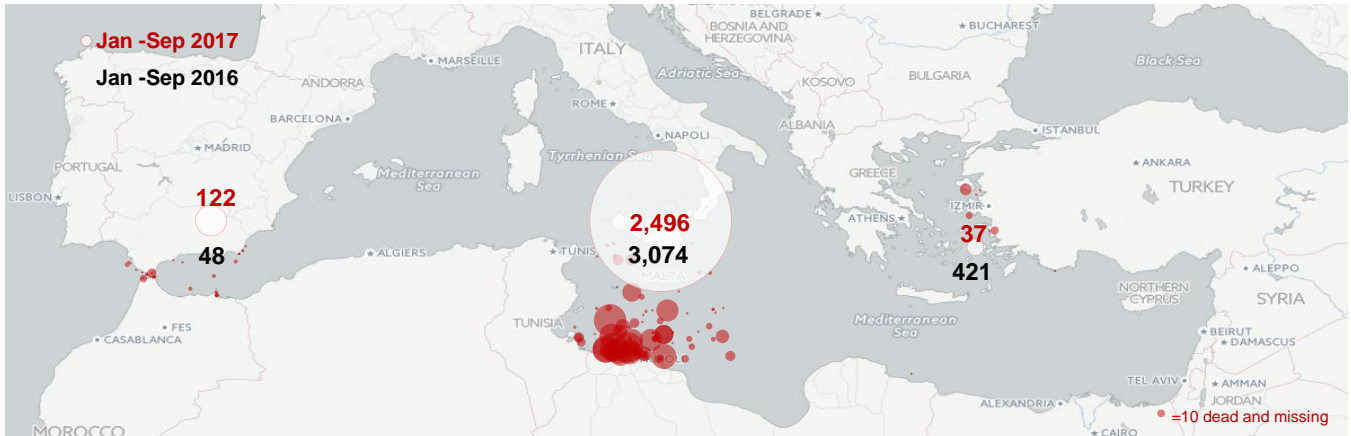

(Jan -Sep, 2016 and 2017)



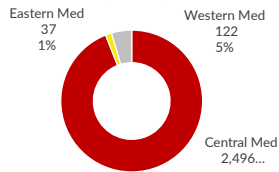

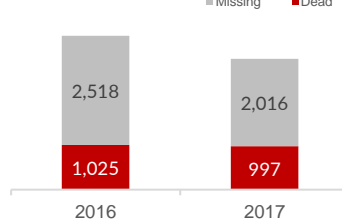

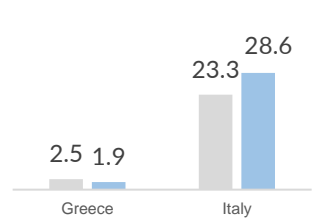
Distribution per route (2017)



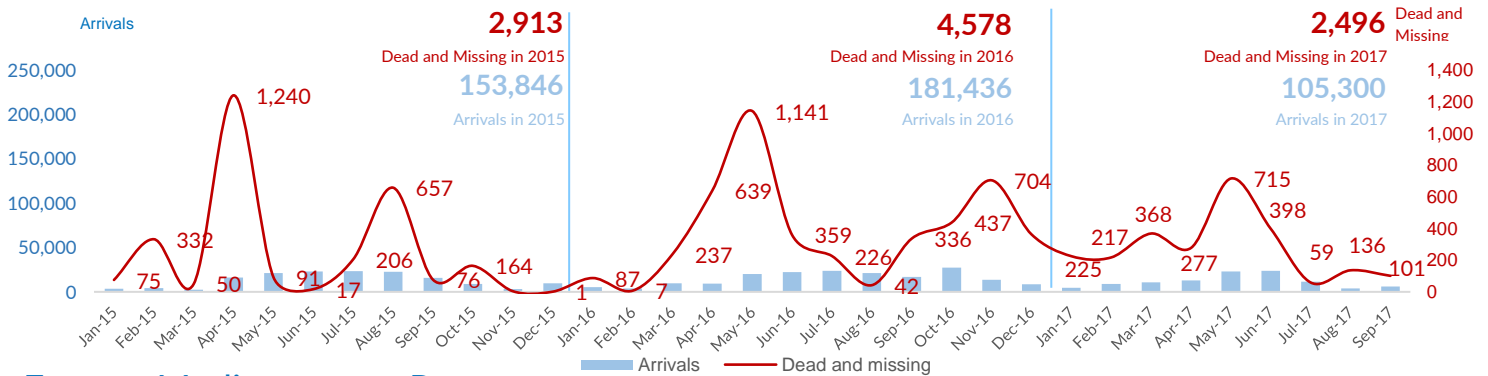
Dead and missing (as of 30 September - 2016 and 2017)



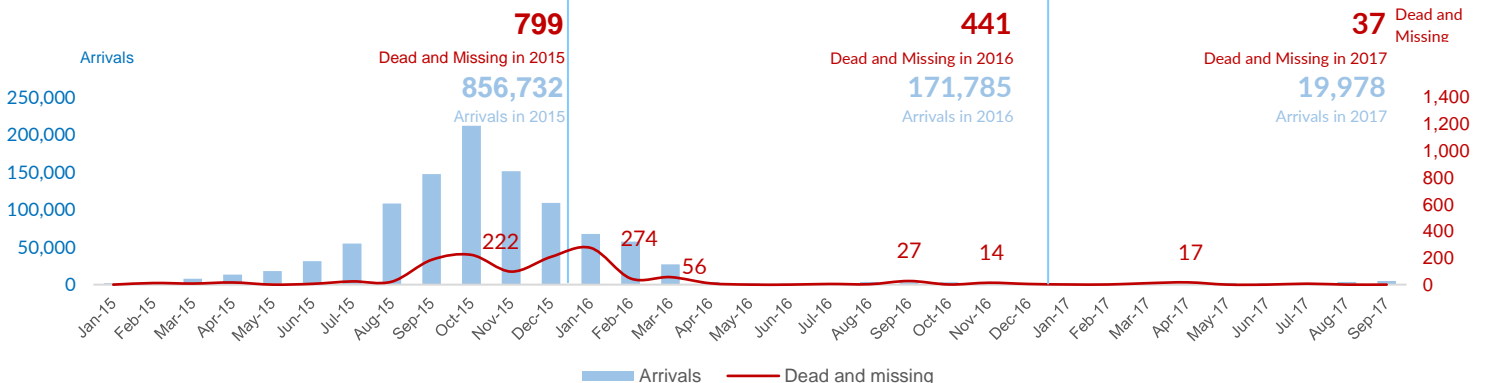
Dead and missing / 1000 arrivals
