

# 2017 - 2018 Winterization assistance summary

Week commencing 05 November 2017 - Syrian cases

## Summary

- We are still early in the 2017-2018 Winterization season, which means:
- 56% of eligible cases have been blocked. This figure may seem low, however this is because UNHCR has not blocked the full extent of its budget in order to grant organisations time to assess and block their own cases loads. UNHCR has capacity to absorb the remaining cases and this will be implemented in mid-late November.
- No assistance has been uploaded to RAIS at this time but over the coming weeks we expect the first tranches of assistance to be

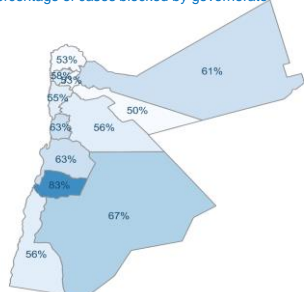

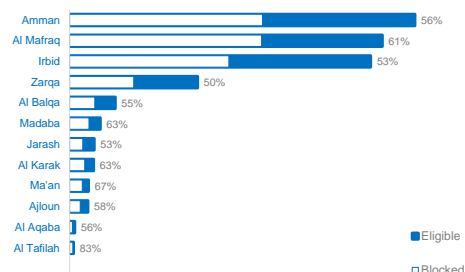

Eligible cases and percentage blocked

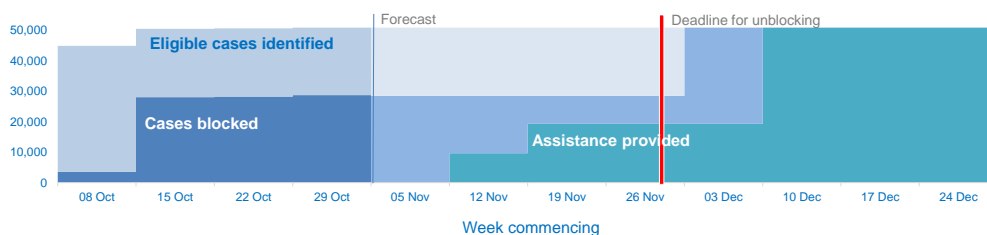

### Forecasting assistance

- Partner organisations have until November 28th to block and confirm assistance before UNHCR will provide for the remaining caseload on the 30th November.
- Partner cases not being assisted must be unblocked by the 28th** so that UNHCR can apply their block on the 30th.

### Targeting observations

- The UNHCR Wait List has been fully allocated by UNHCR and partners
- The Cash List that set aside for partner allocation has a remaining caseload of 21,991, this will need to be allocated, there is potential for large organisations to help to reduce the gap
- Over 6,000 cases have been provisionally blocked from partner owned lists. It is expected that this number will reduce after assessments are completed. De-prioritised cases from this list will not be reallocated to other partners
