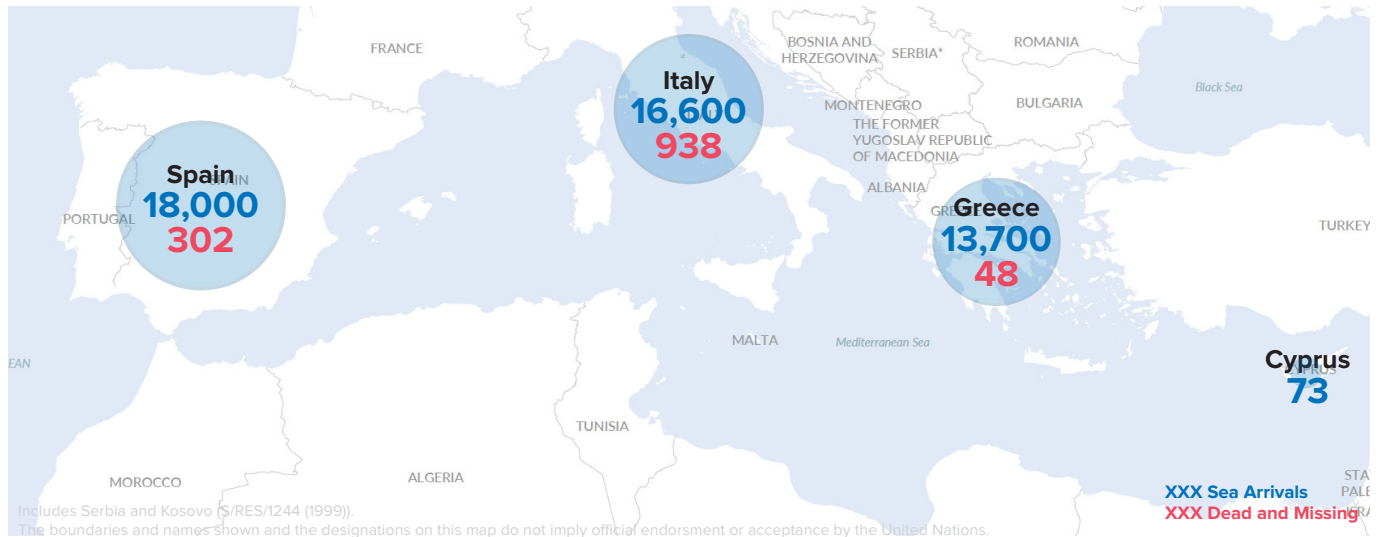

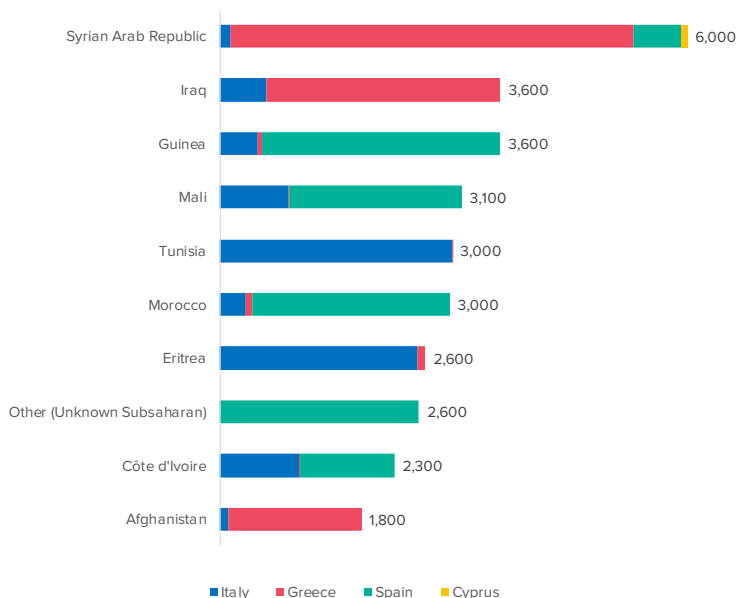

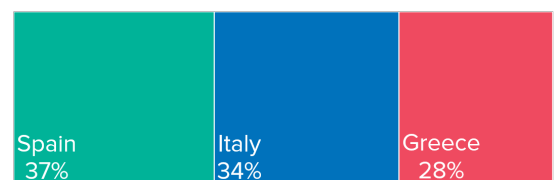

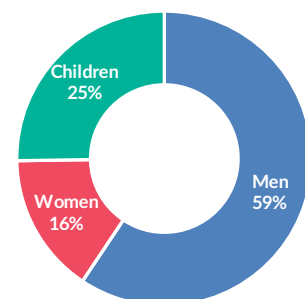
Most common nationalities of Mediterranean arrivals Q1+Q2 2018

