UPDATES FROM PARTNERS	<p><b>DRC:</b> Activities continue as usual, started NFE activities for adults in Trikala</p> <p><b>SOS Children's Villages:</b> Continues with NFE activities in Kara Tepe, Lesvos. SOS Children's Villages mobilized in support of the fire victims in Rafina and Marathonas with providing psychological support</p> <p><b>IOM:</b> No major updates. IOM has submitted their proposal for the transportations to schools for the coming school year. There will be an increased demand from the newly opened Temporary Accommodation Facility of Kipselochori</p> <p><b>UNHCR:</b> Work as usual. With transfers from the islands to the mainland. It remains to be seen how to proceed with NFE in the islands for 2019. New report from HRW on education has been published and has inconsistencies.</p>	Xenia to share the latest HRW report with the ESWG.

	<p><b>ELIX:</b> The ELIX Learning Centers will be closed for one week from the 15<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> of August due to summer holidays. Elix volunteers assisted fire victims in Nea Voutsa and in the Kinetta area. ELIX volunteers collected goods for the Red Cross team</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Akominatou Open School closed due to repairs and the activities were temporarily moved to the Patision Learning Center because of repairs</li> </ul> <p><b>Praksis:</b> Sent mobile units with doctors and nurses to the areas most affected by the fires</p> <p><b>Formal education:</b> Registrations in schools will start again with the return of the school principals from summer holidays on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of August. In some sites children have already been registered and are ready for the coming school year.</p>
