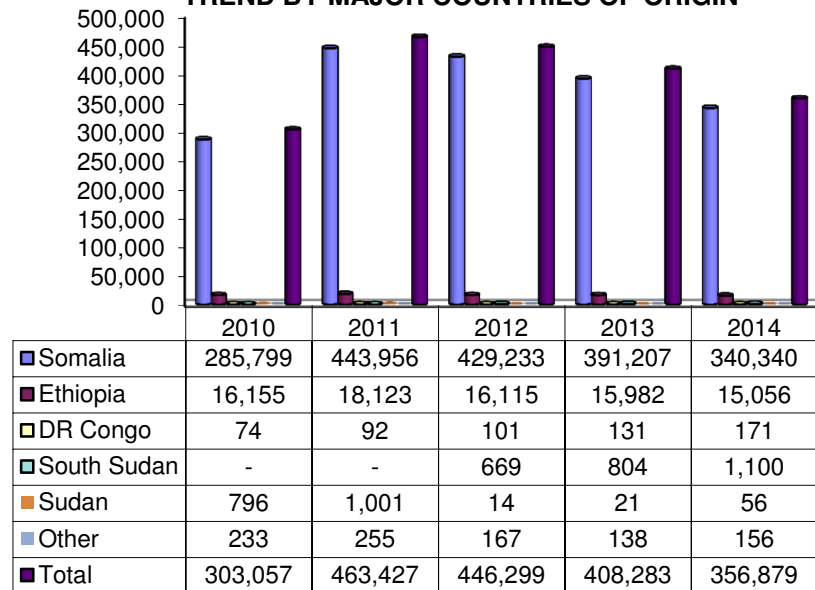

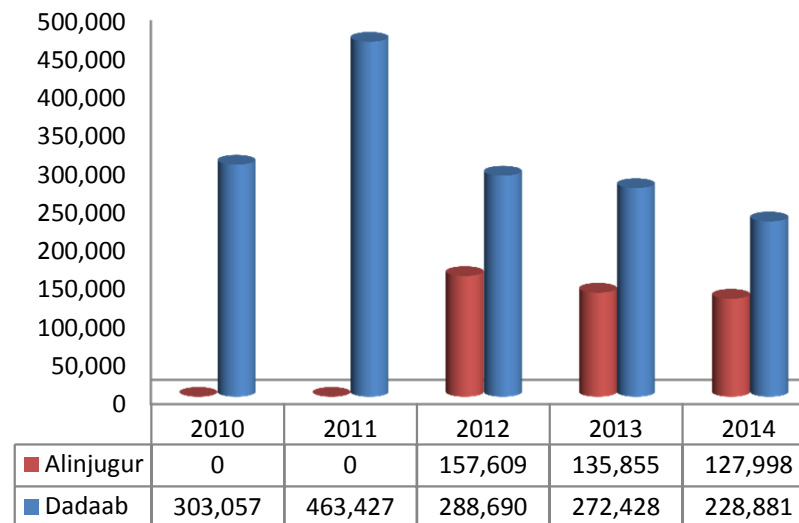

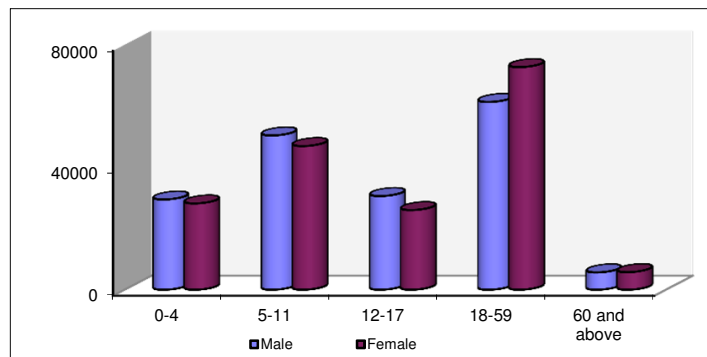

TREND BY LOCATION



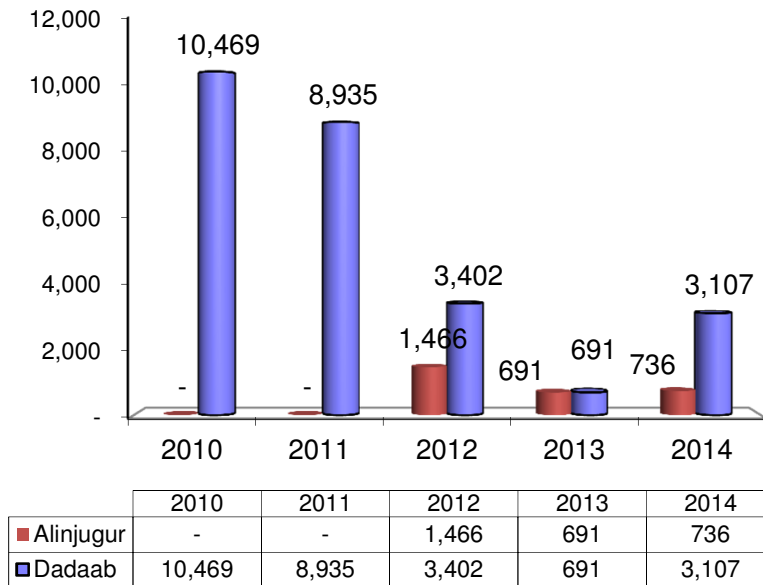
TREND BY MAJOR COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN



