Shelter DRC-UNHCR	Due to the cyclone Komen, several shelters have been partially or totally damaged in the camp. DRC conducted a rapid shelter assessment the week after the cyclone. The results of the assessment have been shared with CCCM and Shelter Cluster.	 RSG has currently committed to respond to the shelter needs in the camps, especially in the camps covered by DRC CCCM. The shelter renovation in OTC has not started yet.
