

# Somalia

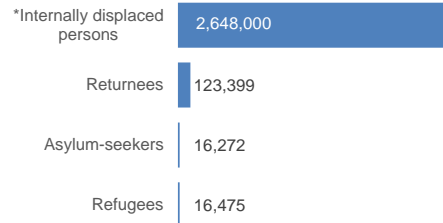

In November, 26,000 new displacement were monitored by the UNHCR-led Protection and Returns Monitoring Network (PRMN), a decrease compared to last month. Half of the displacements occurred in Bakool region due to lack of livelihood as pastoralists search for greener pastures. In 2018 so far, PRMN has monitored 858,000 internal displacements due to conflicts, floods and drought.

It is estimated there are 2.6 million internally displaced people in Somalia.

Somali refugees continue to return from countries of asylum. Over 123,000 people have voluntarily returned from twelve countries of asylum since 2014. The countries of asylum include Kenya, Yemen, Djibouti, Libya, Tunisia and Eritrea.

 (Source: Information Management Working Group)



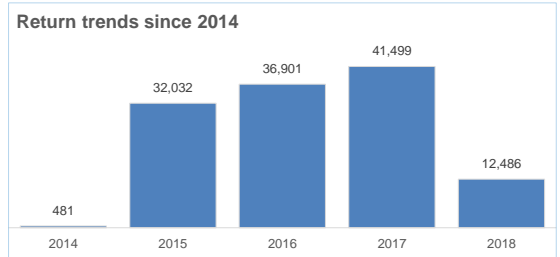
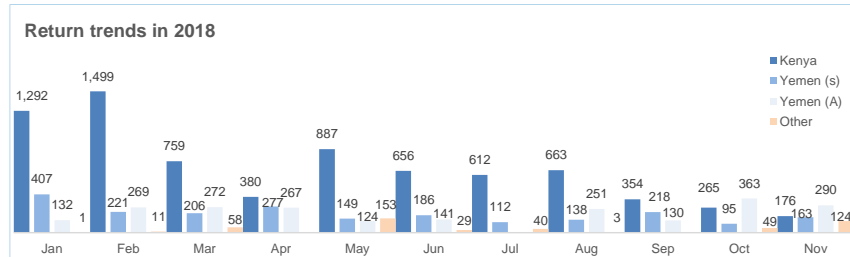
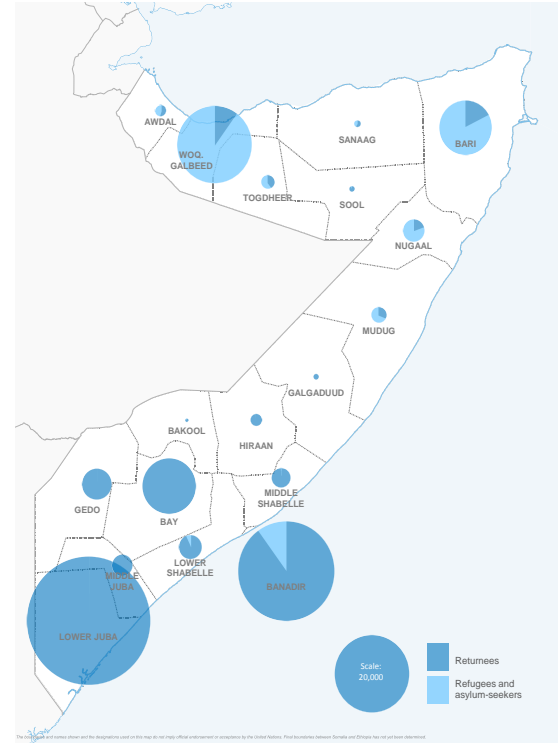
As of the report date, there are 32,747 refugees & asylum-seekers registered in Somalia, mainly from Ethiopia (15,989 asylum seekers and 3,872 refugees) and Yemen (54 asylum seekers and 12,296 refugees). In addition, 536 persons are from other countries including Syria (217), Tanzania (107), Eritrea (90) and others.



In total 123,399 Somali refugees have voluntarily returned to Somalia since December 2014. Of those, UNHCR has provided assistance to 82,840 voluntary returnees from Kenya and 3,053 assisted spontaneous return since 2017 from Yemen.