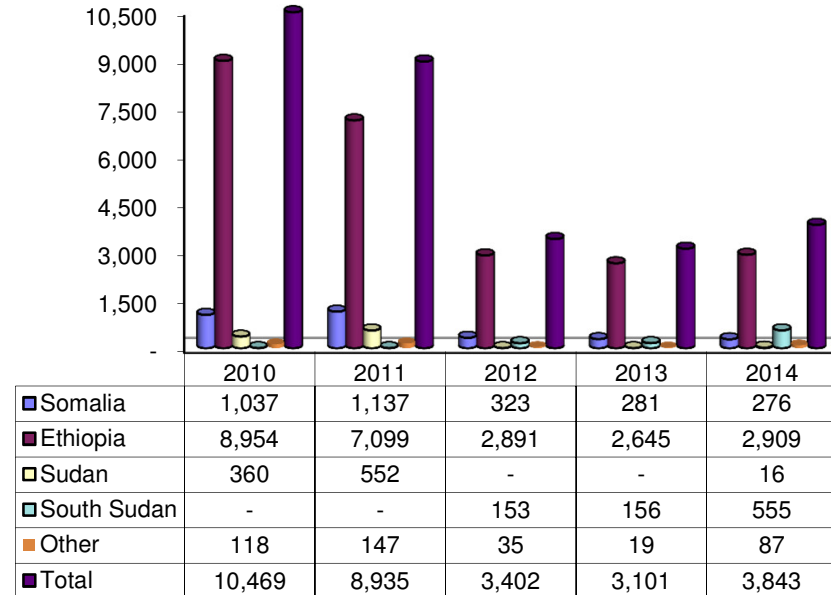

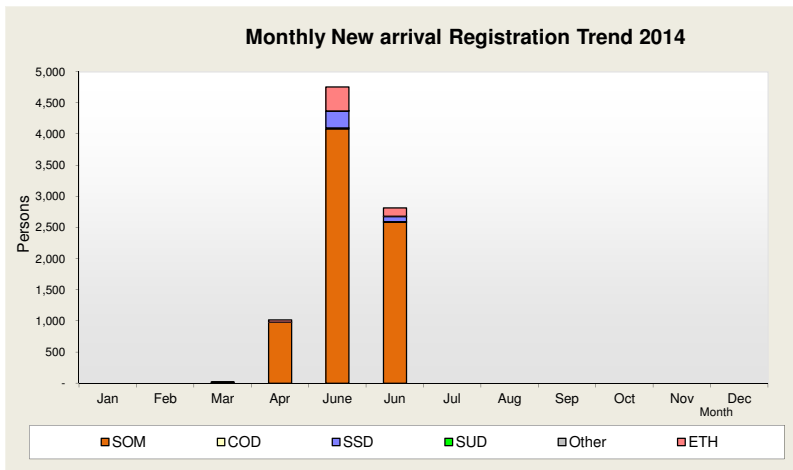


TREND BY MAJOR COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN

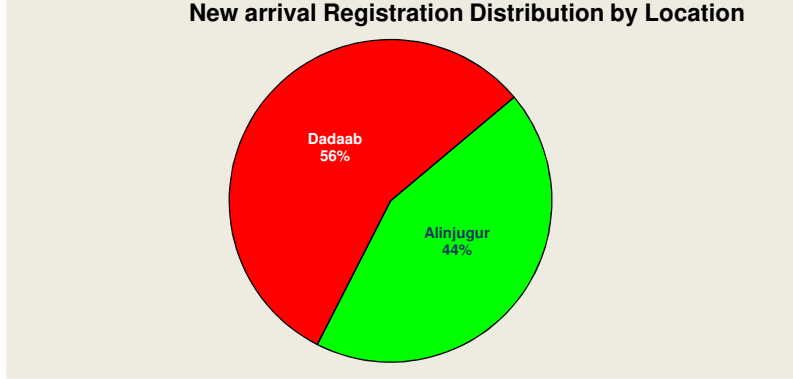

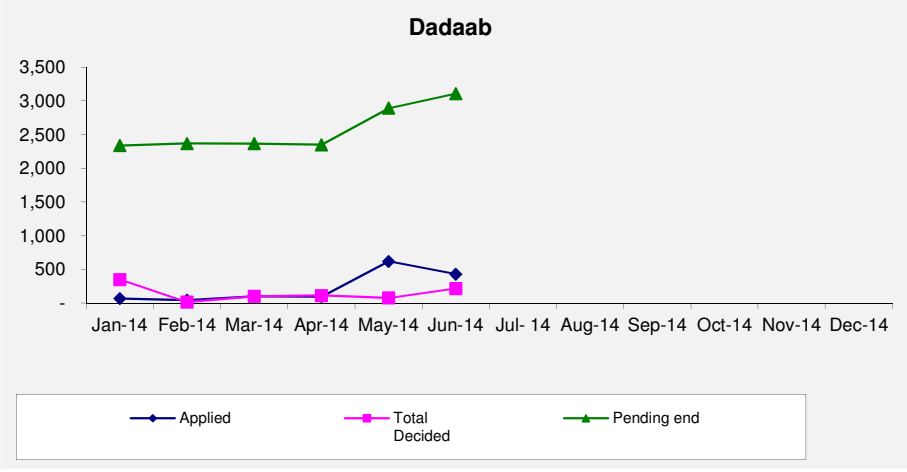


Individual Asylum Applications and Refugee Status Determination Trend - June 2014

