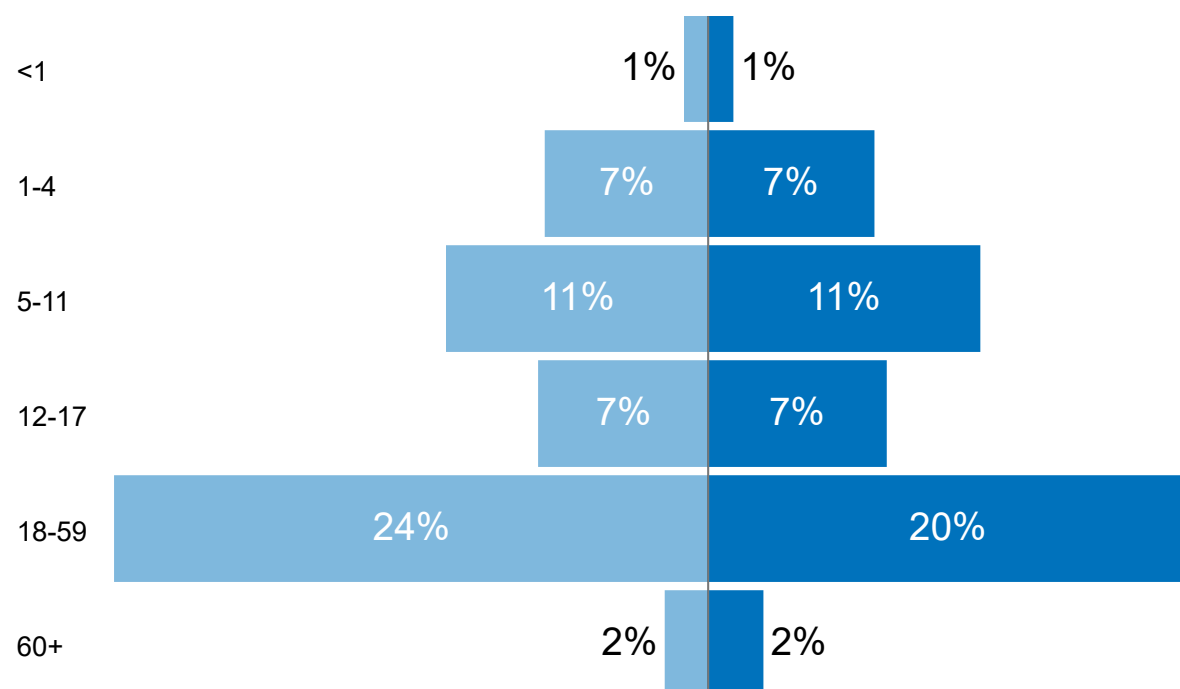

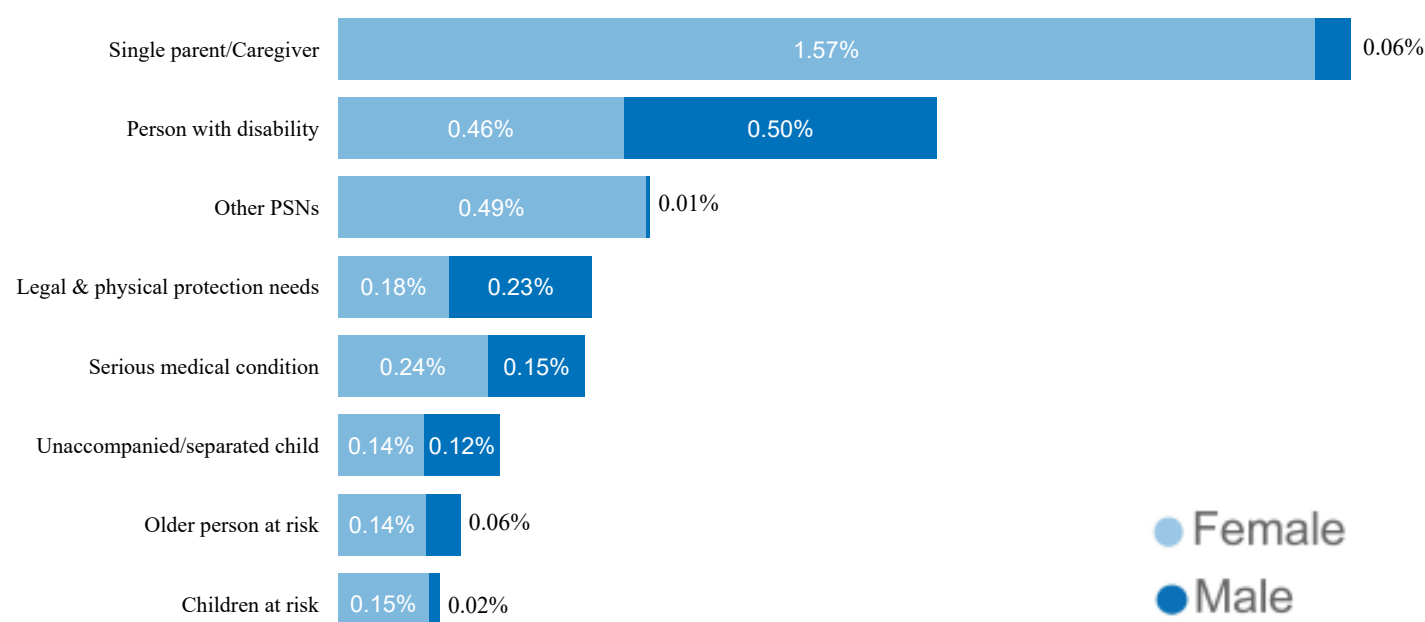

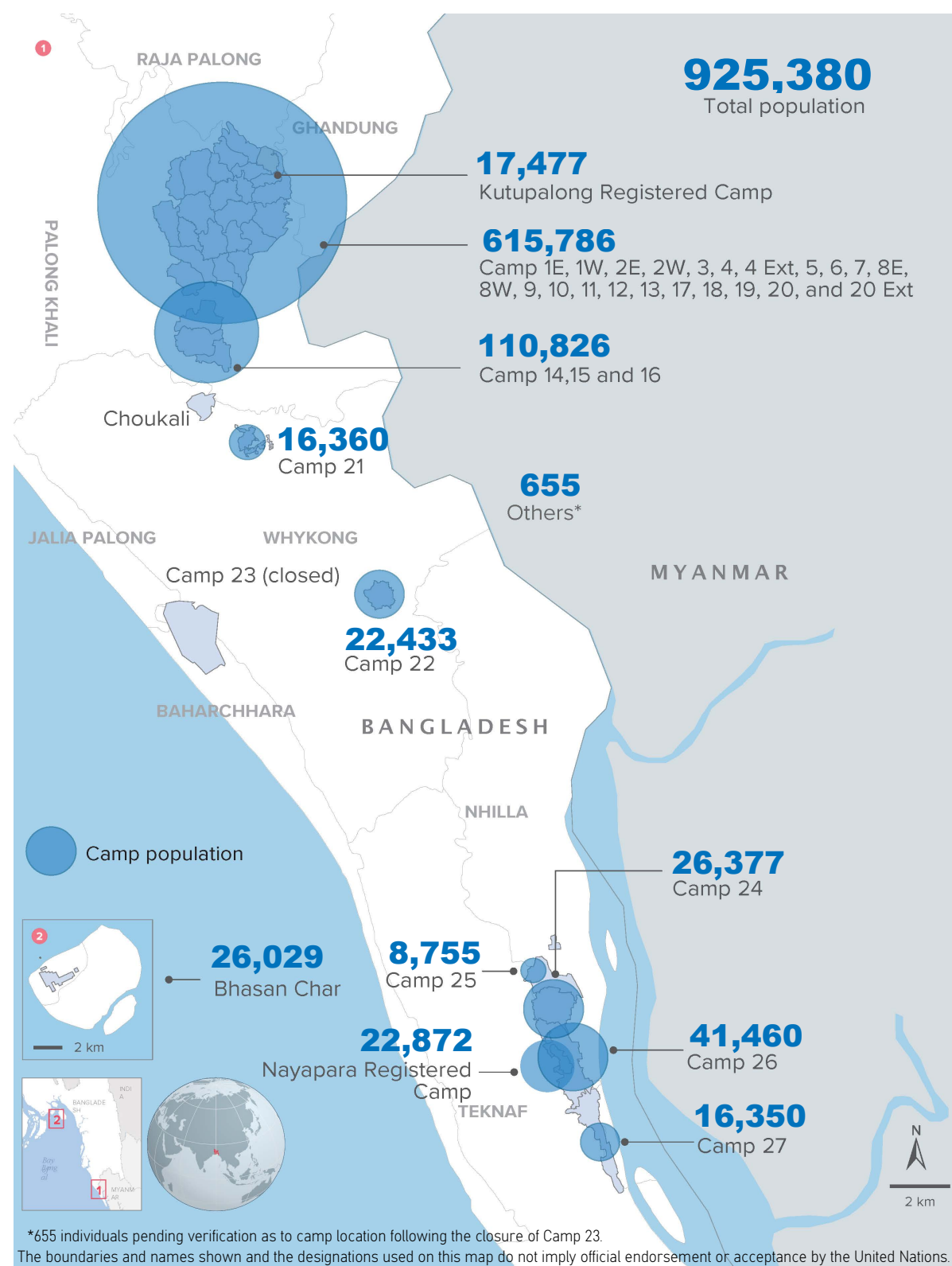


