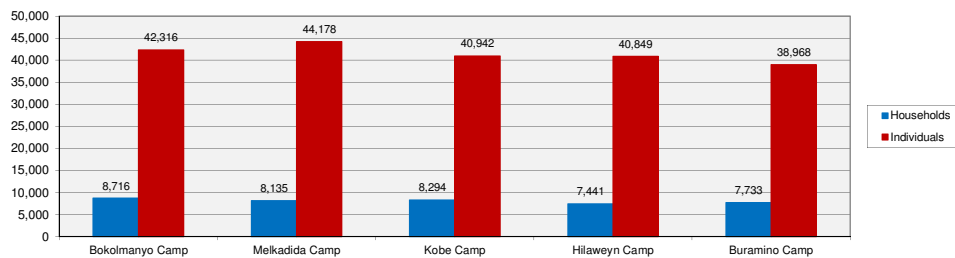

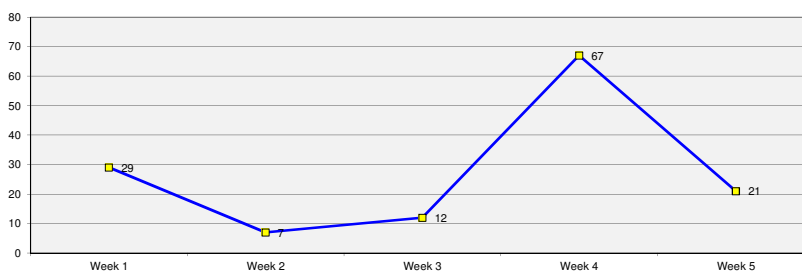
**Figure 1.1 - Total Refugee Population in Sub Office Melkadida**