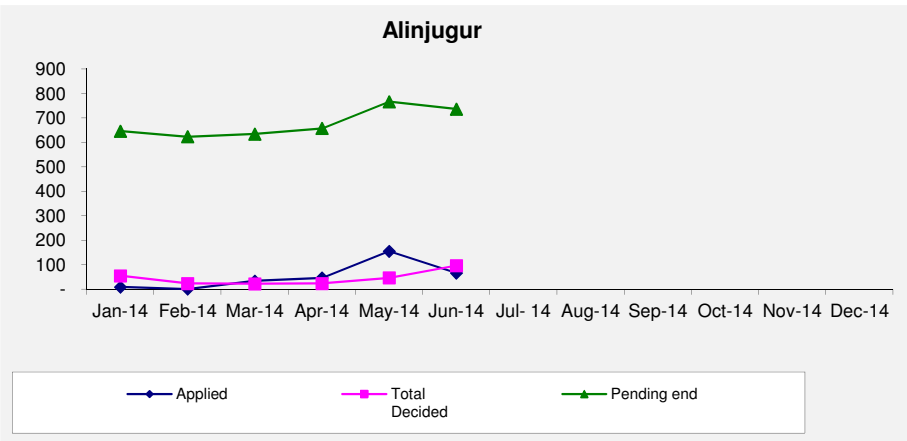

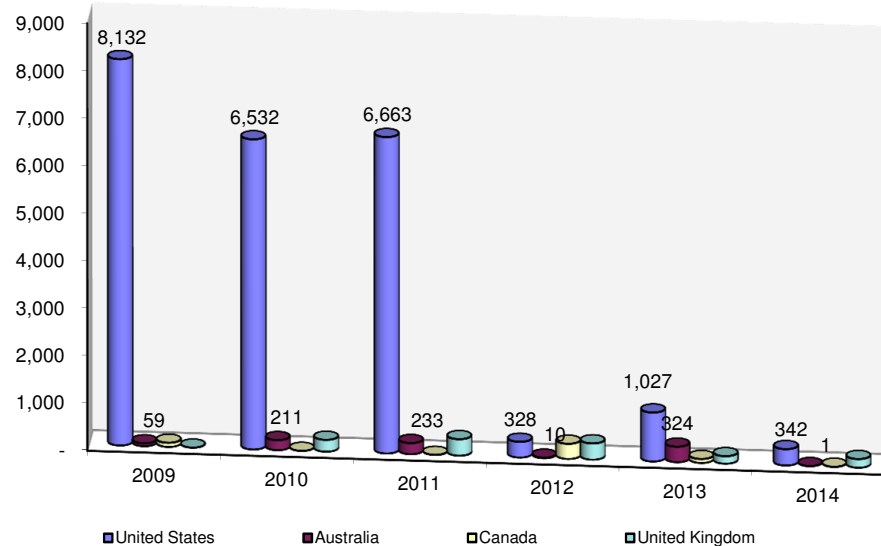

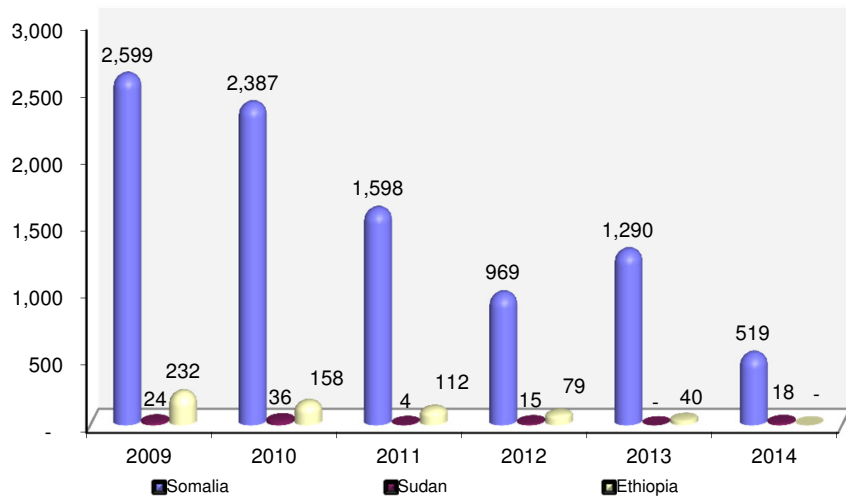

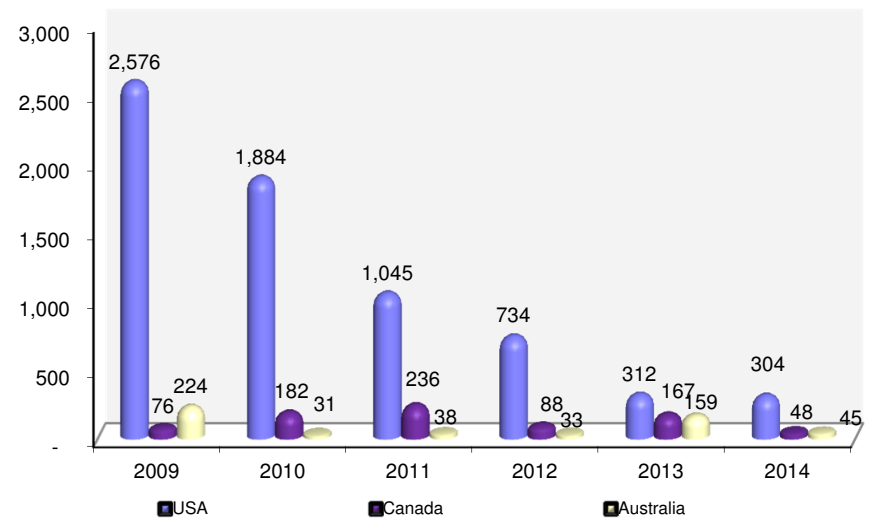

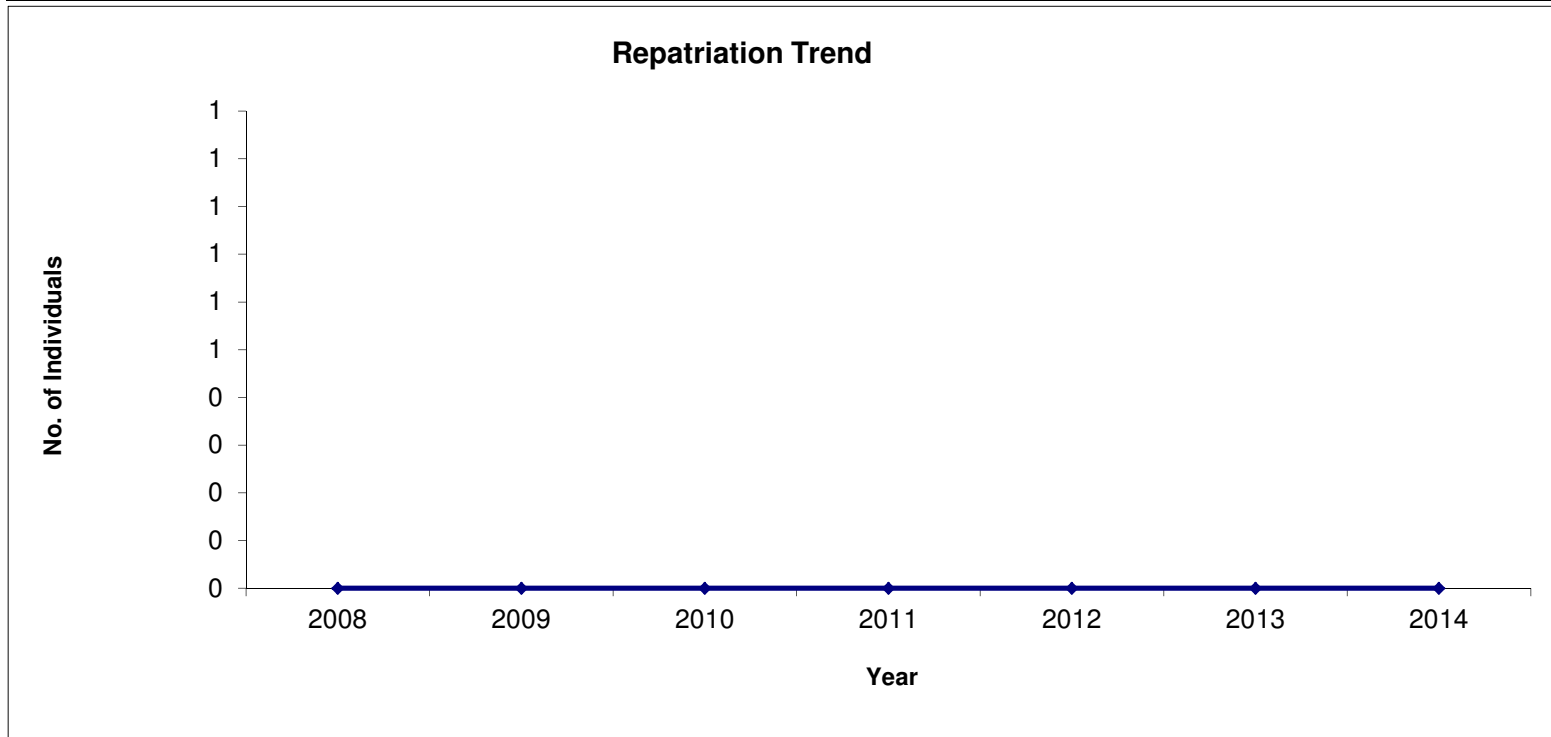

526 individual refugees who approached and benefited from the individual counseling procedures at the RHD believed that there were improved conditions in their places of origin. This accounted for 20% of those individuals who approached the RHD during the period.

• 568 individual refugees who approached the RHD wanted to join their relatives in Somalia This figure presented 21% of the total number of persons counseled so far.

