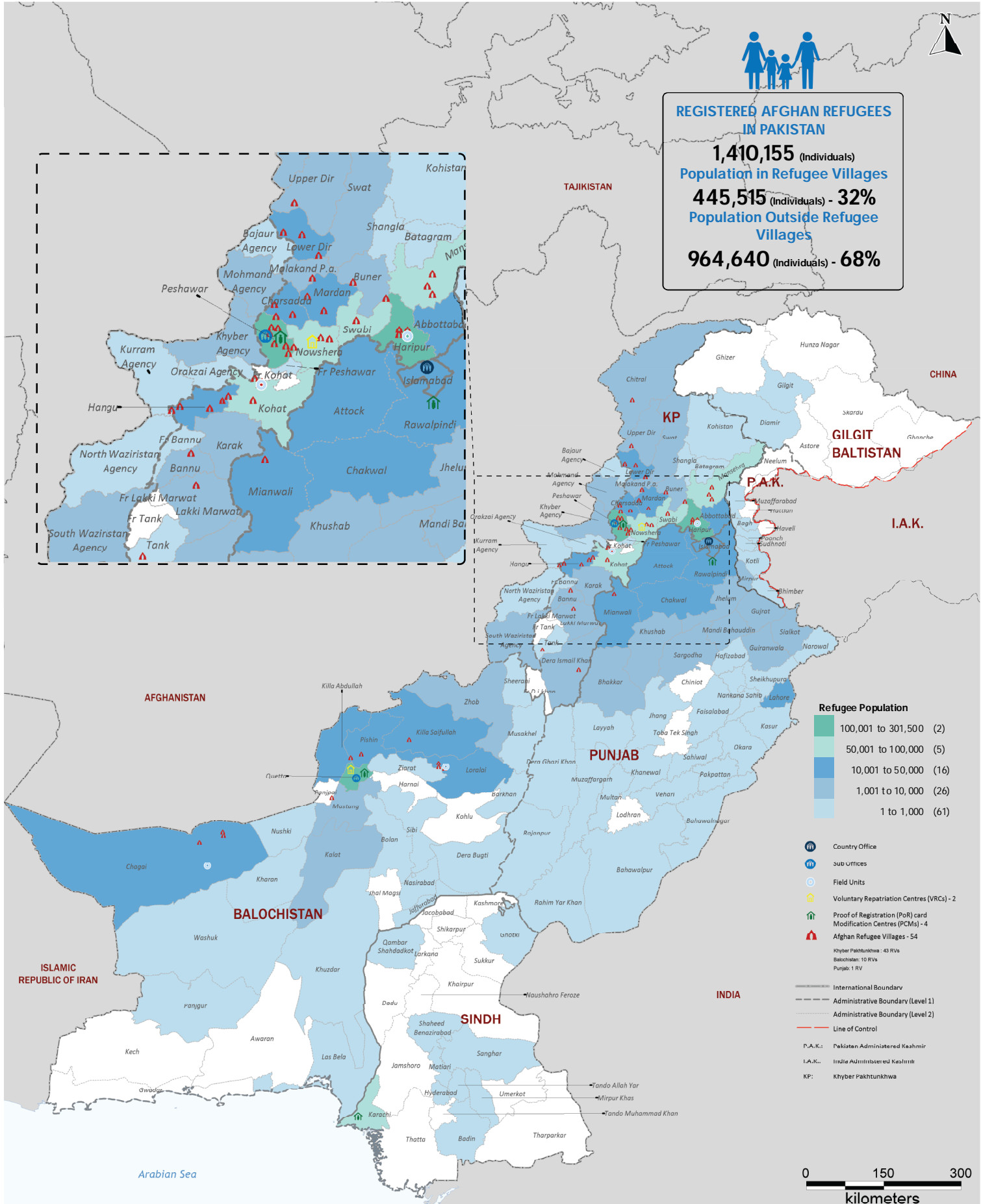


# Pakistan: Overview of Afghan Refugee Population and UNHCR Operational Presence | as 31st of Aug, 2019

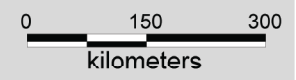
