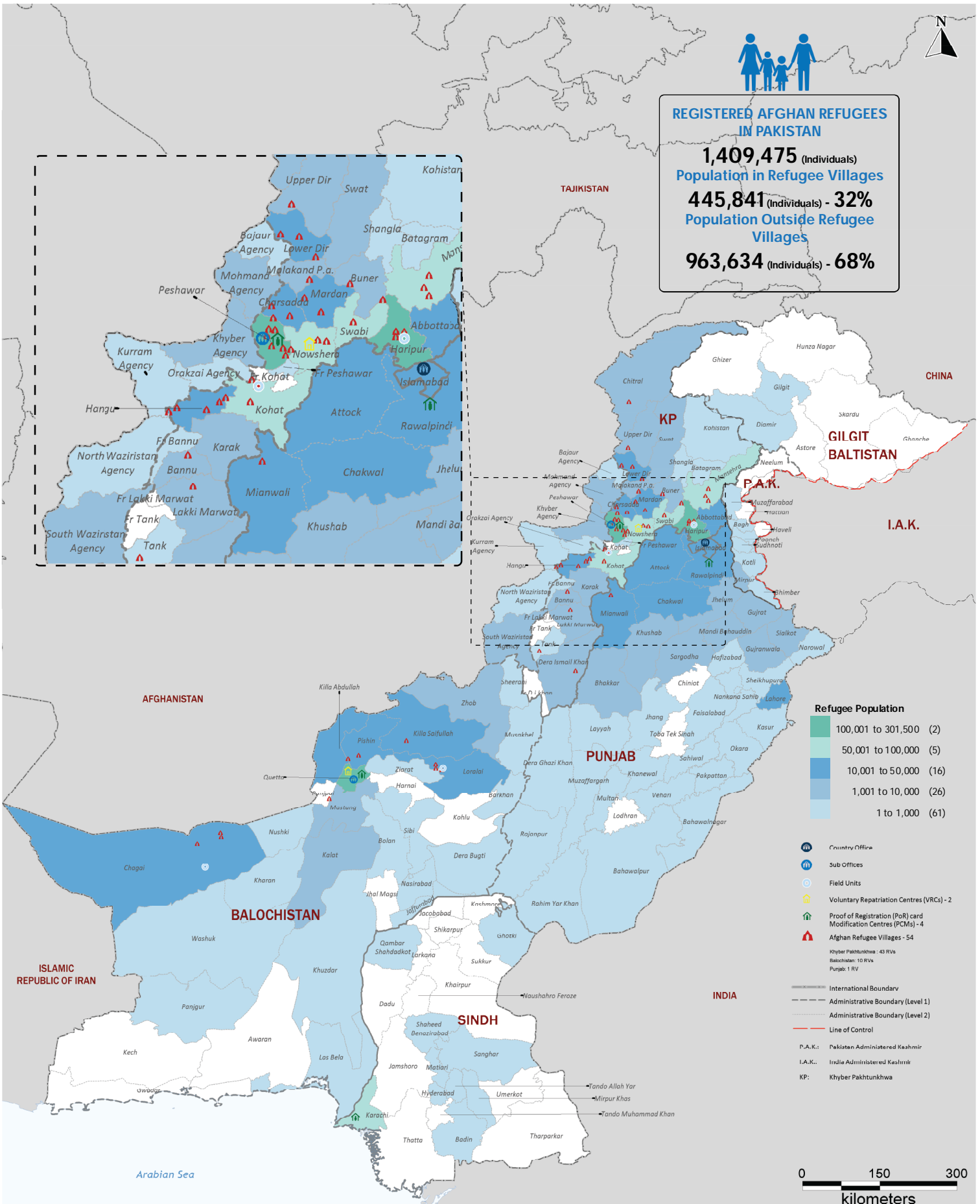

REGISTERED AFGHAN REFUGEES IN PAKISTAN

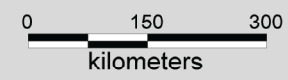