• 2673 individuals approached the Return Help Desk for counseling. 777 Individuals were from Kambioos comprising 29.0% of the total figure; 673 were from Ifo 2 camp comprising 25.1% of the total figure; 464 in Hagadera comprising 17.3% of the total figure, 398 in Dagahaley comprising 14.9% of the total figure and 360 in Ifo1 comprising of 13.5% of the total population that approached the RHD. Among them, 5 individuals stated that they were not willing to go back to Somalia; they comprising of 2 females and 3 males, comprising of 0.2% of those who approached the RHD.

• 106 individuals stated that they were desirous to go back to Somalia due to lack protection and assistance in Kenya. The beneficiaries represented 4 % of the total number of persons who were counseled; they were referred to the Multi-Functional Team based at the UNHCR Field offices for further counseling and assistance.

NB: The Total Figure is greater than the actual number of Persons who visited the RHD since some of the persons have more than one reason as to why they would wish to return to return to Somali. The Increase is as a result of 7 Individuals who have 2 reasons for their desire to return to Somalia from Kambioos.

• 401 out of 645 individuals who wanted to go back to Baidowa originated from there (representing 62%) 793 of 1027 individuals who wanted to go back to Kismayu originated from there Representing 77%; 132 of 208 individuals who wanted to go back to Luuq originated from there representing 63%. Persons who did not originate from the three designated areas were informed that they could not access support from UNHCR during the pilot phase of the spontaneous voluntary return.

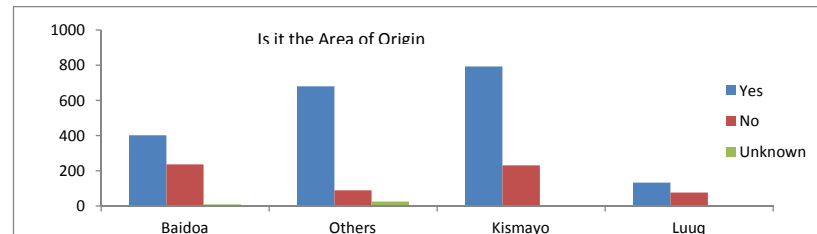
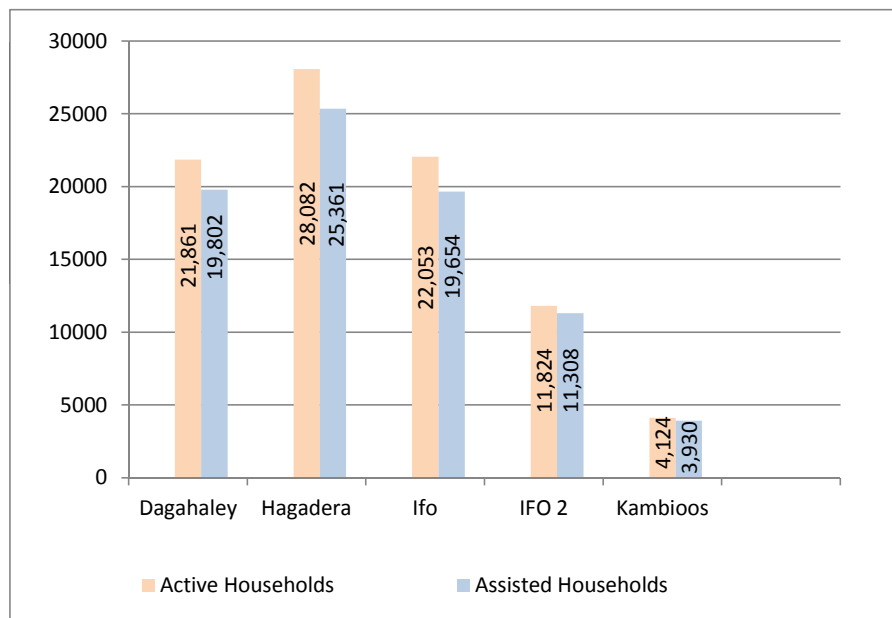

