

VERIFIED IDP SITES IN DIINSOOR AS OF NOVEMBER 2022




Map of verified IDP sites in Diinsoor - November 2022

Assessment overview

IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Diinsoor in November 2022 led by SWSCRI, IRW and MARDO. 17 IDP sites were identified hosting 3,958 households or 25,694 individuals. Compared to the last site verification conducted in July 2022, there was an increase of 2 IDP site, 509 Households or 4,604 individuals.

People living with disability

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were

108 (49% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

94 (40% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

105 (64% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding

67 (45% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

76 (54% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing

126 (54% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

Eviction Risk Mapping

576 (2.3%)

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

24% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme (24%) and high (0%) risk of eviction

76% of sites have landowner authorized ownership type of land tenure

71% of sites have agreement in place

100% of those that have agreements have oral agreements

75% of those that have agreements have agreed end dates

 \sim 24% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

4 IDP sites (24%) have been classified as high (floods frequently)
