The analyses have been conducted by duly considering the bank reports related to the pre- and post-disaster periods. It should be noted that the scope and the findings of the analyses are subject to revision and modification as new data is acquired.




INTRODUCTION

It is imperative to bolster management processes with the requisite analytical tools to enhance the effectiveness of cash assistance programmes aimed at supporting victims of the Kahramanmaraş earthquake that occurred on 06.02.2023. The Product and Information Management team is currently engaged in conducting analyses that will support end-to-end cash assistance scenarios, spanning from data entry to payment stages. The key objective of these analyses is to facilitate the efficient execution of cash assistance programmes by leveraging precise geographical and numerical data to identify the affected region and uncovering unique data on bank transfers.

For the preliminary insights into the region, the following overview analyzed by support of KIZILAYKART M&E Team, summarizes general information.

PROFILE OF AFFECTED AREA




The main aim of the analysis was to gain insight into cash assistance strategies and identify trends in the data. Each category was systematically investigated to determine how and for what purpose the data were analyzed. This comprehensive analysis will serve as the foundation for the team's ongoing efforts to enhance the effectiveness of the cash assistance programmes and support the victims of the Kahramanmaraş earthquake in the best possible manner.



Analyses of Bank Reports

Based on an examination of bank reports, the analysis scope has been broadened through the inclusion of expenditure information and account transactions. This enables more detailed inferences to be made, particularly in relation to the Pay Week Loading and Card Usage Analyses, and Card Transactions Analysis for the affected region.


Outlined below are some fundamental aspects of the Pay Week Loading and Card Usage Analyses for the Emergency Social Safety Net (ESSN) Programme and the Complementary Emergency Social Safety Net (C-ESSN) Project between February 28, 2023 and March 6, 2023 and for In-Camp Programme between March 1, 2023 and March 5, 2023.



As of February 2023, the ESSN Programme accounts for 69% of the total monthly payment amount. The total amount loaded for the ESSN Programme in the disaster area is 263,856,200 Turkish Liras. Within this framework, 72% of the beneficiaries fully used the assistance, 18% partially used it, while 10% did not use it at all.


On the other hand, when looking at the statistics of the previous month (January 2023), beneficiaries used 92.51% of the assistance in the first week after receiving assistance. A similar calculation technique was applied for the first payment (February 2023) after the earthquake, and there was no major change for this month.





In February 2023, the total amount loaded of the C-ESSN Project, which constitutes 25.1% of the monthly total payment amount, in the disaster area is 95,949,750 Turkish Liras and the number of households is 43,675. Within this context, 79% of the beneficiaries fully used the assistance, 8% partially used it, while 13% did not use it.

On the other hand, when looking at the statistics of the previous month (January 2023), beneficiaries used 91.87% of the assistance in the first week after receiving assistance. A similar calculation technique was applied for the first payment (February 2023) after the earthquake, and there was no major change for this month.



Finally, total amount loaded of the In-Camp Programme, which constitutes 6% of the monthly total payment amount, in the disaster area is 22,776,150 Turkish Liras and the number of households is 9,684. Also, 79% of the beneficiaries partially used the assistance, 3% fully used it, while 13% did not use it.




The chart below shows that there was a sharp decline in the number of purchases on February 6, 2023 as seen within the framework of the analyzes made for the period between February 6, 2023 and March 6, 2023. From this analysis, it can be understood that there are still shopping areas in these dates in the region.



Within the scope of the withdrawal process, as of February 6, 2023, there was a sharp decrease in withdrawals compared to the previous month, but withdrawals increased with the beginning of the new month. From this analysis, it can be understood that there are still active bank branches or ATMs in the region.


Number of Withdrawals Per Day





As one of the result of analyses, it was found that fewer individuals received their cards during the same time period in newly opened accounts in the earthquake zone compared to the previous month.


People Leaving the Affected Region








The ESSN Programme accounts for 67,5% of the total monthly payment amount in ADANA. The total amount loaded for the ESSN Programme in ADANA is 36,612,900 Turkish Liras, and the number of eligible households is 17,301.

Within this framework, 84% of the beneficiaries fully used the assistance, 10% partially used it, while 6% did not use it at all.



As for the C-ESSN Project, which represents 25.1% of the total monthly payment amount, the total amount loaded is 9,891,300 Turkish Liras, and the number of households is 4,003.

Within this context, 86% of the beneficiaries fully used the assistance, 6% partially used it, while 8% did not use it. From this analysis, it can be understood that there are still shopping areas in these dates in the region.




Withdrawal Transaction Information for Adana Province



Within this framework, 75% of the beneficiaries fully used the assistance, 15% partially used it, while 10% did not use it at all.



































Number of Purchases Per Day







Within this framework, 79% of the beneficiaries fully used the assistance, 9% partially used it, while 12% did not use it at all.


Use of **ESSN** Assistance Amount

















CONCLUSION

Following the devastating Kahramanmaraş earthquake on February 6, 2023, extensive analyses were conducted throughout the bank and card transactions to support the post-disaster efforts of operation and planning, with a focus on KIZILAYKART beneficiaries. The analyses provided crucial insights that shed light on several key issues that arose in the aftermath of the disaster.

For instance, even it is seen that transactions have decreased compared to the past three months in the affected area, it was discovered that a significant portion of the population have been conducting transactions in the affected area, highlighting the fact that 48% of KIZILAYKART beneficiaries in February, 2023 were located in the disaster zone. While this may seem concerning, it is also an indication that the local economy is still functioning to some extent, as evidenced by sales in groceries, clothing, gas stations, and pharmacies, as well as ATMs.

Another important finding was that there was no major change in the usage of ESSN, CESSN, and In-Camp assistances when compared with previous months, and nearly all of the assistance was utilized.

Finally, it was observed that some beneficiaries registered in the affected provinces in pre-disaster period, have transactions in the cities such as Izmir, Kocaeli, Adana, Antalya, Ankara, Gaziantep, Bursa, Mersin, Mardin, and Istanbul. Although this analysis does not mean that these people are still in these cities, it allows us to infer that they have somehow left the affected area.

In sum, the analyses conducted in the aftermath of the Kahramanmaraş earthquake have provided crucial insights into the post-disaster landscape. By continuing to monitor the situation and adjusting strategies as needed, it can be ensured that those who have been affected by this disaster receive the support they need.
