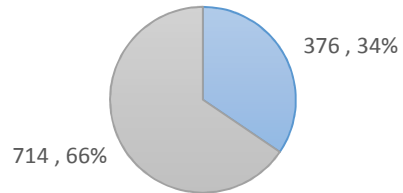
Focused PSS - Sex



Case Management - Sex

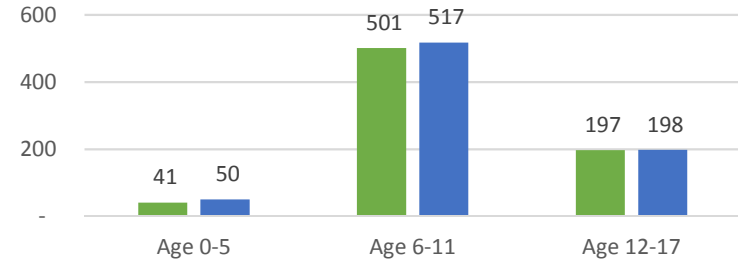
