NORTH DARFUR



PHKs to support health and protection of over **4,100** refugee and host community women and girls.



Community-based protection and livelihoods programming to support wellbeing of **2,400** single women-headed households.



Shelter materials for over **4,600** refugee families in need and vulnerable host community members.



Scale-up of mobile clinic and nutrition services to improve access for **15,000** refugees living across Al Lait locality.

SOUTH DARFUR



Targeted livelihood programming for over **7,000** refugee youth.



Latrine construction in health centres to support health and wellbeing of refugees and host communities.



School feeding to support school retention for **3,500** refugee children and vulnerable host community students.



Water network expansion to improve access for over **5,000** refugees in Beilel IDP Camp.

EAST DARFUR



Scale-up of SGBV prevention and response services to improve access for **60,000** refugees.



Targeted livelihood programming for over **1,500** refugee youth.



Waste management initiatives in refugee camps and El Ferdous settlement.



Shelter replenishment and rehabilitation for **7,500** refugee families, and vulnerable host community members.



Education access and school retention support for nearly 13,000 out-of-school refugee children.



KHARTOUM



Case management for at-risk refugee children, including UASC, SGBV survivors and children living with disabilities.



Strengthened community outreach and support to increase access to registration.



Shelter materials for over **11,000** refugee families and vulnerable host community households.



Household latrine construction in Naivasha and Bantiu 'Open Areas'.



Textbooks, uniforms and school supplies to support retention of **2,000** refugee children and vulnerable host community students

WHITE NII F



Peaceful coexistence initiatives to address host community tension and resolve implementation issues.



Sustained CMAM programming in all camps to reduce malnutrition among refugee children and PLW.



Latrine desluding across all camps to mitigate sanitation gaps.



Construction of **3,600** household latrines to improve access for over **18,000** refugees.

SOUTH KORDOFAN



Scale-up of SGBV prevention and response for over 26,000 vulnerable refugees, and child protection services for 1,100



Improve access to primary health services and medical referrals for over **35,000** refugees.



Improving water supply access for **21,000** refugees and their host communities in Gedied, Qurayd, Dar Batti and Al Amira.



School rehabilitation and enrolment support to improve access for $\bf 9,500$ out-of-school refugee children.
