30 November 2017



**3,300** Estimated number of UAC currently in Greece based on analysis of data available to EKKKA (as of 30 November 2017)

**1,130** Total number of places available in UAC shelters (filled, pending assigned cases as of 30 November, including 45 vacant places)

**2,201** Total number of UAC on waiting list for shelter (as of 30 November 2017) including:  
**•425** in Reception and Identification Centers  
**•80** in protective custody

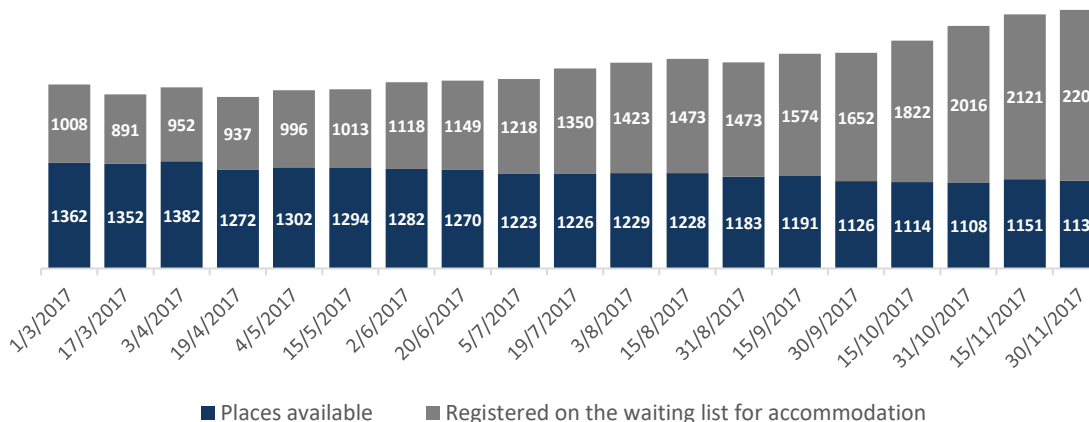
Waiting list does not include referrals of unknown location carried out during pre-registration exercise. Waiting list includes **183** separated children.

**10,175** Total number of UAC referrals to EKKKA from 1 Jan 2016 to 30 November 2017.

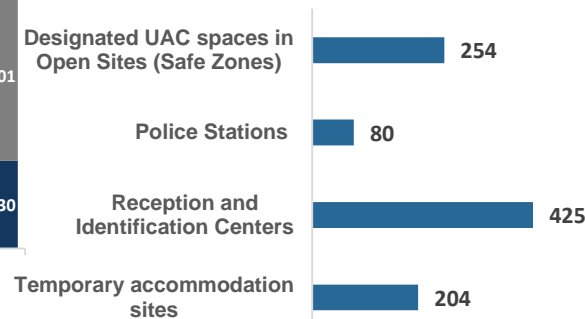
Out of the total:  
**•9,513** boys (93%)  
**•662** girls (7%)  
**•605** <14 years old (6%)

