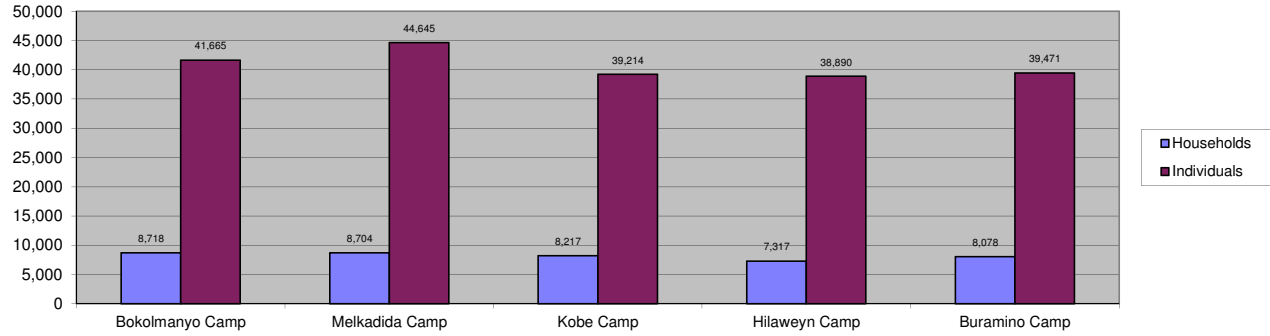

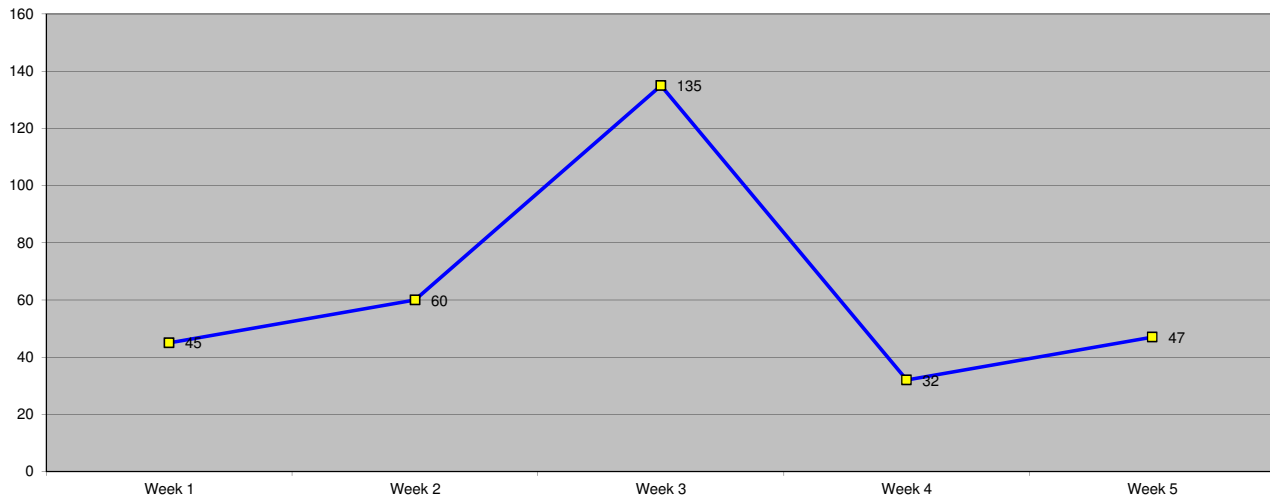
**Figure 1.1 - Total Refugee Population in Dollo Ado**

