

# Aegean Islands Weekly Snapshot

#### **Arrivals**

This week, 153 people arrived on the Aegean islands, an increase from last week's 64 arrivals and an increase from last year's 2 arrivals, during the same period.

The average daily arrivals on all islands this week equaled 22, compared to 9 in the previous week.

### **Entry Points by Sea**

Dodecanese islands received the highest number of arrivals (56), followed by Lesvos (36), Samos (35) and Chios (26).



This week, 79 refugees and asylum-seekers, once authorized by the authorities, departed from the Aegean islands to the mainland.


## Present Population on the Islands

Some 6,650 refugees and asylumseekers reside on the Aegean islands. Of those, some 4,700 (71%) reside in the permanent and temporary Reception and Identification Centers (RICs).

The majority of the population on the Aegean islands are from Afghanistan (48%), Syria (13%) and DRC (10%).

Women account for 21% of the population, and children for 29% of whom nearly 7 out of 10 are younger than 12 years old.

Approximately 12% of the children are unaccompanied or separated, mainly from Afghanistan.
