2019 Priorities	<ol> <li>Update and strengthen M&amp;E system</li> <li>Link with protection: Referral System, decent work &amp; exploitation issues</li> <li>Link with Basic Assistance: sectors started working on graduation from ESSN and transition. A questionnaire has been developed by LH sector and WFP and will be shared with partners.</li> <li>Short Term Employment/ Cash for Work: defining minimum criteria, develop guidelines. İŞKUR is the focal point.</li> <li>Skills Training: List of trainings and modalities of partners, harmonization of modalities and develop guidelines.
