

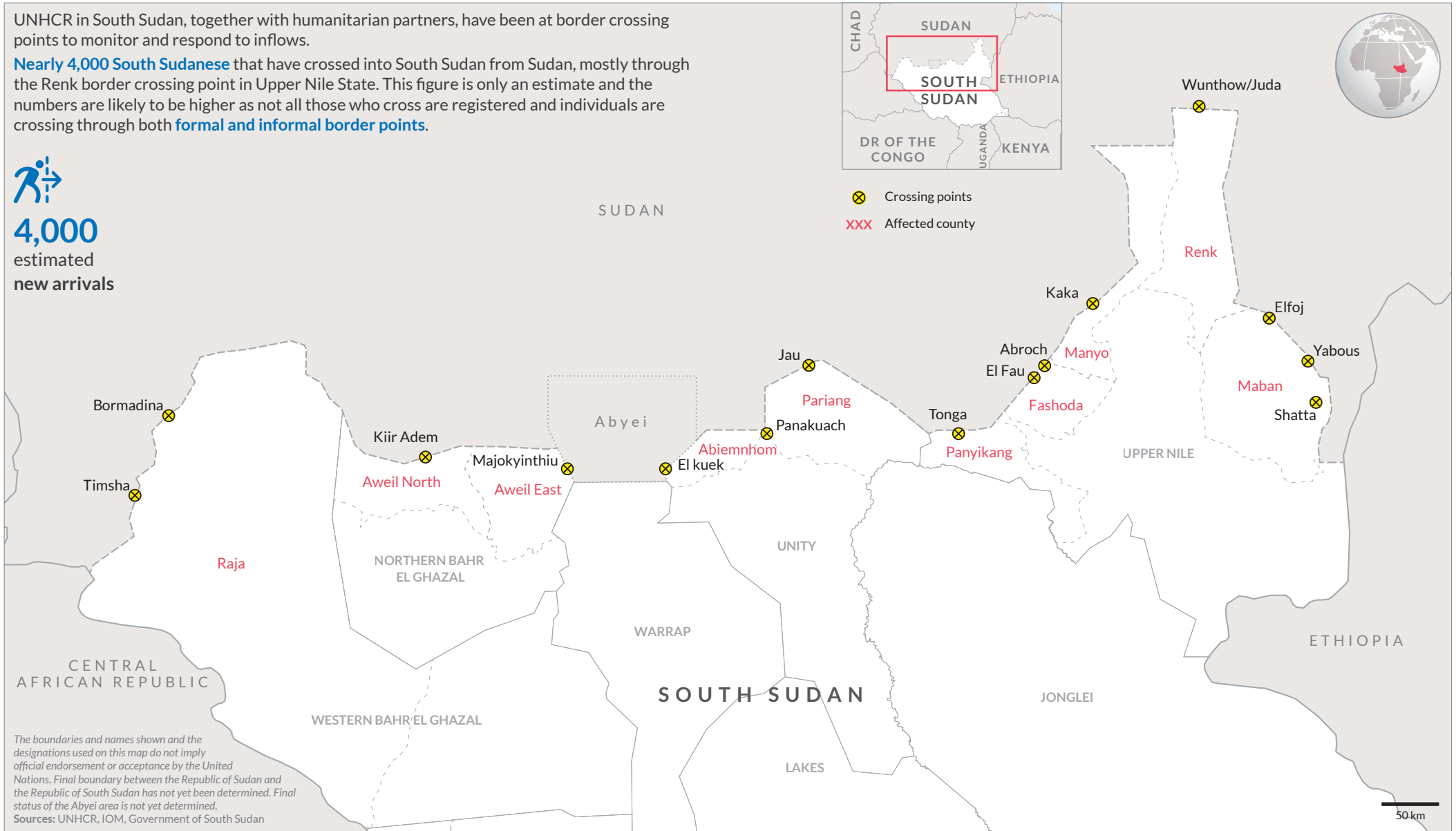


UNHCR in South Sudan, together with humanitarian partners, have been at border crossing points to monitor and respond to inflows.

Nearly 4,000 South Sudanese that have crossed into South Sudan from Sudan, mostly through the Renk border crossing point in Upper Nile State. This figure is only an estimate and the numbers are likely to be higher as not all those who cross are registered and individuals are crossing through both formal and informal border points.
