


Applications by Year and Month



## Summary of key trends observed

- In October, 5,611 persons in mixed movements arrived in the region, which is 26% lower than in September (7,532). October usually marks the decrease in the flow of mixed movements due to winter and harsh cold temperatures in the region.
- This month, 209 persons filed an asylum application (compared to 154 in September). Only 10 % of the expressed intentions to seek asylum were formalized into actual asylum claims.. Overall, since January 2020, 4,289 asylum applications have been lodged in the region.
- In October, 8 new positive first-instance decisions (6 refugee status and 2 subsidiary protection status) were handed. In 2020, 27 persons have been granted refugee status and 39 persons subsidiary protection status, while 146 applications were rejected. In addition, 2,314 submissions were closed after the applicants absconded the asylum procedure. In October, the authorities in the SEE region conducted 48 interviews (total of 237 for 2020). This year the average number of interviews conducted monthly is 26, which is lower in comparison with the 2019 average (34.5 per month).
- At the end of October, 785 decisions were still pending (5.6% more than in September (741)).
- In 2020, 12% (497) of all applications have been submitted by women and 21% (873) by children, including 124 unaccompanied and separated children (UASC) (14.2% of the children in total). The trends in October show an increase in the number of of single men in the mixed movements.









#### Monthly New Intentions to Seek Asylum by Reporting Country








#### Monthly New Asylum Applications by Country of Origin (Top 10)




## Monthly Interviews by Country of Asylum

#### Monthly Otherwise Closed Applications by Nationality (Top 10)