**Figure 1.2 - New Arrivals at Reception Centre by Week during the Current Month**



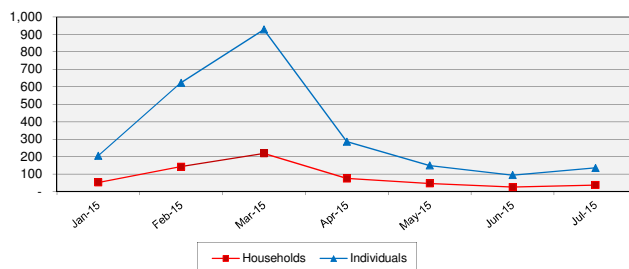

Figure 2.1 - ALL CAMPS Demographic Breakdown\*

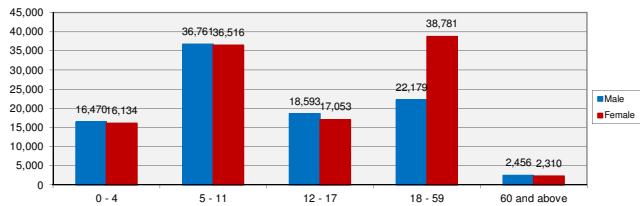

Figure 2.2 - Melkadida Camp Demographic Breakdown

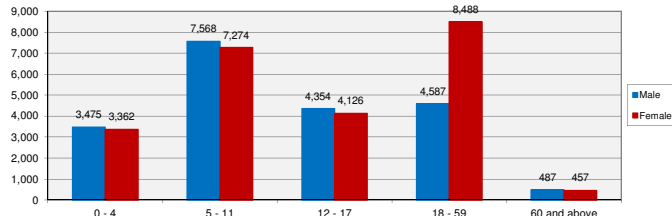

Figure 2.3 - Bokolmany Camp Demographic Breakdown

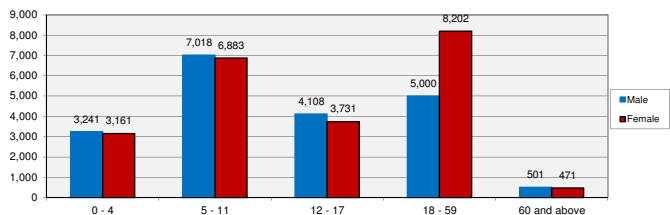

Figure 2.4 - Kobe Camp Demographic Breakdown

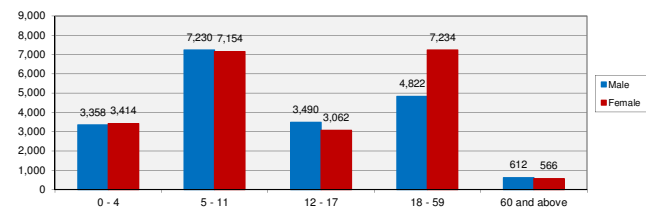

Figure 2.5 - Hilaweyn Camp Demographic Breakdown

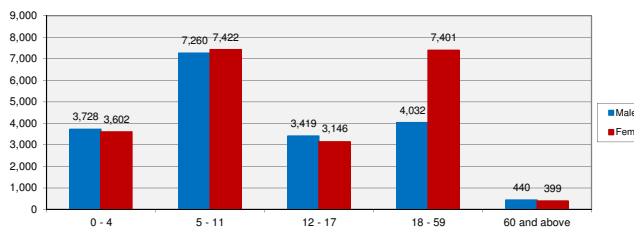
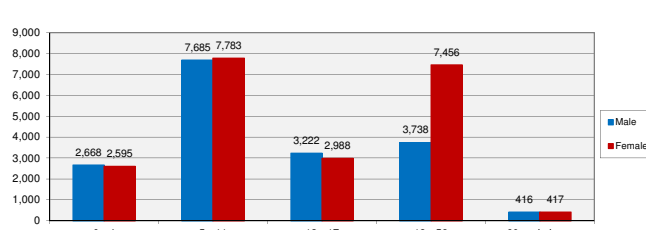