 1 March 2017 – 30 November 2017



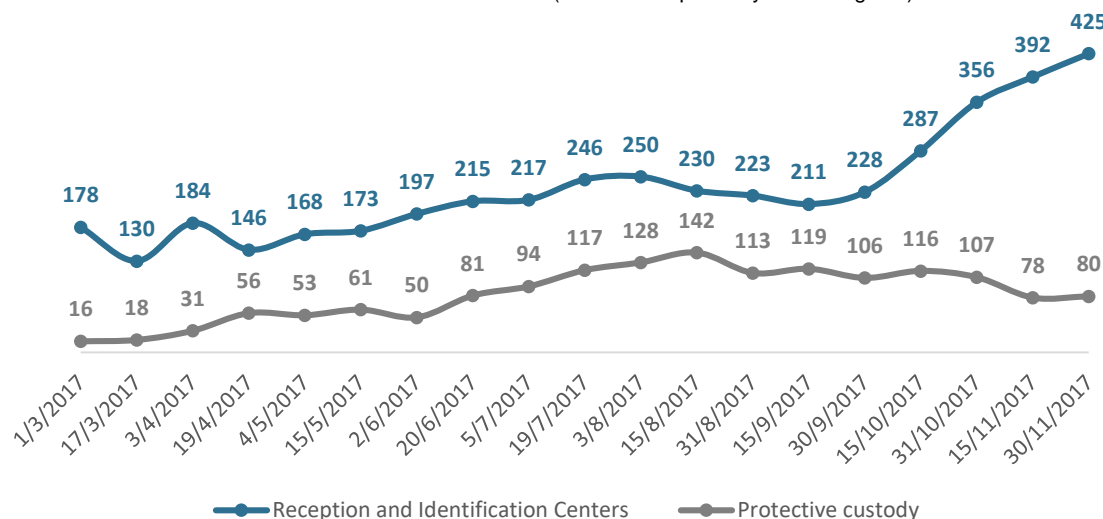

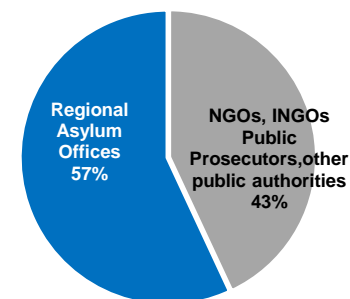
\*Referrals from open facilities are carried out by referral agents including Asylum Service, NGOs, INGOs, Public Prosecutors.

