





Cardiovascular disease Ischaemic heart disease During the month of June, Hypertension constituted for 34% of all chronic consultations, a slight decrease in comparison to the month of May, but still higher than previous months. Diabetes consultations have slightly decreased compared to the previous month. Proportions of asthma consultations increased from 13% in May to 19% in June. Trends in chronic health conditions vary due to clinic accessibility challenges. Management of chronic diseases requires regular periodic visits to monitor diseases and evaluate therapeutic outcomes, which necessitates enhanced accessibility of those morbid


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