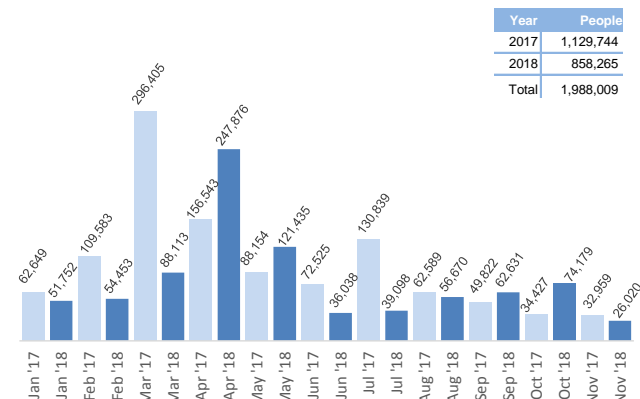

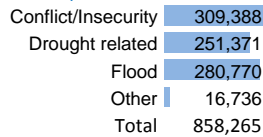

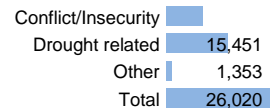
### Monthly internal displacement (2017-2018)



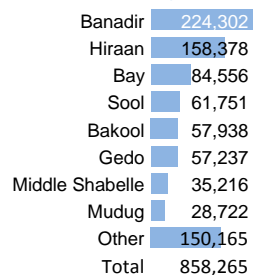
### 2018 displacement reasons



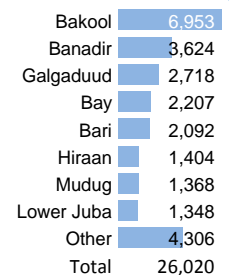
### November 2018 displacement reasons

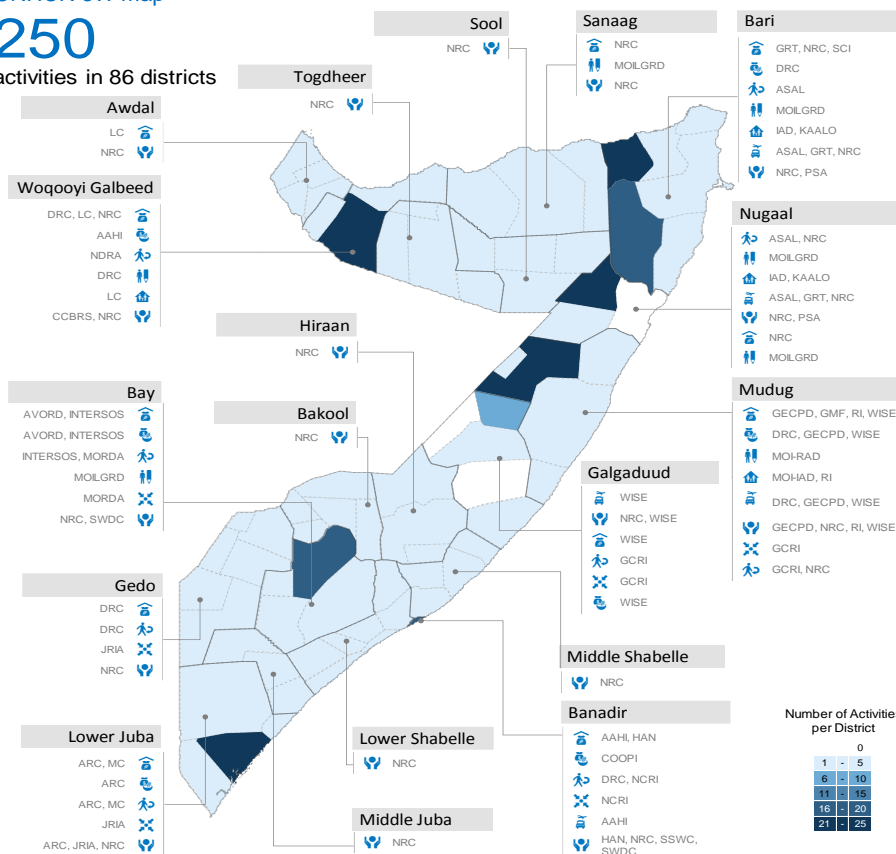

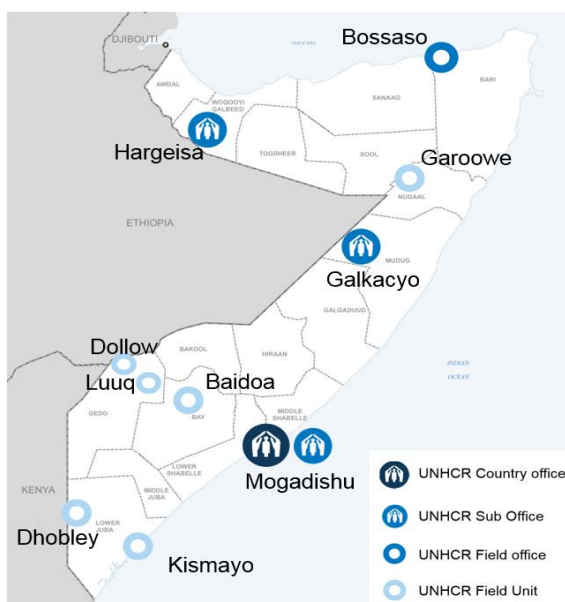

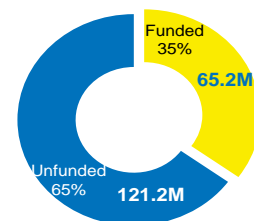