### UAC Shelters (transit and long-term)

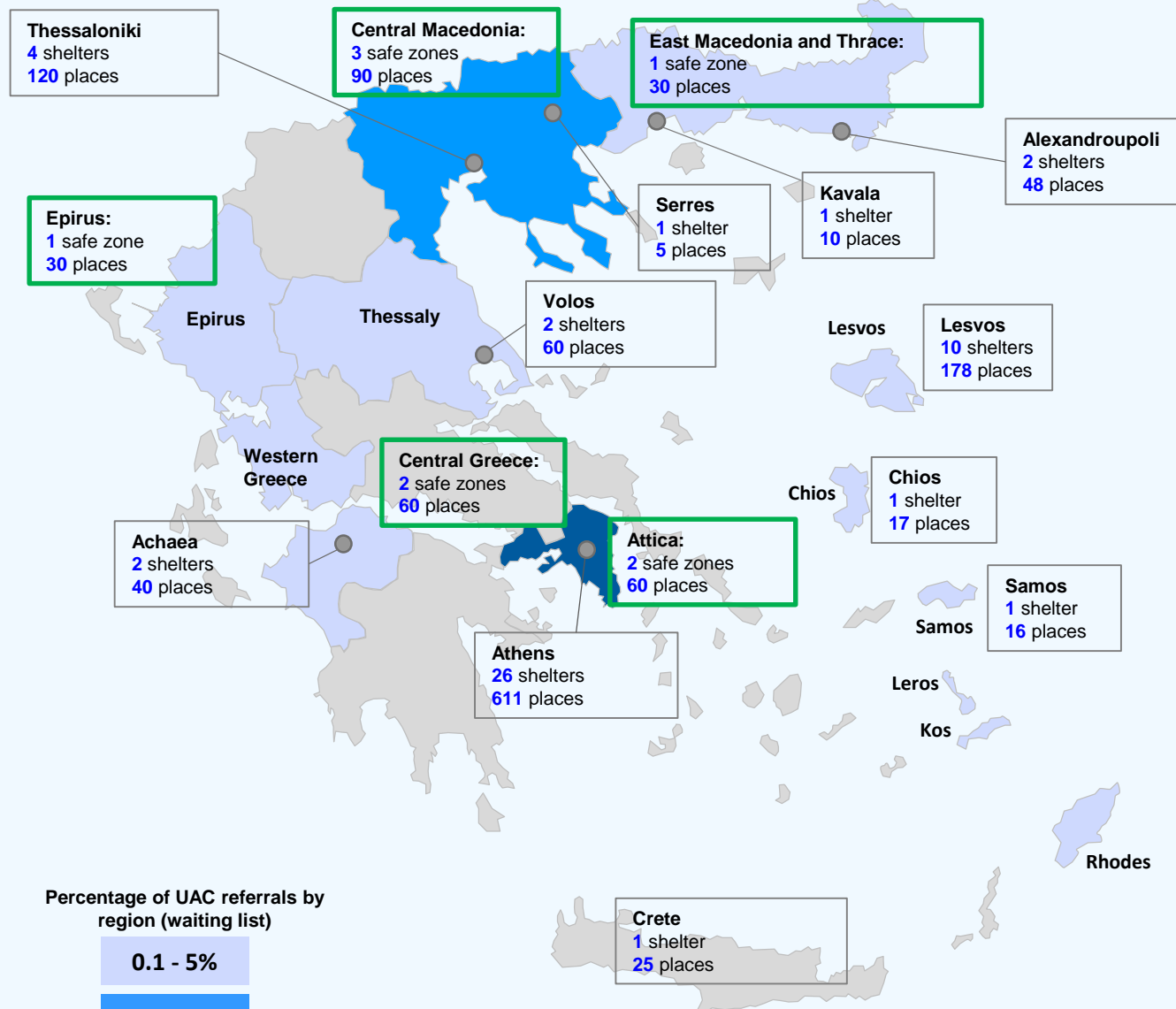
- **Current: 51** UAC shelters with total **1,130** places. (increased from 423 places in March 2016)
- **Planned: 2** new shelters with total **30** new places

