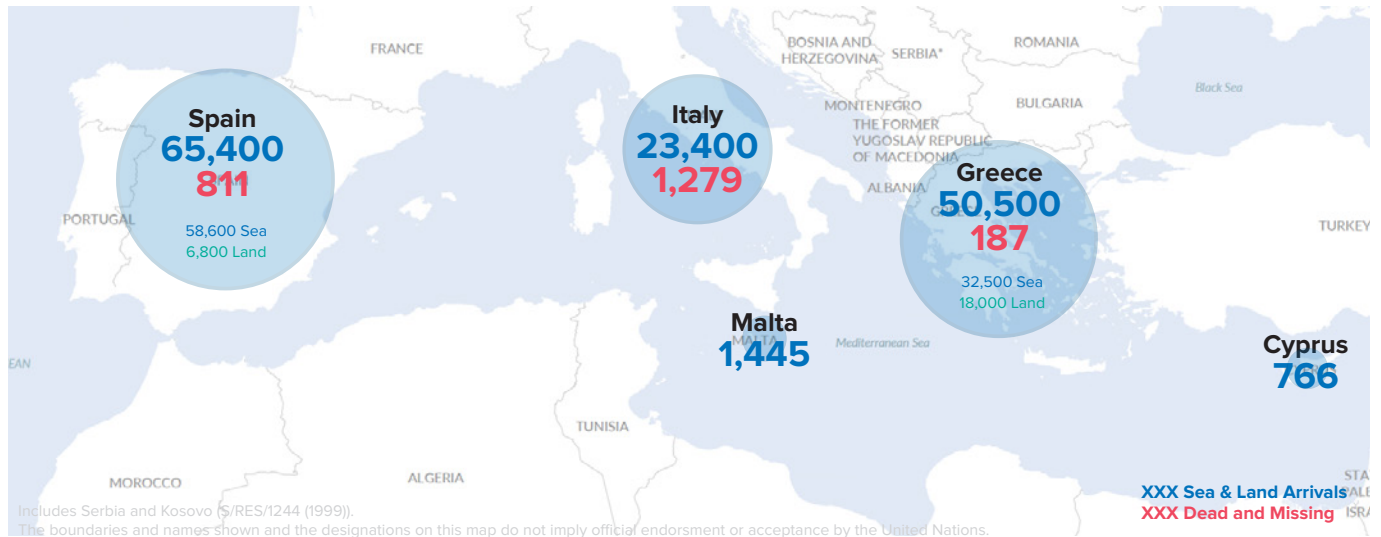

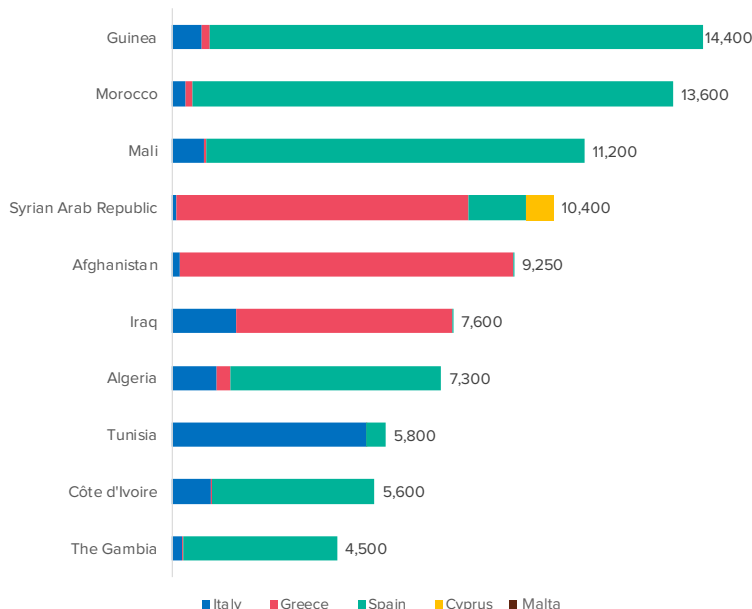

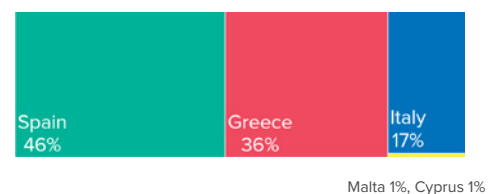

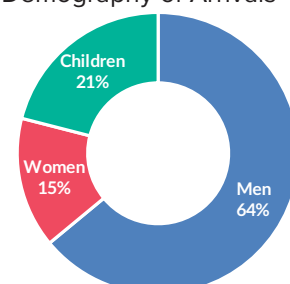
Most common nationalities of Mediterranean arrivals 2018¹