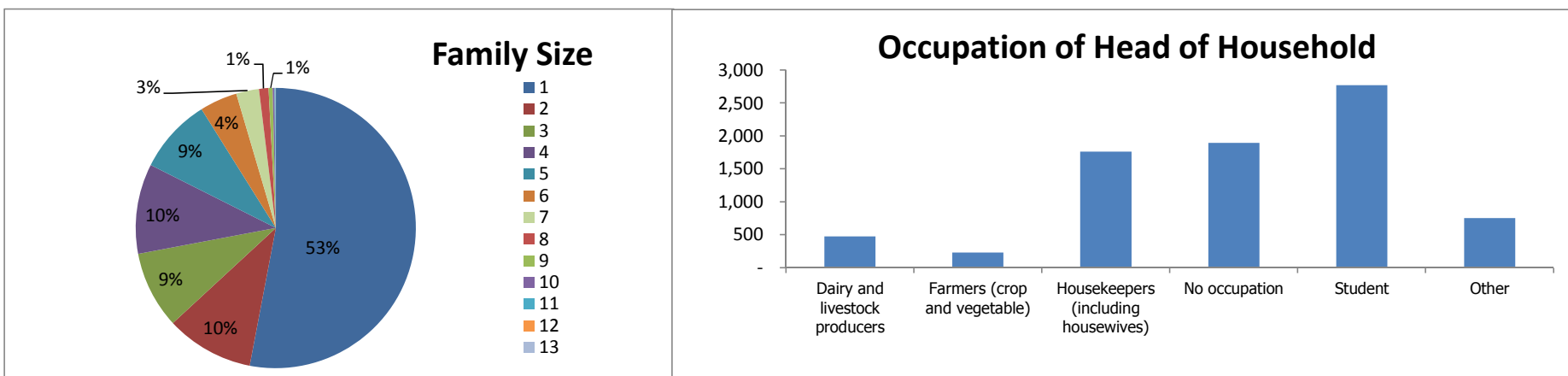

The Active Population Table refers to all persons of concern who were present during the verification exercise and were retained in the UNHCR Database as well as those added during the Continuous Registration process. The Assisted Population Table refers to refugees with valid ration cards which facilitate easy access to all types of assistance in Dadaab, Kenya. During the last General Food Distribution cycle, 06% of the Active Population has not presented itself to collect their food ration by using the WFP Biometric System, this represents 7,889 households comprising of 21,625 individuals.

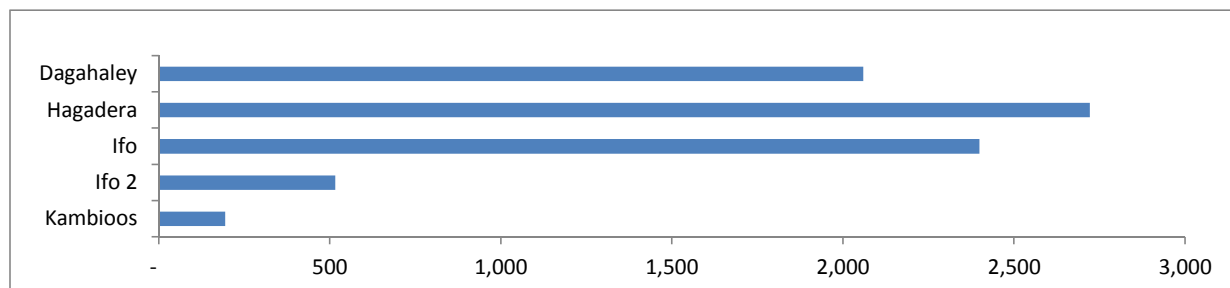
An analysis of this data shows that a number of the individuals in the 7,889 households may be engaged in activities that prevent them from collecting the food ration entitlement. Among those affected are students, housekeepers and health professionals who are continuously on duty in various schools, colleges, hospitals and homes; businessmen, salesmen, street food vendors, hoteliers and waiters are similarly included in that category. The data further shows that some are livestock herders, taxi drivers, and mechanics. All these obligations June preclude them from queuing for long hours to receive food rations.

