
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




- Skin infection

During the month of September 2019, upper respiratory tract infection (URTI) was the highest reported acute health condition with a proportional morbidity of 28%. No significant changes in the trends of other acute health conditions.

- Hypertension
- Diabetes
- Asthma
- Cardiovascular disease
- Ischaemic heart disease

During the month of September 2019, hypertension, diabetes and asthma were the highest reported chronic health conditions with a proportional morbidity of 12%, 12% and 11% respectively. Trend in chronic health conditions varies as a result of clinic accessibility challenges. Management of chronic diseases requires regular periodic visits to monitor diseases and evaluate therapeutic outcomes which necessitates enhanced accessibility of those morbid diseases to the health care facility.










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
