The ESWG coordinator updated the group on school enrolment and the organization around the different programmes.

Important highlights regarding the new school year:

- The ministerial decision on DYEP included all islands. The exact dates for opening will be announced later.
- Some children living in Open Accommodation Sites who attended DYEP during the last school year may attend morning schools this year.
- MOE and IOM are preparing to start transporting children from some Open Accommodation Sites to morning schools starting from next week.
- This year, morning reception classes (ZEP) will be available for selected senior high schools.

Greek schools started September 11th,. If you encounter issues, please flag to us to see if we might be able to support your efforts.
