




ARRIVAL BY NATIONALITY (October 2020)




ARRIVAL TREND (2019-2020)

UNHCR continues to receive new arrivals in East Sudan, largely from Eritrea. The Commission of Refugees (CoR) receives and assists asylum-seekers at the border where they are temporarily hosted in reception centres. Within 1-2 weeks they are transported to Shagarab camps where they undergo screening, registration, and Refugee Status Determination (RSD) while receiving life-saving services and shelter.
