

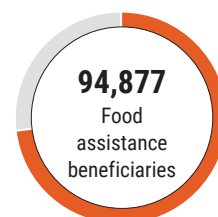
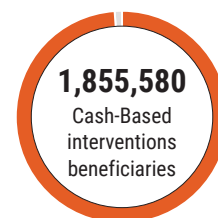


SECTOR ACHIEVEMENTS

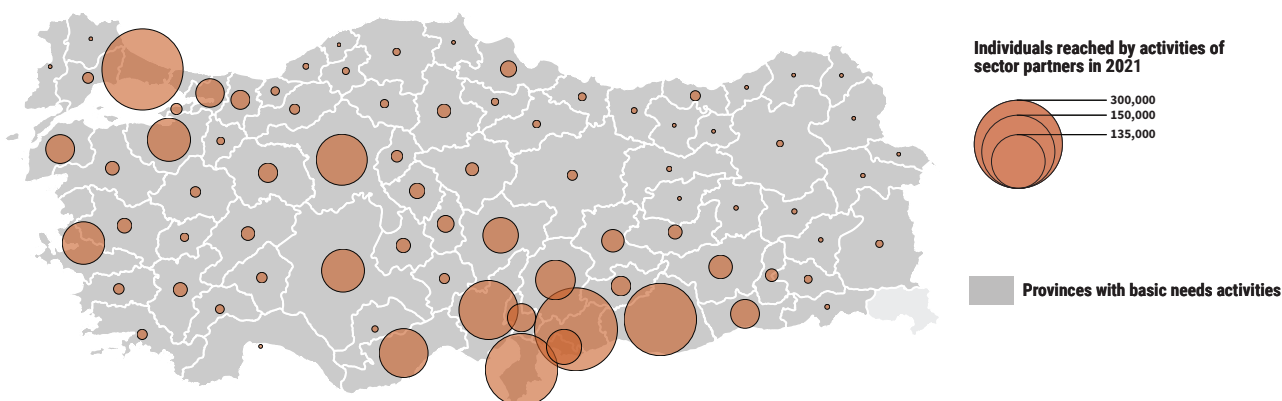
In the first quarter of 2021, Basic Needs sector partners cumulatively reached over 2 million refugees through cash-based interventions, shelter assistance, NFI distributions and food assistance. Partners observed continuation of increased need for support in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic. Basic Needs assistance was delivered to the targeted beneficiaries without interruption; however, it was observed that some of the activities marked less progress than expected during the first quarter of the year Basic needs assistance through municipalities continued to be provided.

Through their monthly and one-time cash support, Basic Needs sector partners cumulatively reached 1,855,580 million refugees nation-wide; including the ESSN programme. The Emergency Social Safety Net (ESSN) programme extended support to refugees in meeting their daily needs though multi-purpose and monthly cash assistance and reached 1.82 million individuals. In the first quarter of the year, nearly 39 thousand individuals received one-time complementary cash assistance.

Shelter activities of the sector partners aiming to facilitate the ability of the targeted beneficiaries to live in adequate shelter conditions by ameliorating buildings and public spaces to the benefit of both refugees and local host communities continued, reaching 4,313 individuals. During the first quarter of 2021, Basic Needs sector partners' food assistance activities continued and reached 94,817 individuals, achieving nearly three-fourths of the annual sector target. NFI activities of the sector partners including the distribution of gender-appropriate hygiene kits reached 104,213 beneficiaries in total in the first quarter of the year.