**Figure 1.2 - New Arrivals at Reception Centre by Week during the Current Month**

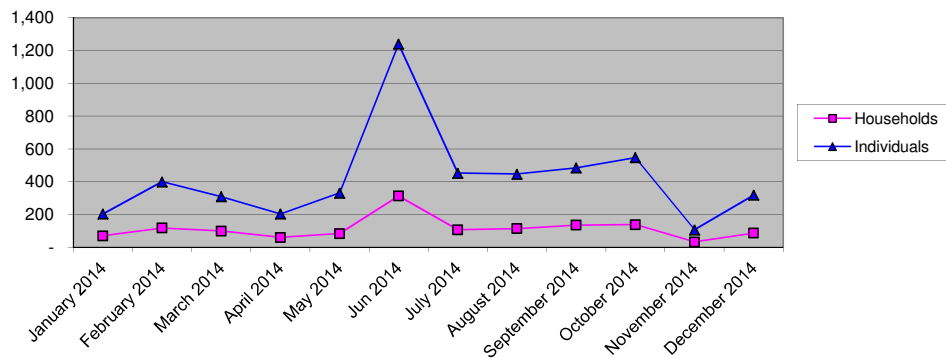

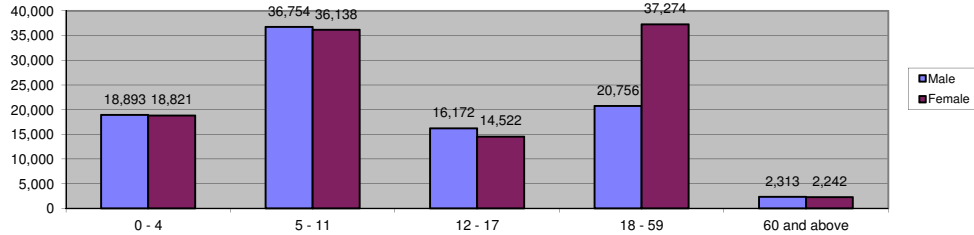

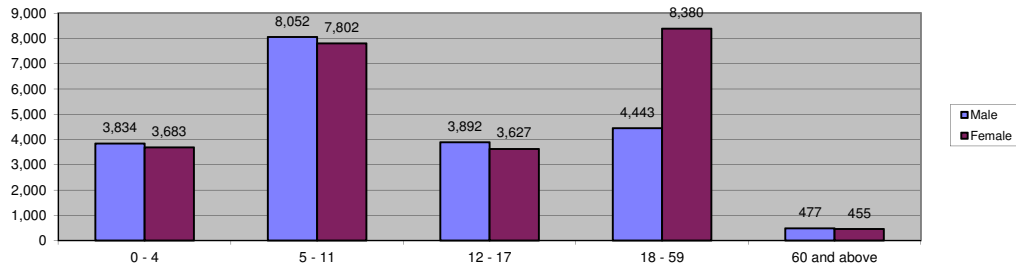
**Figure 2.1 - ALL CAMPS Demographic Breakdown\***

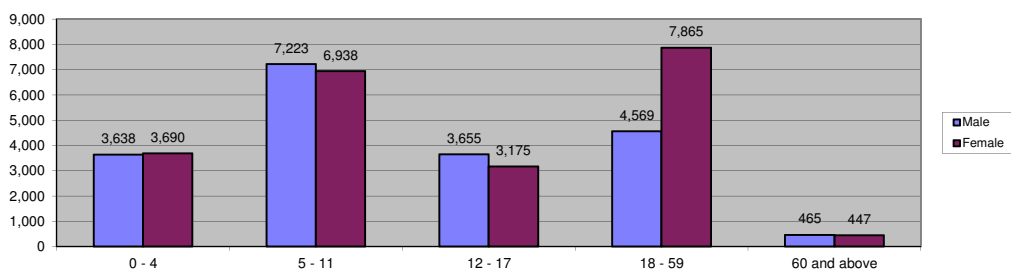
**Figure 2.2 - Melkadida Camp Demographic Breakdown**