### Safe Zones\* (short-term)

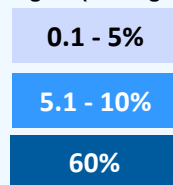
- **Current: 9** Safe Zones for UAC with total **270** places.
- **Planned: 1** new Safe Zone with total **30** new places

\*Safe Zones are designated supervised spaces within accommodation sites which provide UAC with 24/7 emergency protection and care. They should be used as short term (maximum 3 months) measures to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Safe Zone priority is given to UAC in detention as well as other vulnerable children, in line with their best interests.

Shelter(s) by location



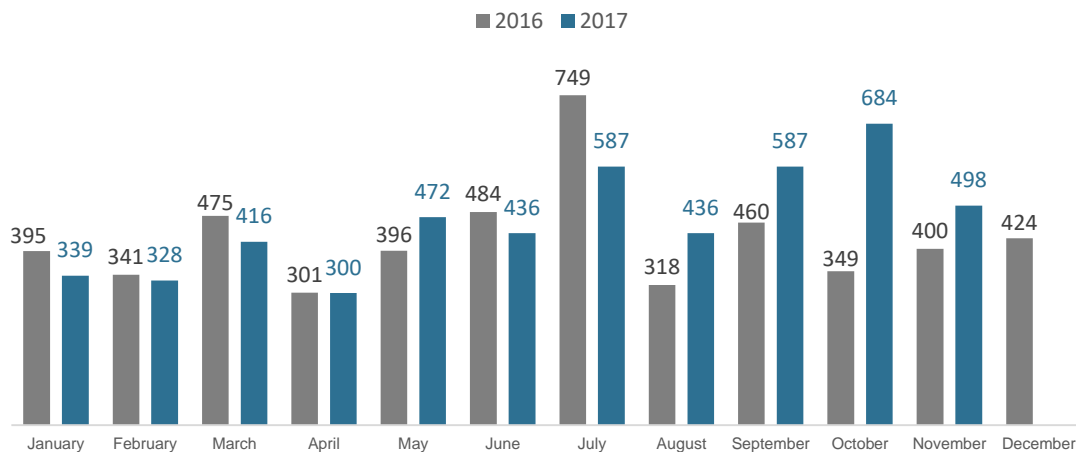

Number of UAC Referrals to EKKA by month\*

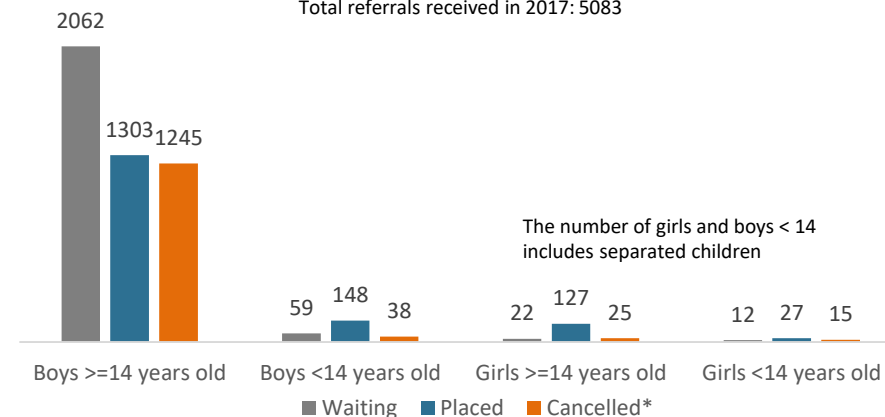

Total referrals received in 2017: 5083

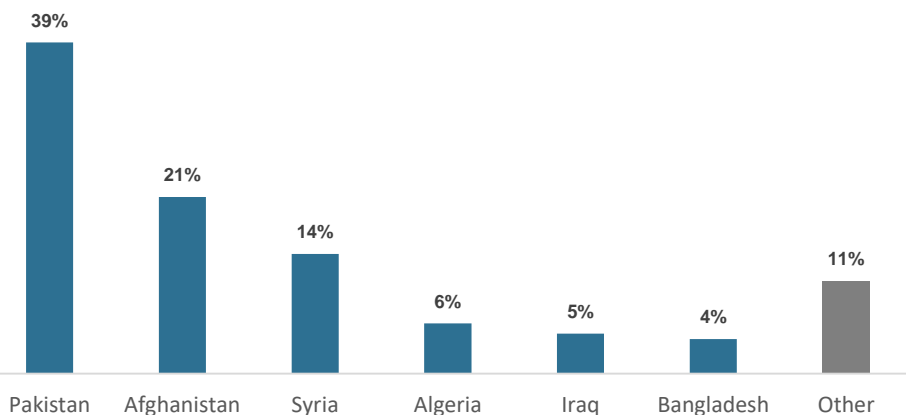

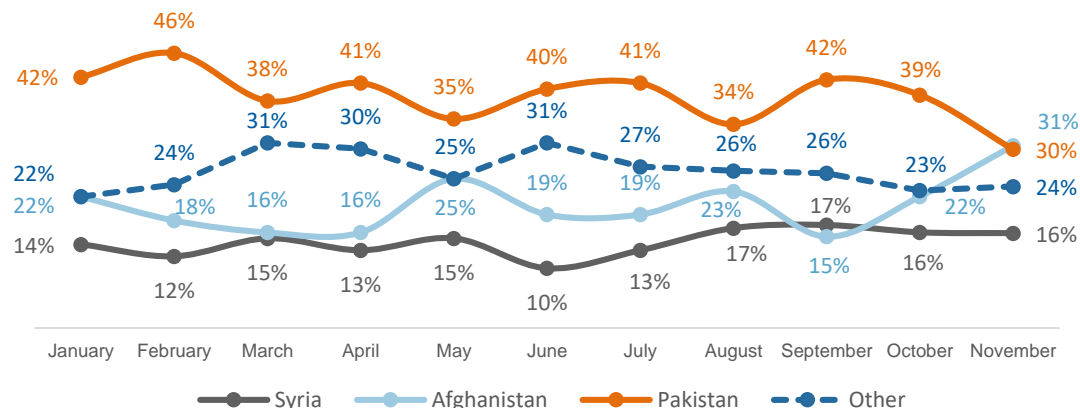
UAC referrals to EKKA by nationality
