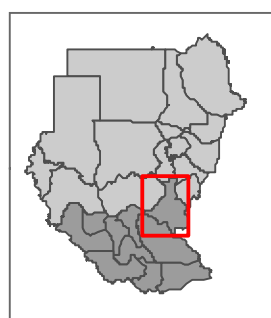


Transport Overview Upper Nile State - October 2009