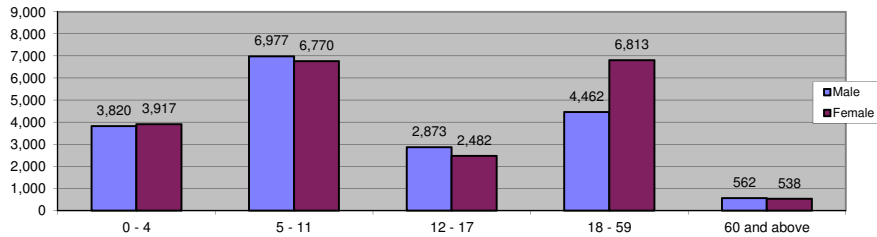

**Figure 2.3 - Bokolmany Camp Demographic Breakdown**



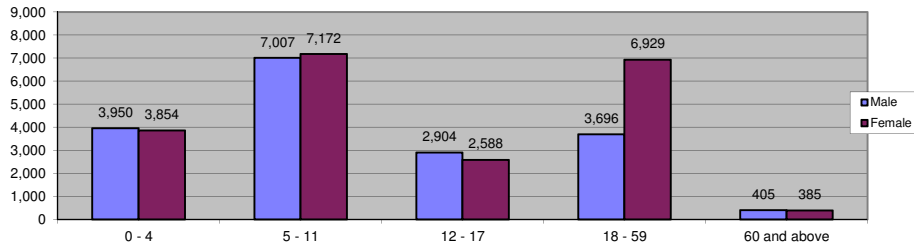

Figure 2.4 - Kobe Camp Demographic Breakdown



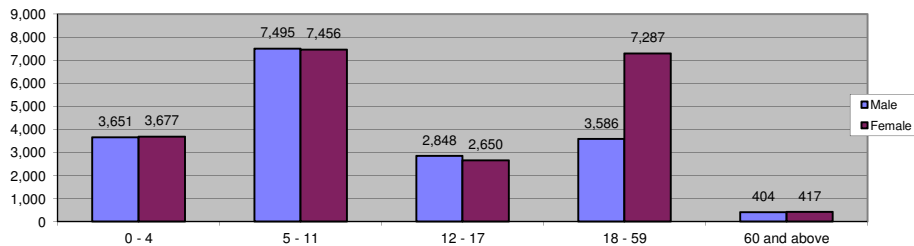

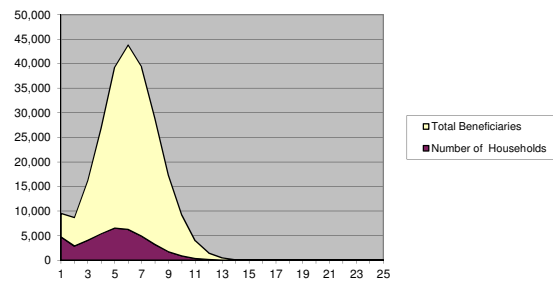

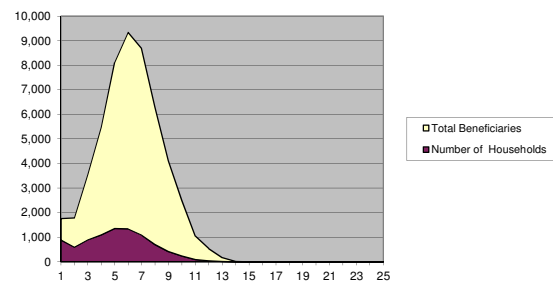

Figure 4.1- ALL CAMPS Household Size



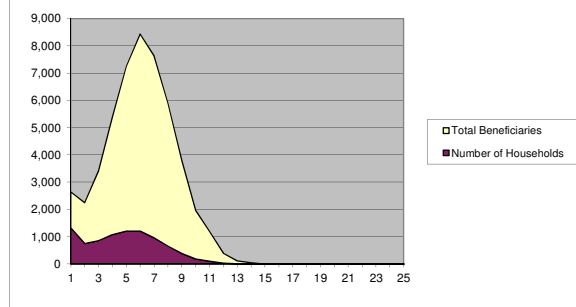