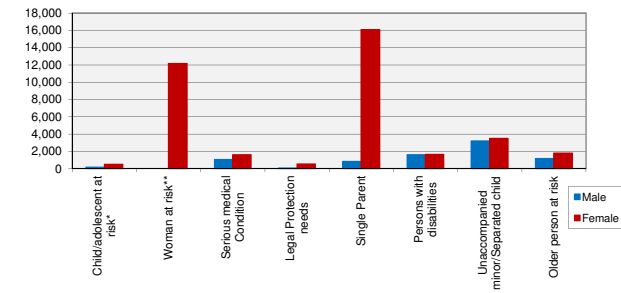

**Figure 5.1 - ALL CAMPS Specific Needs**

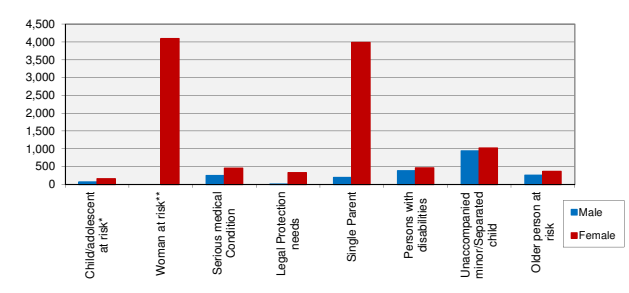

**Figure 5.2 - Melkadida Camp Specific Needs**

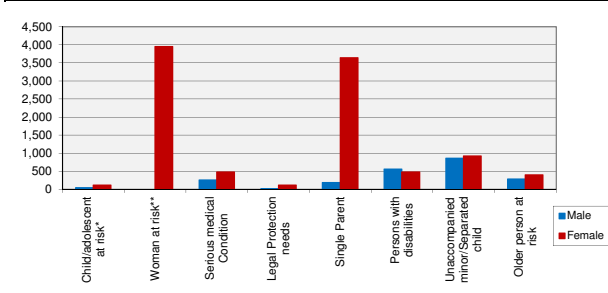

**Figure 5.3 - Bokolmanyo Camp Specific Needs**

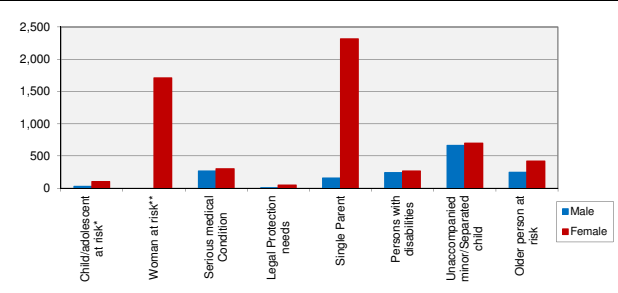

**Figure 5.4 - Kobe Camp Specific Needs**

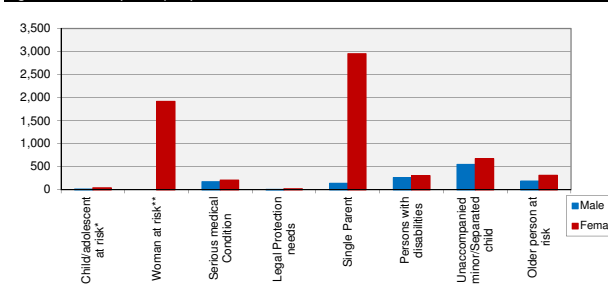

**Figure 5.5 - Hilaweyn Camp Population Increase**

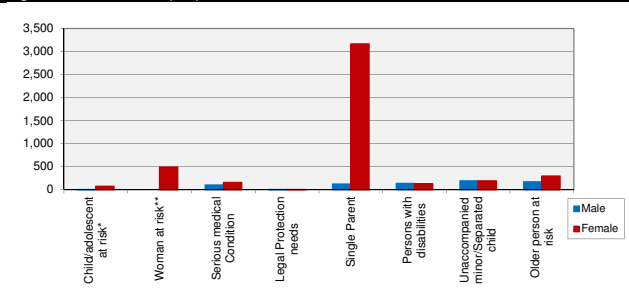

**Figure 5.6 - Buramino Camp Population Increase**



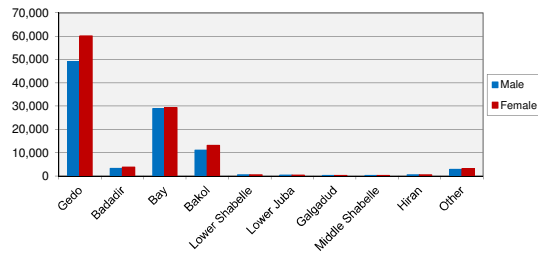

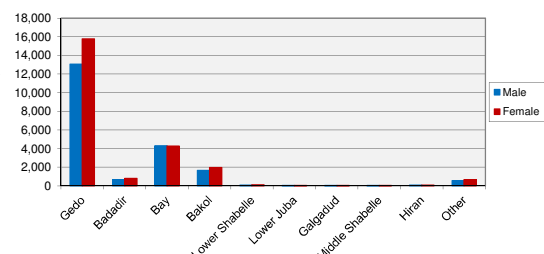
**Figure 7.1 - ALL CAMPS Places of Origin**

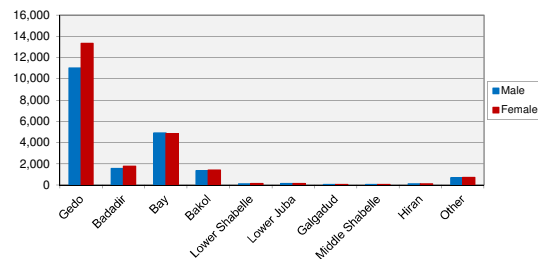
**Figure 7.2 - Melkadida Camp Places of Origin**

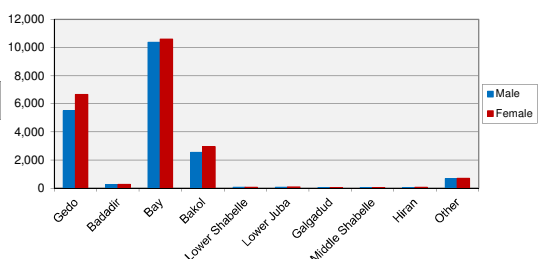
**Figure 7.3 - Bokolmanyol Camp Places of Origin**

