

TRI-CLUSTER COVID-19 STRATEGY

In collaboration with the **Health and WASH Clusters** the **UNHCR-led Tri-Clusters** will work to support the most at risk IDP communities prone to COVID-19.

The **community-managed strategy** aims to support limited health facility capacity through preventive measures and reduce transmission.

Hand Washing Stations will be set-up for people in **600 IDP sites**



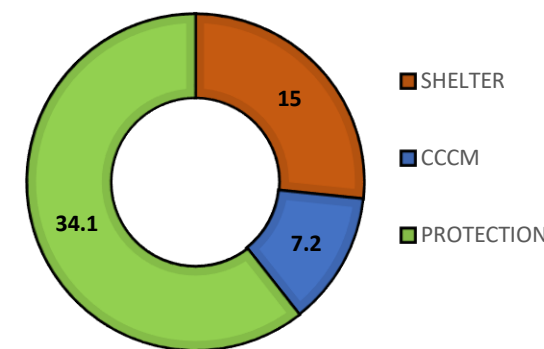
People living in 600 IDP sites will be less at risk due to decongestion measures being taken



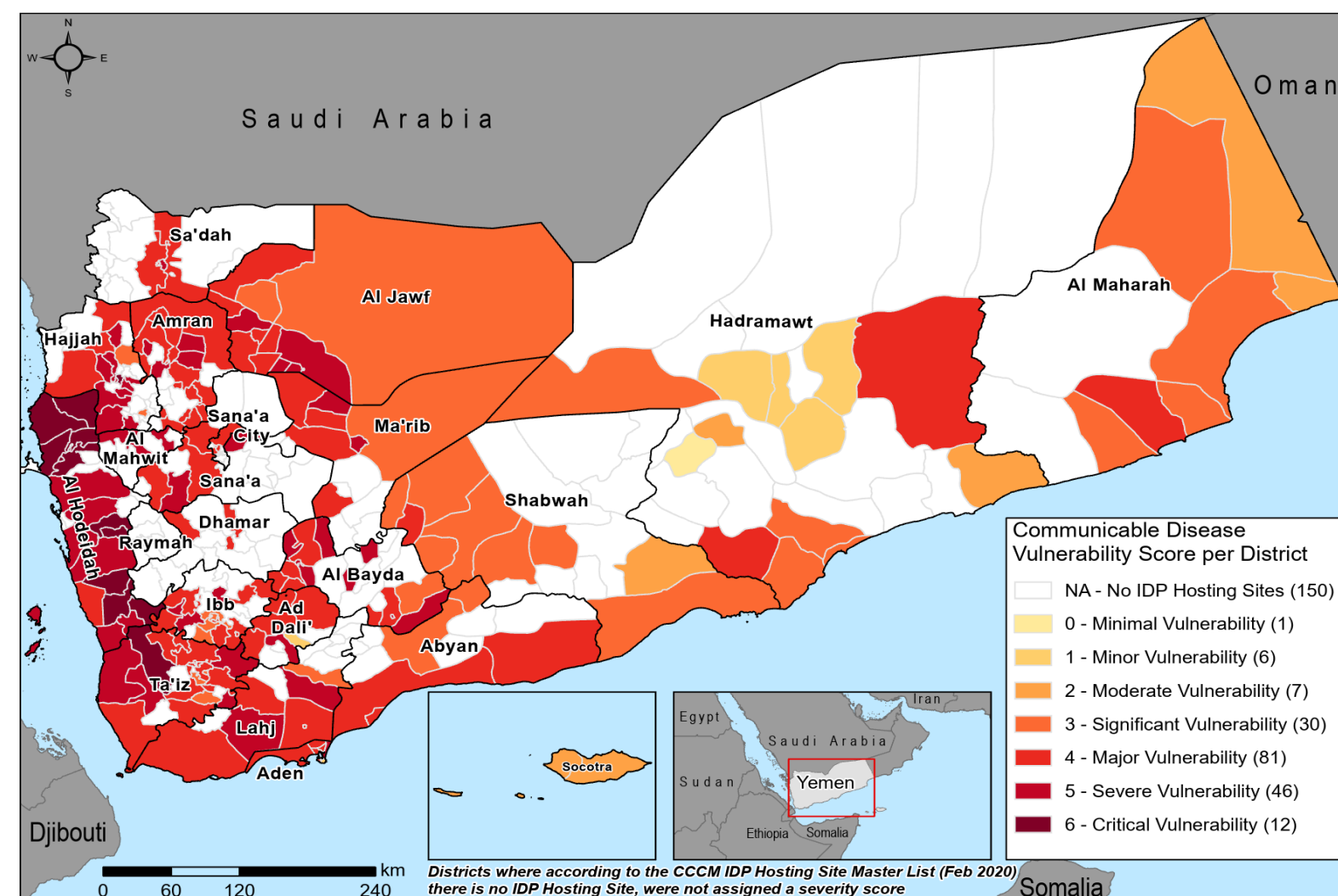
IDP site community networks will support **prevention and symptomatic identification**