Figure 4.2- Melkadida Camp Household Size



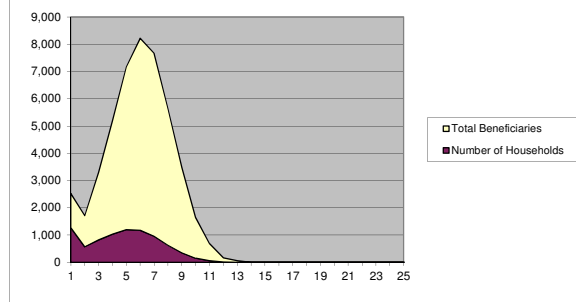

Figure 4.3- Bokolmanyo Camp Household Size



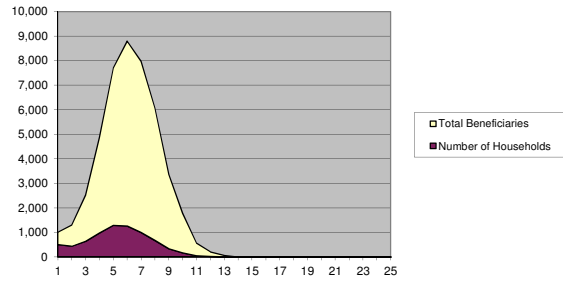

Figure 4.4- Kobe Camp Household Size



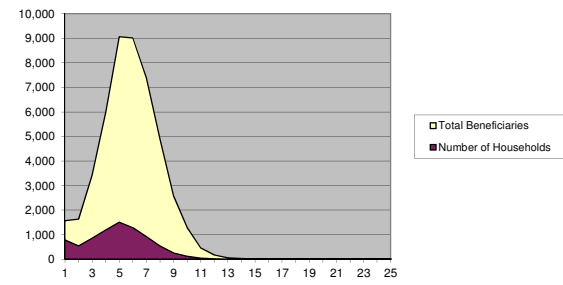

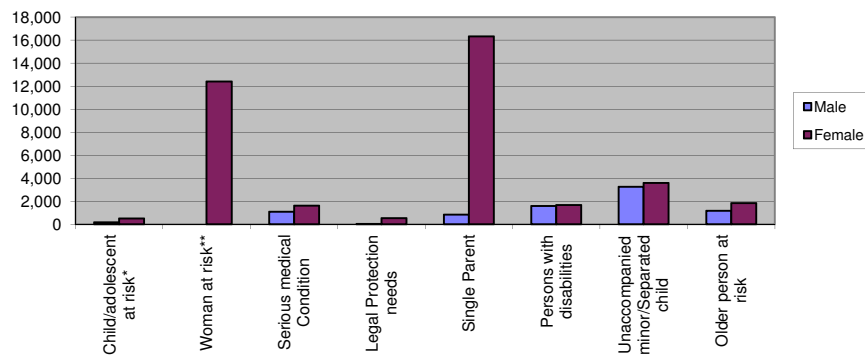

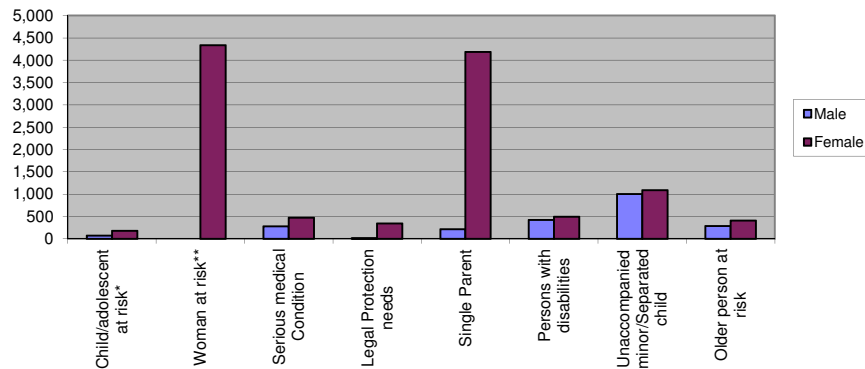
**Figure 5.1 - ALL CAMPS Specific Needs**

