COVID-19 response	<ul> <li>UNHCR BNWG chair highlighted about the discrepancies still exist in the COVID-19 Sept dashboard in terms of the number of cases being booked vs. cases being assisted, and mentions that this will affect the accuracy of related reporting to the donors and respective stakeholders. Eg., a case being booked in October should have an assisted record in RAIS before 31 Oct.</li> </ul>
