Refugee returnees to Somalia at 31 December 2018

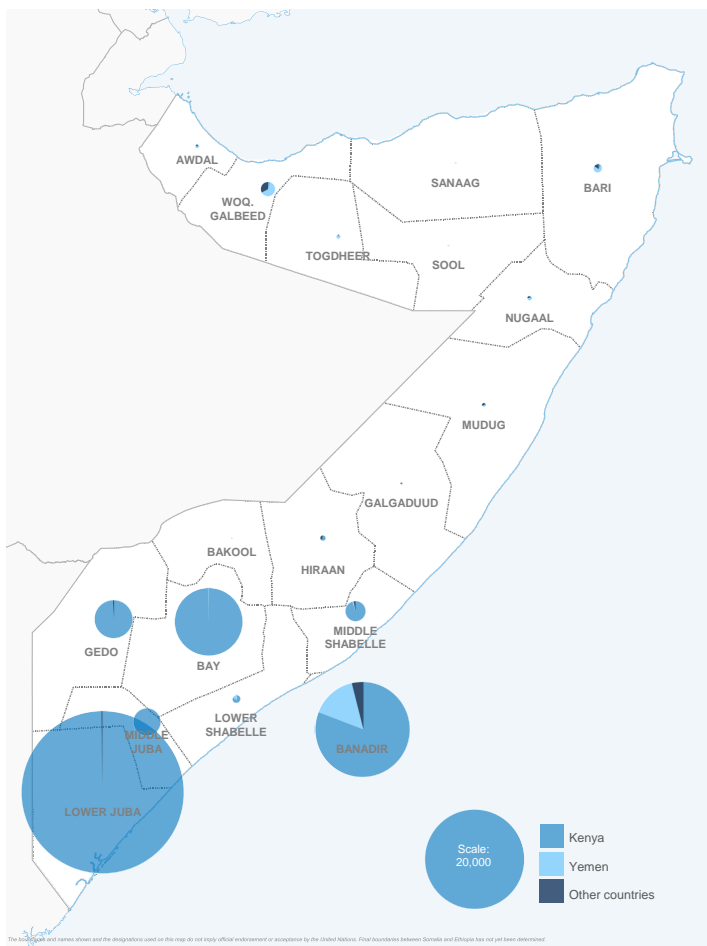

This figure includes voluntary repatriation from Kenya (82,840) and Assisted Spontaneous return from Yemen (3,405) as well as 1,245 returns from other countries such as Djibouti (783), Libya (353), Sudan (64), Eritrea (34), Pakistan, Gambia, Angola, Cambodia and others. Somali refugees from these or other countries who return spontaneously without assistance from the UNHCR are not included.

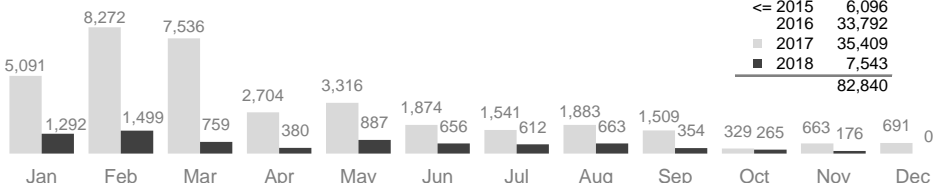

RETURNEES FROM KENYA BY MONTH

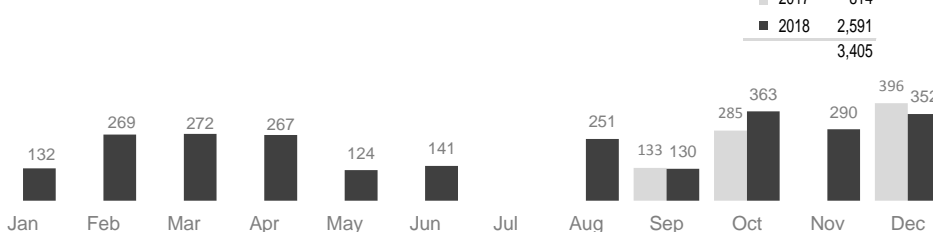

ASR RETURNEES FROM YEMEN BY MONTH

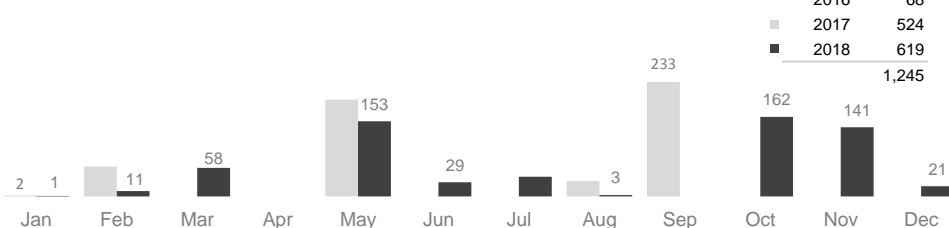
