








Feedback received from the community:

- Community members were dissatisfied with the duplication cases, as some of shops owners are having job opportunities as well.
- Community members were dissatisfied with some cases who didn't take the whole break of service and getting a new IBV opportunity and they ask to have more monitoring for IBV's hiring and break of service process.
- Some community members were dissatisfied with long contracts and the exceptional cases, as they provided some feedback about difficult financial situation and long work contracts are affecting the situation to be more complicated.
- Community members requested to have an office or hotline for IBV allowing them to talk as the most frequent feedback we receiving every day through different channels that community members don't know where to go, or who is the responsible focal point for each agency, also if their application actually stored in the data base of each organization.
