





Age and Gender Breakdown of Families




Marital Status of the Interviewed




Age and Gender Breakdown of the Interviewed






Assessed Households by District



Displacemnt in Marib by Governroate of Origin









Average Monthly Income by Household






Households Intentions for the next 6 Months (IDPs and Returnees Only)




Type of Assitance Needed (If willing to Return for IDPs)




Main reasons for displacement (IDPs and Returnees)











Households threatened with eviction from their current shelter in the last 6 months











Households possesing documents on their house or land in the area of origin (out of the IDPs Households)



Status of the house or land in the area of origin (for IDPs)








Who is Responsible of Collecting Water/Firewood



Sanitation Facilities Near the Shelter




Average Time Needed to Collect Water




Types of Sanitation Facilities Near the Shelter


Households Recommended for General Protection Referral (of Total Households)
