 shelters under construction

#### **PUGNIDO CAMP**

- 190 shelters completed in Pugnido I
- 190 shelters completed in Pugnido II

#### **OKUGO CAMP**

- 421 shelters completed
- 563 shelters under construction



# Construction of emergency shelters

#### **NGUENYYIEL CAMP:**

- 4,829 shelters completed 1500 emergency shelters completed
- 1352 Emergency shelters frames from 2016 were covered with plastic sheets
- Other routine maintenance for 700 emergency shelters were completed within the first quarter of 2017

#### **OKUGO CAMP:**

1,140 shelters completed

### **Shelter Strategy**

 National Shelter Strategy 2017-2020 designed based on a country-wide Shelter Needs Assessment conducted in March-April 2017.

#### Shelter and site planning standards for South Sudanese refugees

- Emergency shelter composing of rectangular shaped wooden structures, covered with plastic sheeting/tarpaulin.
- Transitional shelter composing of rectangular or square shaped stone
  masonry foundation walls, bedded in cement mortar. External walls and
  partition made of mud brick walls un-plastered. Internal partition wall with door.
  One entrance door with an improved lock (lockable from in-/outside) and two
  lockable windows. Roof with eucalyptus wood truss, covered internally with
  plastic sheets externally covered with thatch.



## Challenges

#### **COMMUITY ENGAGEMENT:**

 Grass collection, roof thatching and wall mudding is dependent on refugee participation, which can be challenging. Dedicated community mobilizers have been assigned to encourage and follow-up on participation.

#### **INFLUX:**

 The sudden closure of Pagak, required a rapid re-focusing on emergency needs in Waat Gach and Pamdong to support relocations to Nguenyyiel.

#### **SHELTER STRATEGY:**

The ongoing preparation of guidelines per field location for the implementation of the Shelter Strategy will impact planning during Q1 2018.





# **Moving Forward 2018**

#### **NGUENYYIEL CAMP:**

- Construction of 9,500 transitional shelters
- Prepositioning of 6,700 emergency shelters
- Maintenance of transitional shelters

#### TIERIKIDI REFUGEE CAMP:

Maintenance of 1,500 transitional shelters



### **Moving Forward 2018**

#### **PUGNIDO CAMPS:**

- Construction of 800 transitional shelters in Pugnido I
- Construction of 700 transitional shelters in Pugnido II
- Construction of 800 transitional shelters

#### **OKUGO CAMP:**

- Construction of 1,000 transitional shelters
- Maintenance of transitional shelters
