	4-5 years old (FE/VIAL RIC): Families that have arrived to the island in the past two weeks want to enroll their children to the Kindergarten. The children, though, are not vaccinated, hence cannot be enrolled.	KEELPNO will be contacted for follow-up on this issue.
	6-II years old (NFE/VIAL RIC): New registrations have been taking place at METAdrasi's NFE Centre. Generally, the population's mobility seems to have interesting effects on the established education system. METAdrasi's Education focal point will be examining the situation and will share her observations with the education partners on the next meeting.	
	 I 2-22 years old (NFE/VIAL RIC): Action for Education: The last weeks have been busy, with more registrations taking place. AfE would like to know how many adolescents/young adults that reside in VIAL RIC do not attend their programmes. AfE also prepared and will distribute multilingual 	AfE will contact RIS to request for the relevant age breakdown.

	 METAdrasi Education Centre: METAdrasi will soon start offering Greek language classes for adolescents (12-14 years old), for unaccompanied minors, and for girls and young women (15-22 years old) residing in VIAL RIC. More updates will be shared once the new schedule is finalized. 	METAdrasi will share their amended programme with the REC/MoE.
	 18+ years old (NFE/VIAL RIC and off-site): CESRT Language Centre: 34 people have registered the past 2 weeks for lessons, while the number of regular attendances has dropped. Three new, long-term English language teachers will come this week. 	
	 Imagine Centre: The Centre was closed on Friday and on Sunday for Easter. With the increase of arrivals, new registrations have been taking place. Additionally, two scheduled activities are to take place: (a) a visit to the Chios Mastic Museum and (b) a coastal cleanup.