Specific needs ³

4.05% of total individuals have been identified with at least one specific need.

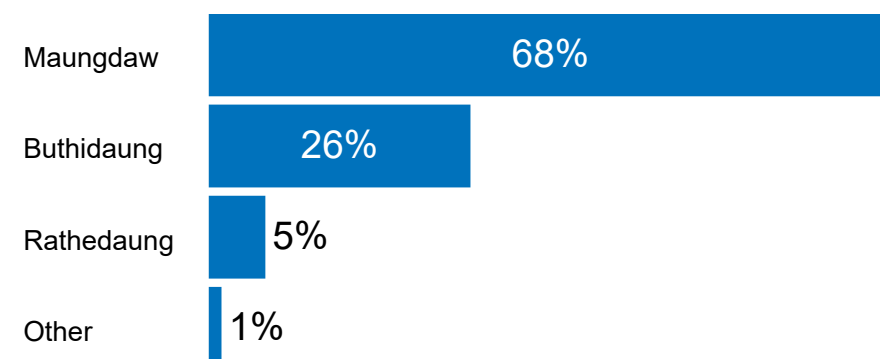


Rohingya Population by Location



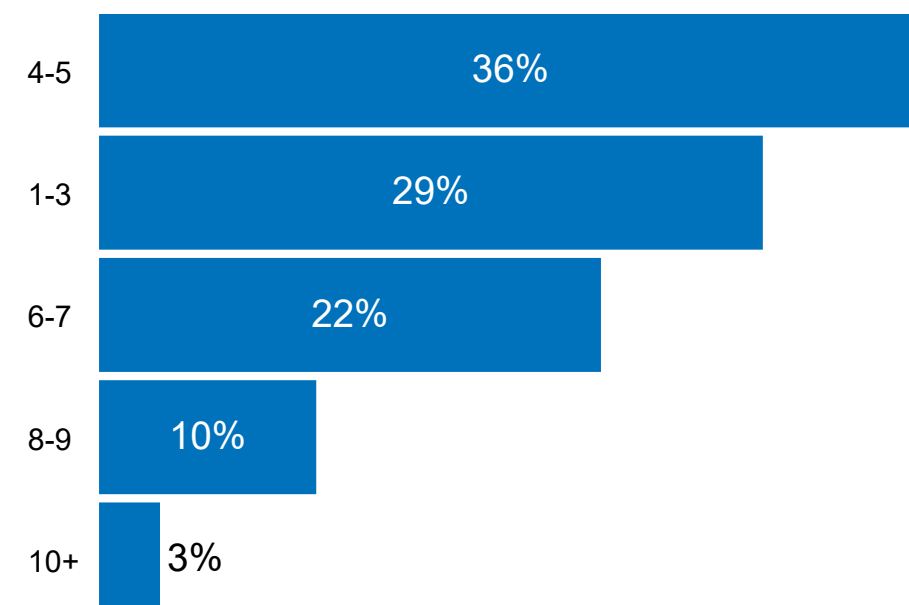
Place of origin
