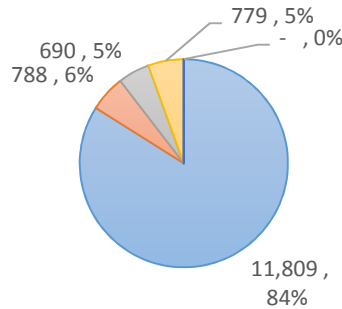

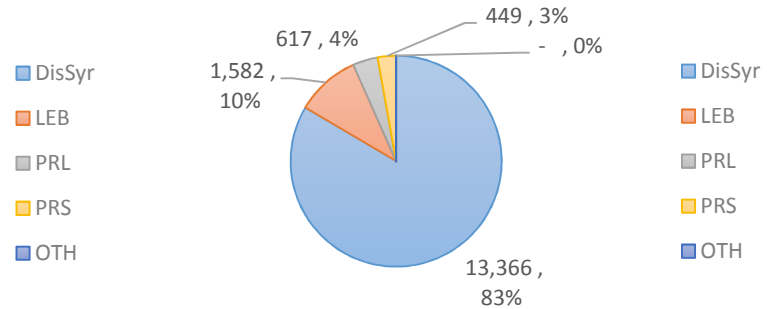

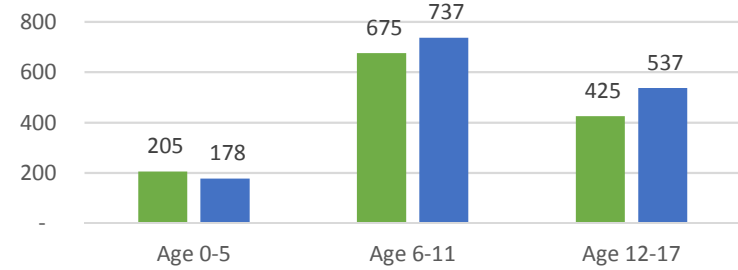

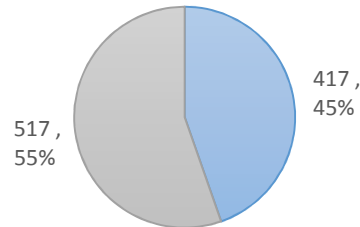
Focused PSS - Age



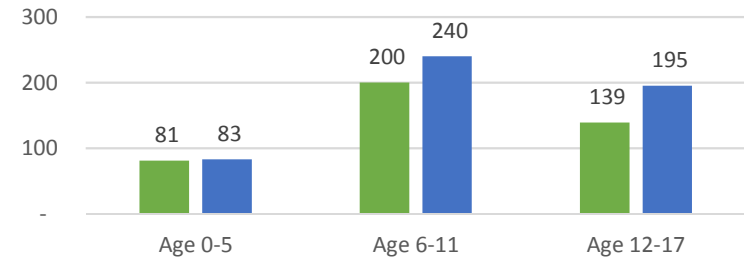

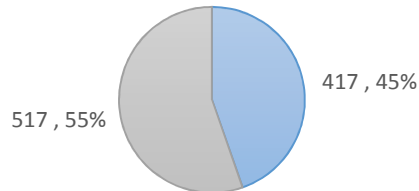

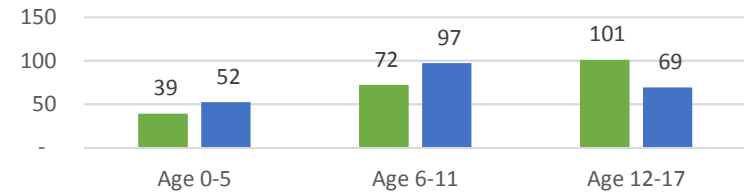
