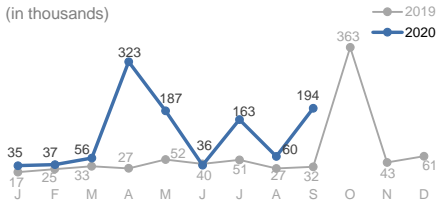

**302,000** (Jan - Sep 2019)

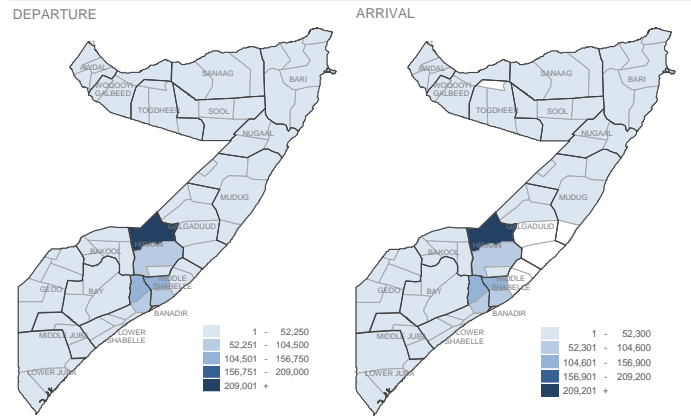
The UNHCR-led PRMN implemented in partnership with NRC reported 194,000 new internal displacements in the month of September 2020. Of these, 167,000 were triggered by flood, 17,000 conflict/insecurity and 9,000 related to drought or lack of livelihoods.

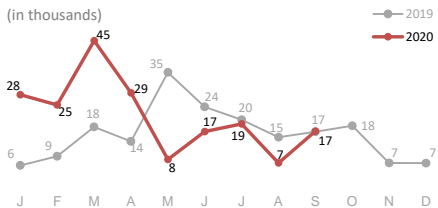

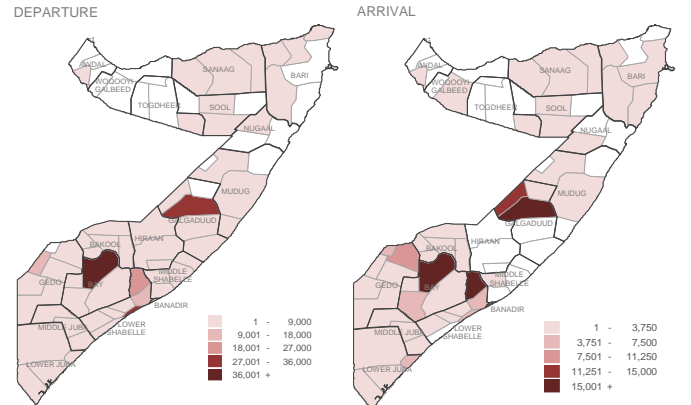
Major displacements (10,000) occurred in Dhuusamarreeb district of Galgaduud region, due to clan conflict. In addition, close to 3,000 individuals were displaced in Lower Shabelle due to military offensive activity.

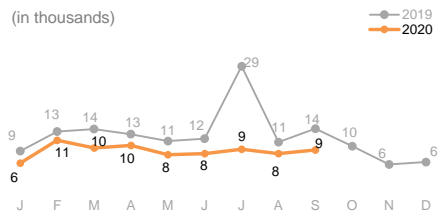

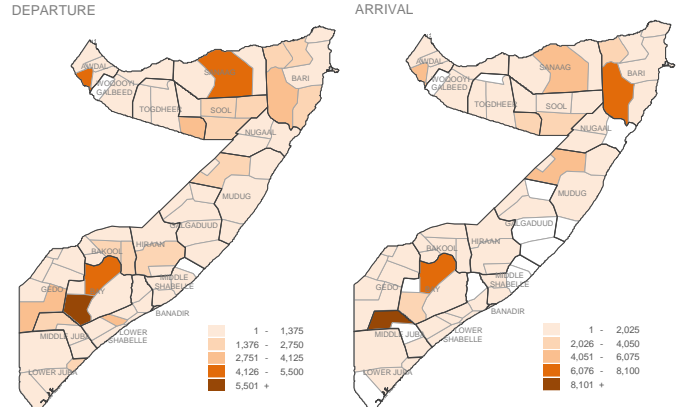
During the month, Sool (2,000) and Bay (1,200) regions were the most affected by new displacements where the main reason given was lack of livelihoods. In the same month, over 2,600 persons were displaced especially in Sool due to lack of livelihoods related to locust.

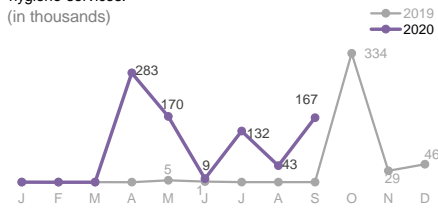

**FLOOD DISPLACEMENTS**

**167,000** in September  
**804,000** (Jan - Sep 2020)  
**7,000** (Jan - Sep 2019)

In September, 167,000 persons were displaced due to floods mostly in Wanla Weyne (93,000) district of Lower Shabelle region, Jowhar (41,000) in Middle Shabelle region and Belet Weyne district of Hiraan regions. The key priority needs for the affected small-scale farmers, livestock producers and traders included shelter, food, safe drinking water, mosquito nets and hygiene services.



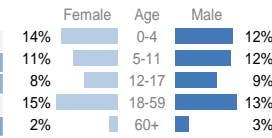

**About PRMN**

The PRMN (Protection & Return Monitoring Network) is a UNHCR-led project which identifies and reports on displacements (including returns) of populations in Somalia. The network also identifies and reports on protection risks and incidents underlying such movements. Only figures collected by PRMN are reported above. Not all displacements in Somalia are captured. This dashboard should be read in conjunction with the Notes on PRMN Methodology (<https://data2.unhcr.org/en/documents/details/53888>) which outline the approach and certain limitations. The figures shown are for numbers of individuals and are based on interviews with key informants and/or displaced households at destination (unless otherwise noted).