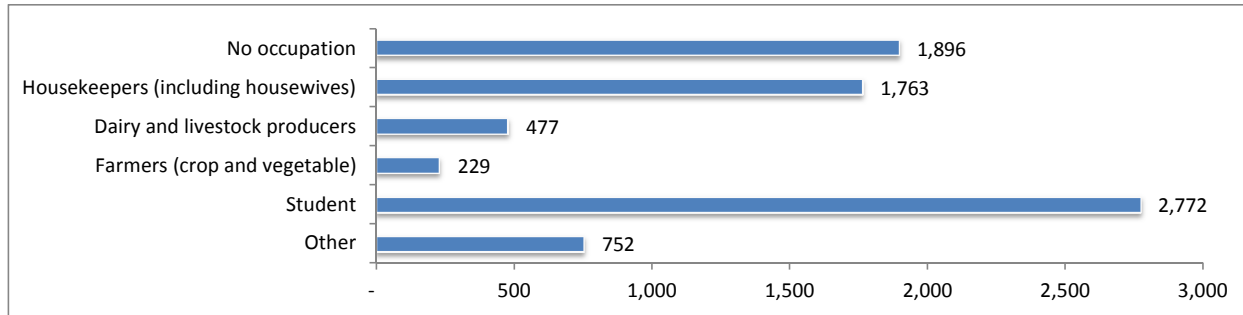

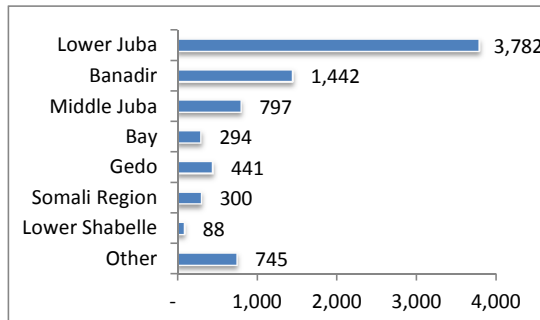

Profile of Households No-Show During June 2014 2nd Food Distribution Cycle

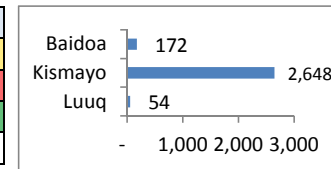

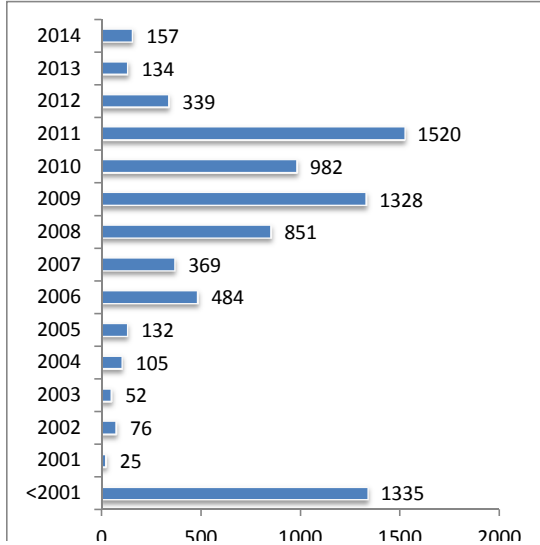