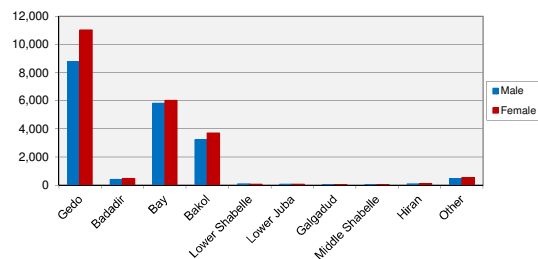
**Figure 7.5 - Kobe Camp Places of Origin**

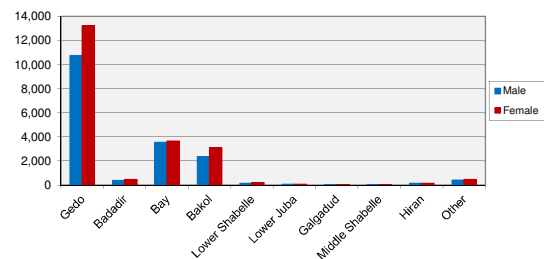
**Figure 7.6 - Hilaweyn Camp Places of Origin**

**Figure 7.7 - Buramino Camp Places of Origin**

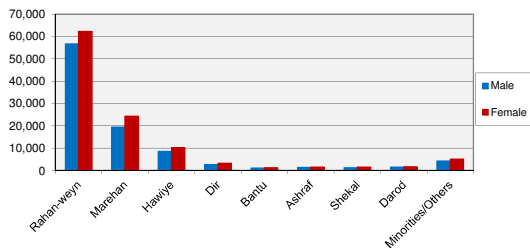

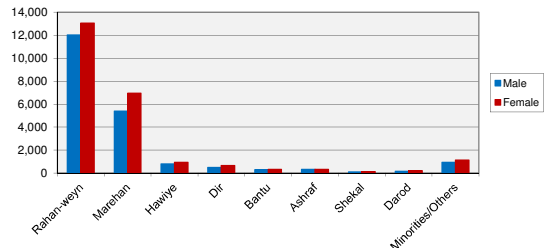

Figure 6.1 - ALL CAMPS Ethnic Breakdown



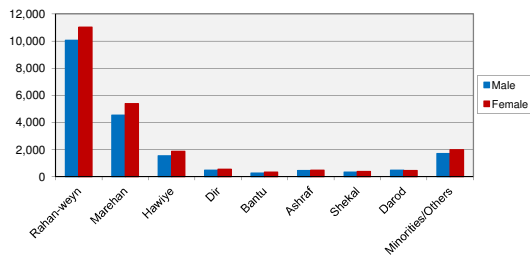

Figure 6.2 - Melkadida Camp Ethnic Breakdown



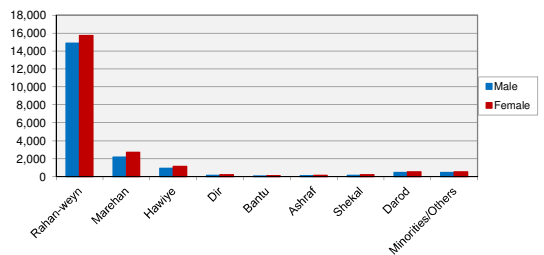

Figure 6.3 - Bokomanyo Camp Ethnic Breakdown



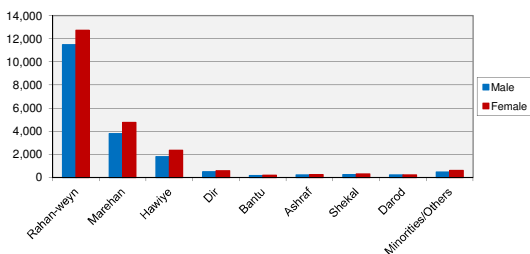