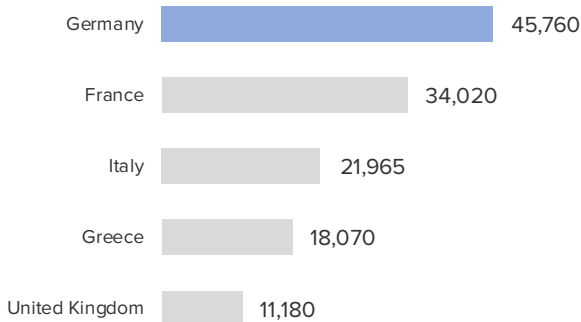
New Asylum Applications in EU+ countries in 2018

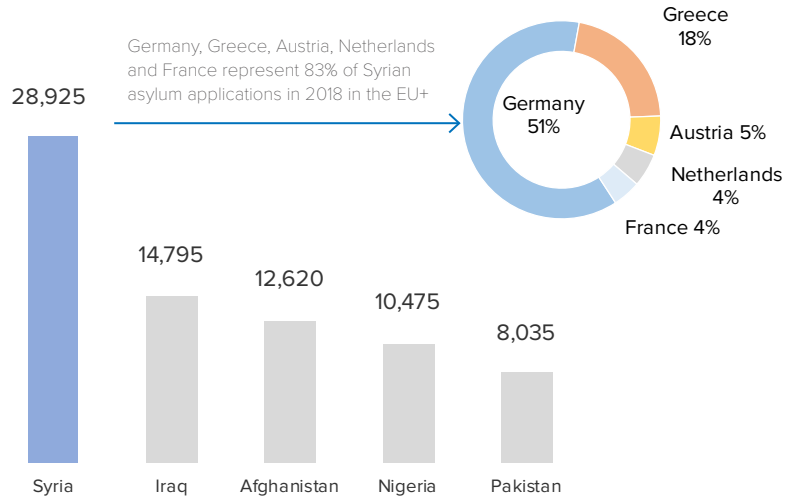

Most common countries of asylum in the EU+ in January-April 2018

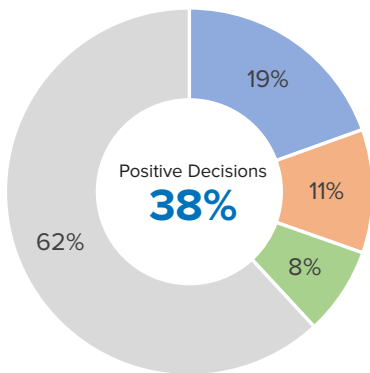

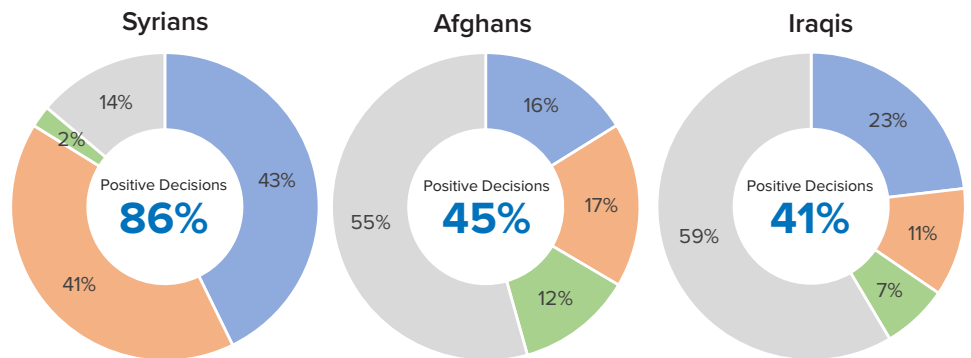
Most common nationalities of asylum applications in 2018

Top Nationalities of EU+ First Instance Decisions (Q1 2018)



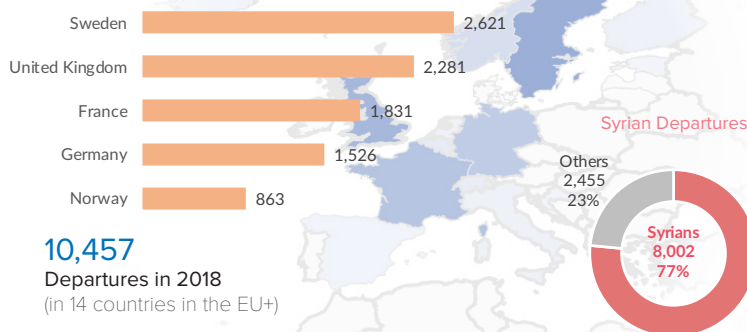
