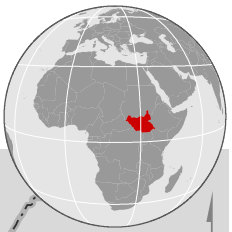
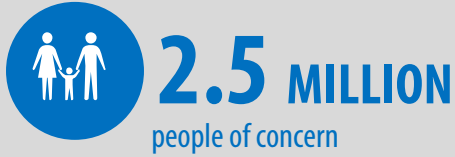

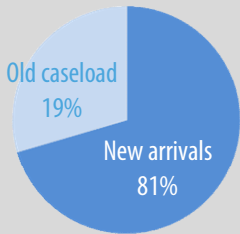

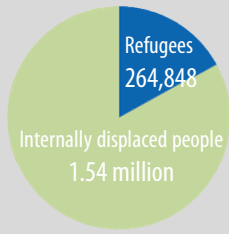
South Sudanese refugees

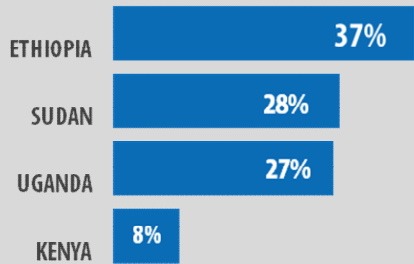

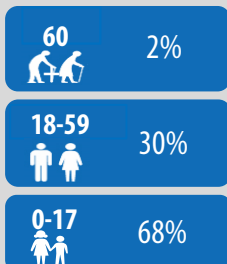

Geographic distribution of new refugee arrivals

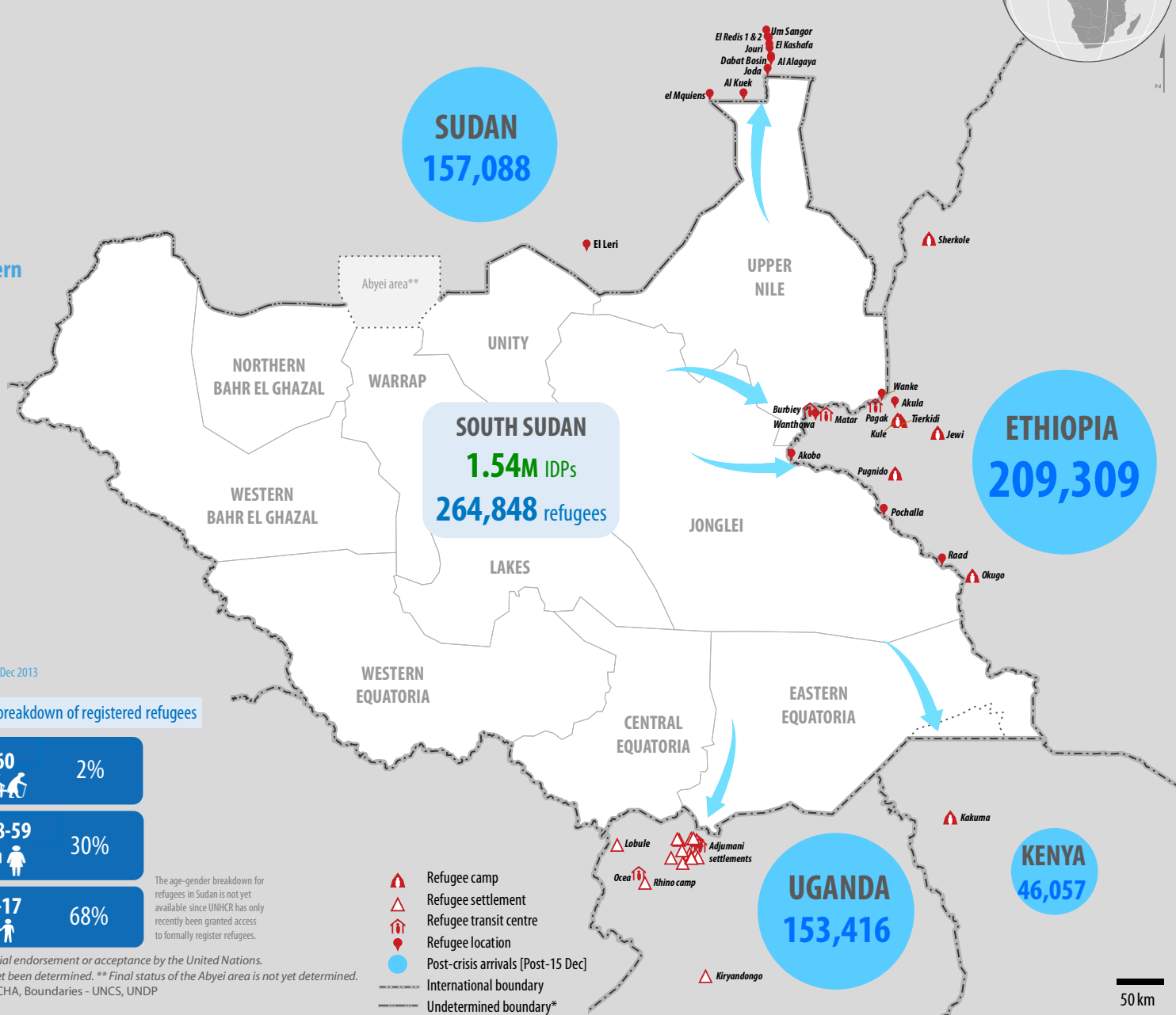


Age breakdown of registered refugees
