Syria refugee crisis: a protracted emergency

- Over 3 million refugees
- US\$ 4.1 billion funding received since 2012
- Growing impact on host governments and local communities

Workshop objectives

- Provide regional generic guidance and tools
- Prepare sector coordinators to play a leadership role in developing sector plans and contributing to country and regional plans
- Develop and discuss regional sector objectives, outputs and indicators

2015 planning assumptions

- Continuation of civil war in Syria
- Refugee outflow to neighbouring countries in line with current trends
- Worsening social and economic impact on refugees, local communities, and host governments

- Strengthening of national systems and local capacities
- Advocacy
- Beyond traditional responses - planning/funding