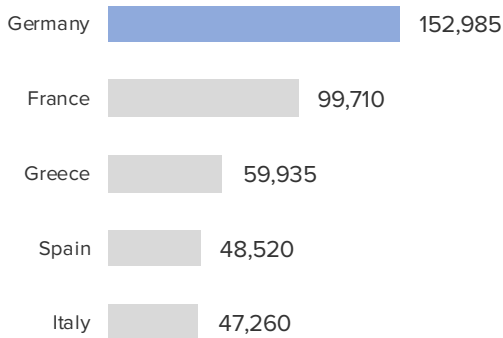
New Asylum Applications in EU+ countries in 2018

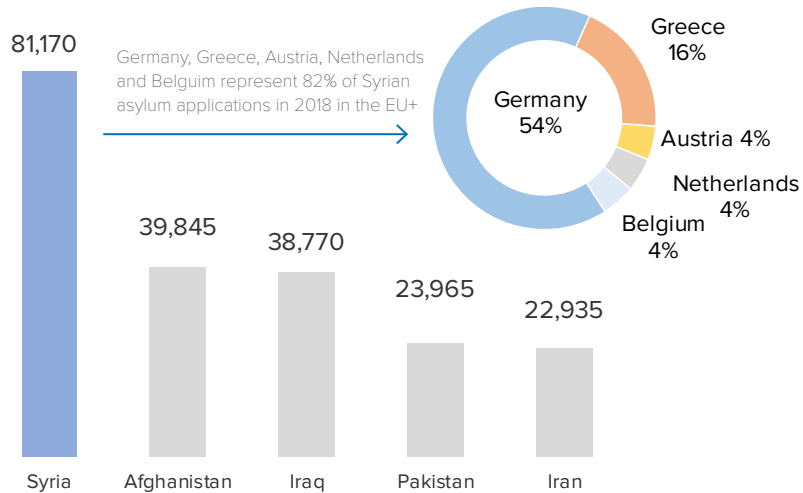

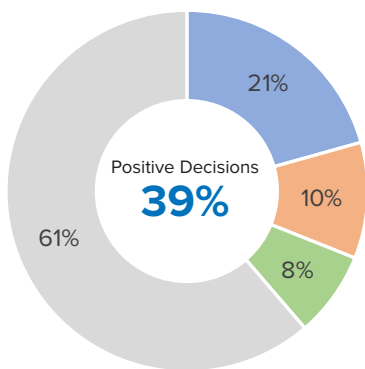
Most common countries of asylum in the EU+ in January-November 2018



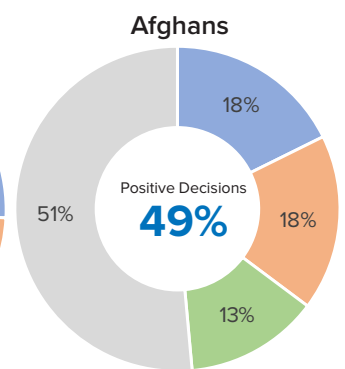
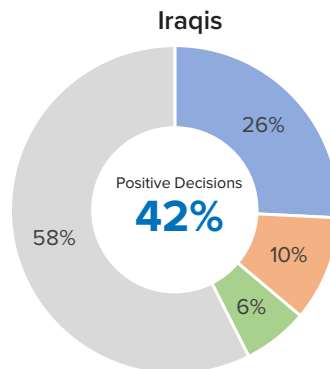
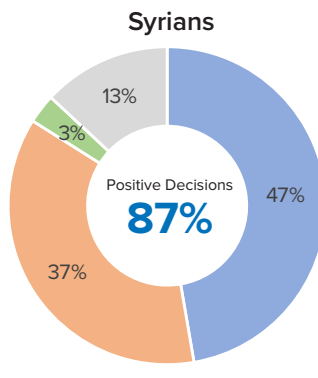
Most common nationalities of asylum applications in 2018

Top Nationalities of EU+ First Instance Decisions (Q1-Q3 2018)



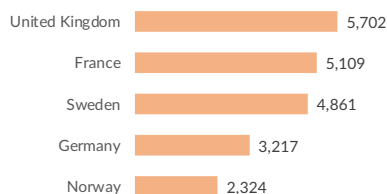

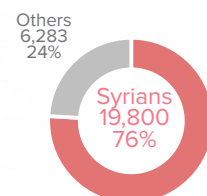
