
Entry and transit points of refugees and migrants prior crossing the Darien jungle

Most extra-continentals from Somalia, Eritrea, India, Pakistan, and other countries, reported arriving to Suriname and started their journey from there, as the country used to offer them e-visa flexible arrangements. From 1st May, visa policies were reestablished for most of these nationalities.
