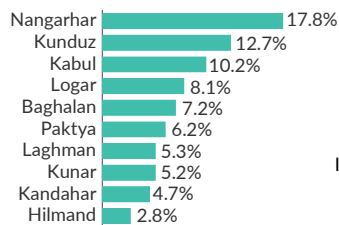

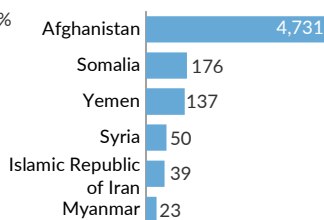

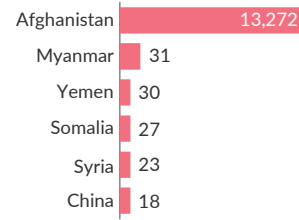

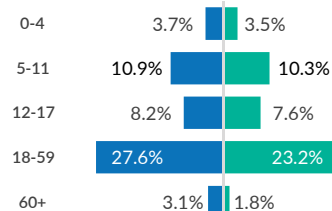

AGE AND GENDER COMPOSITION



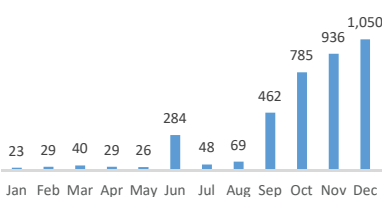

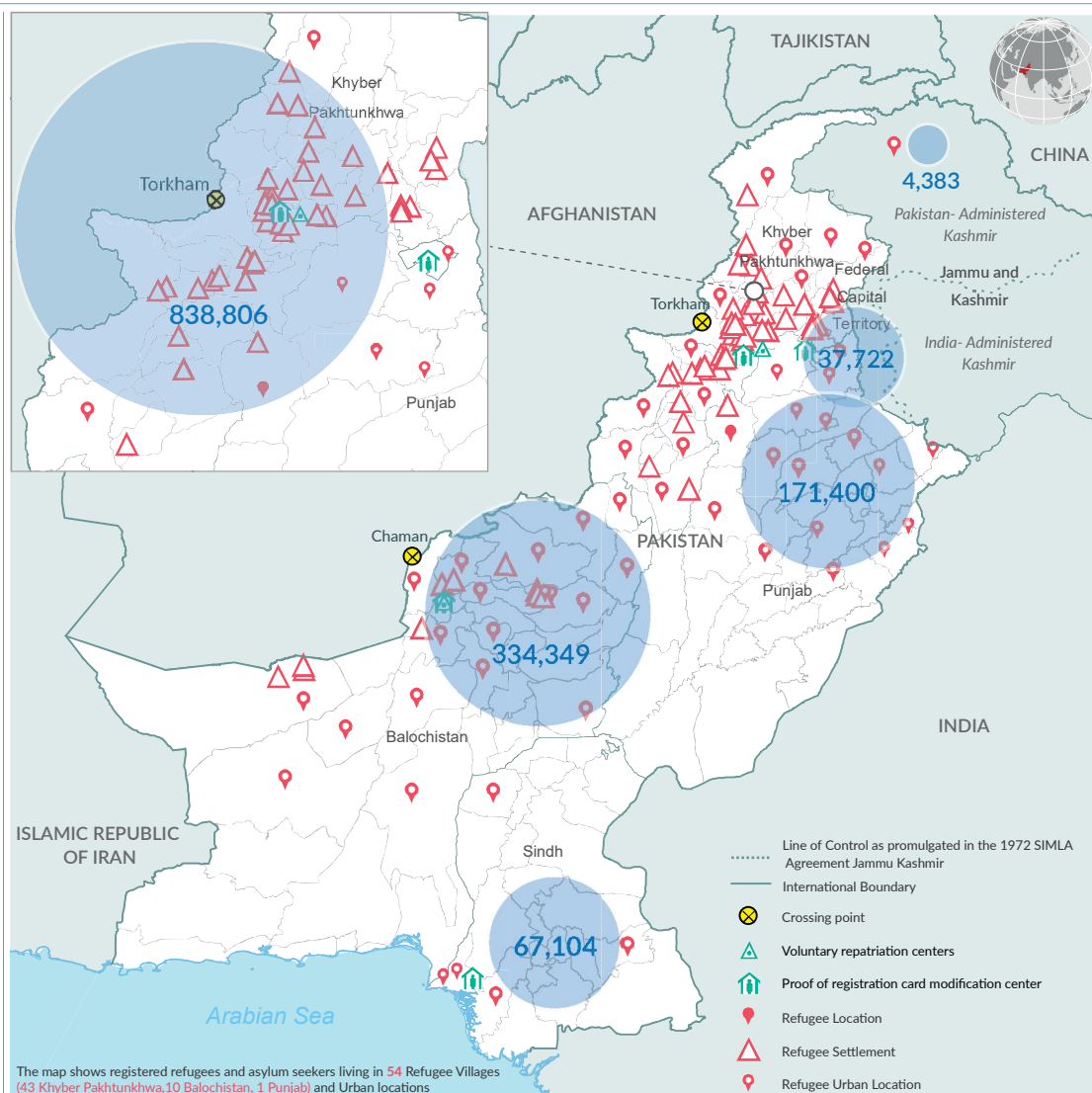

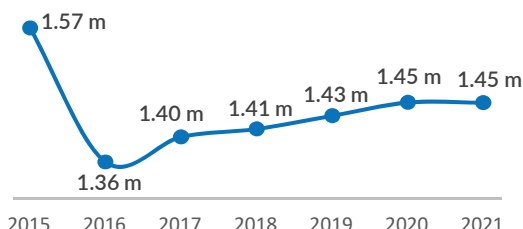

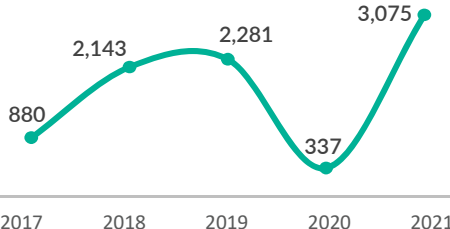

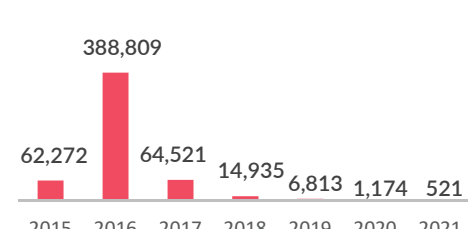
POPULATION TREND SINCE 2015
