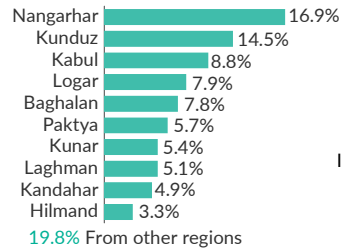

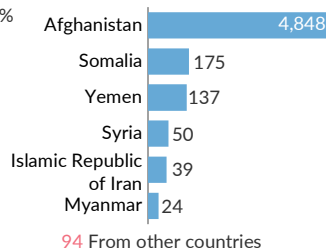

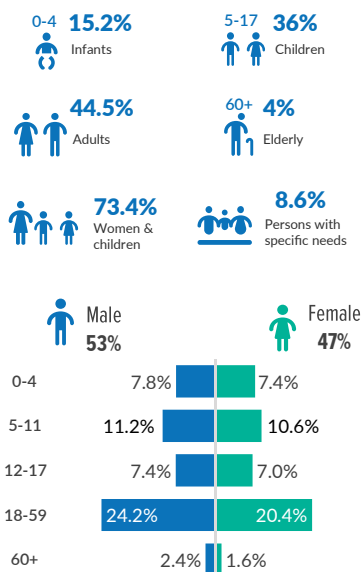

AGE AND GENDER COMPOSITION

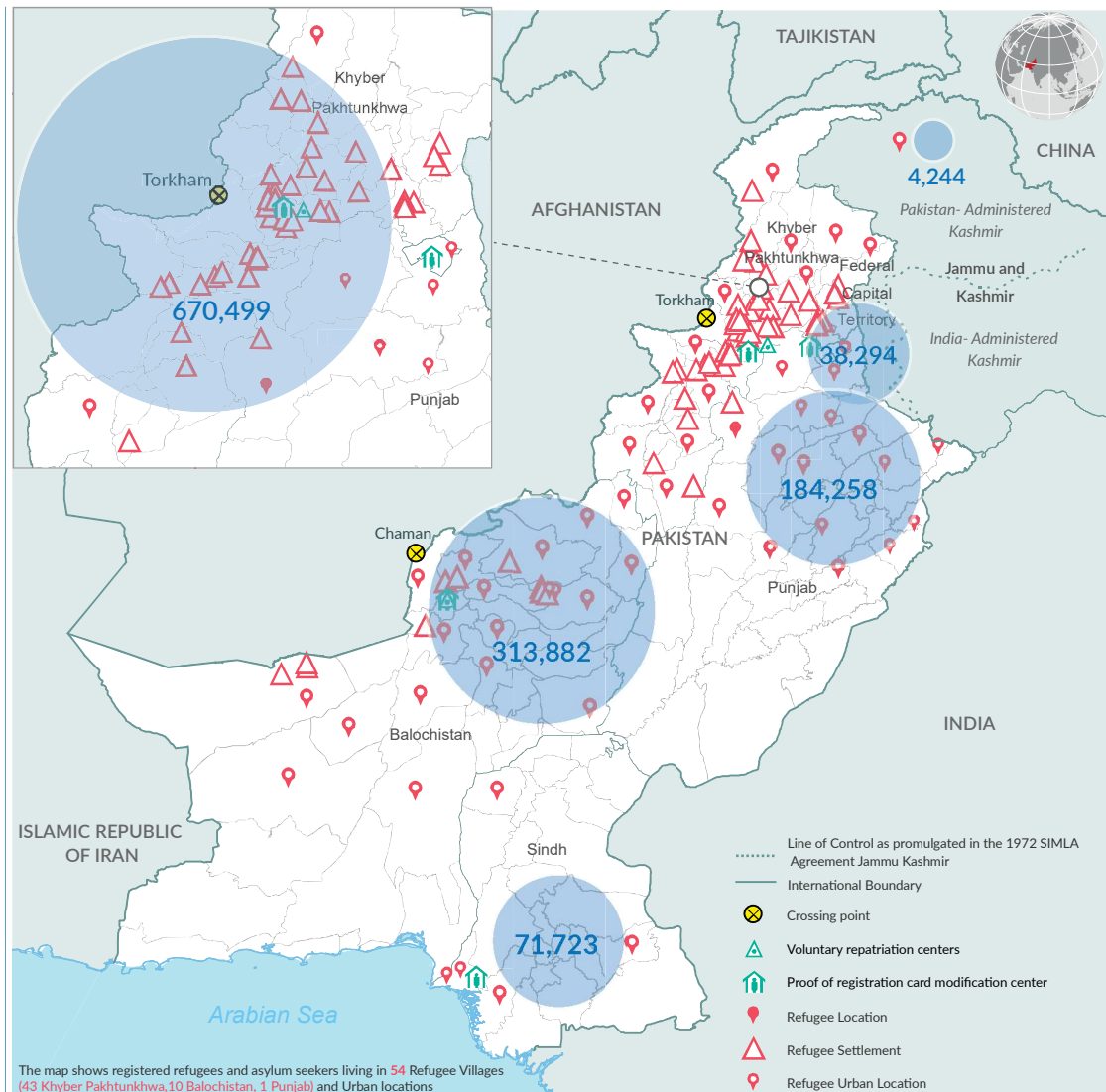

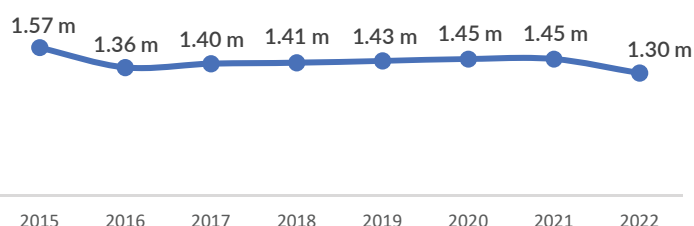

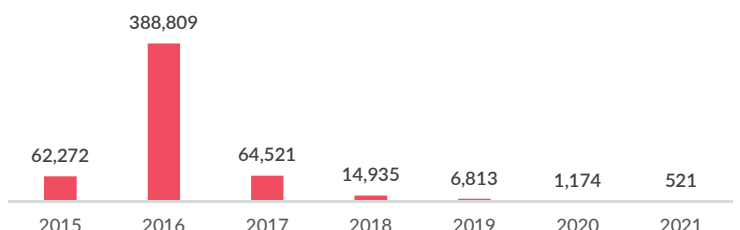