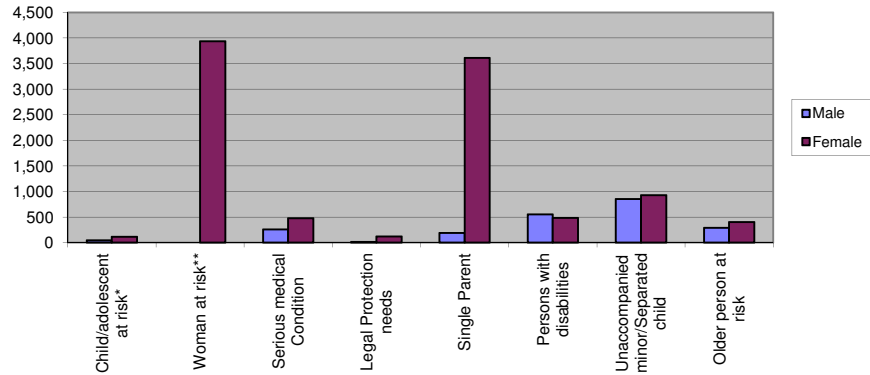

**Figure 5.2 - Melkadida Camp Specific Needs**



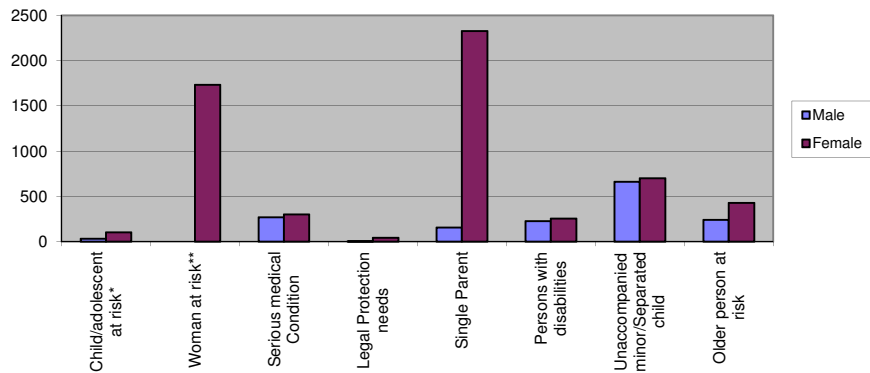

Figure 5.3 - Bokolmanyo Camp Specific Needs



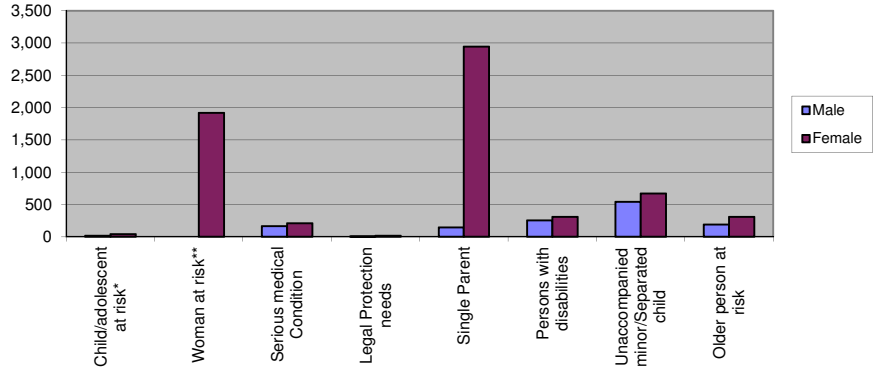

Figure 5.5 - Kobe Camp Specific Needs



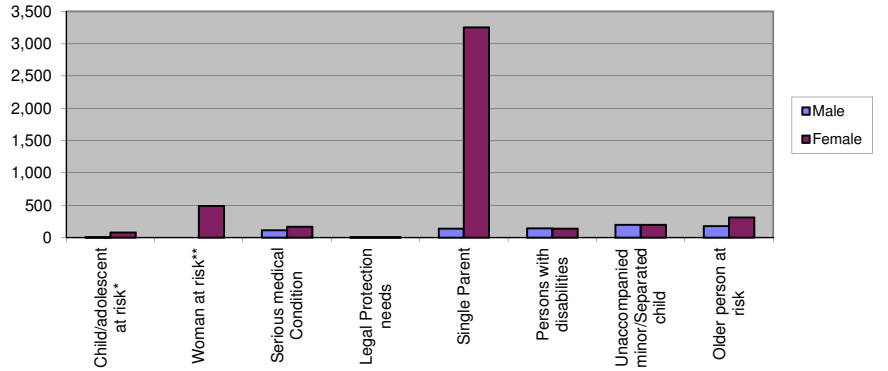

Figure 7.1 - ALL CAMPS Places of Origin

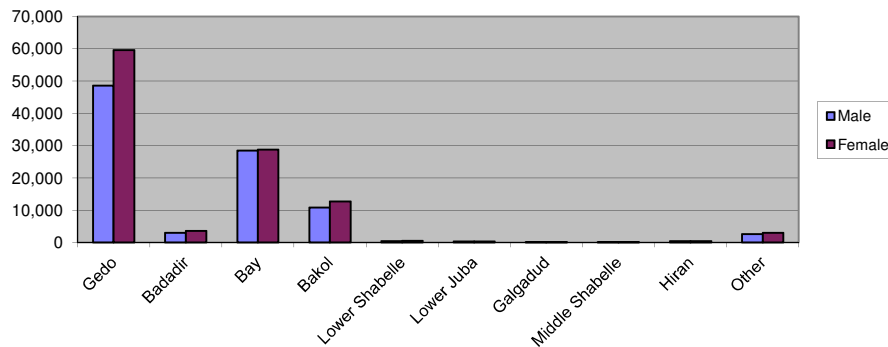
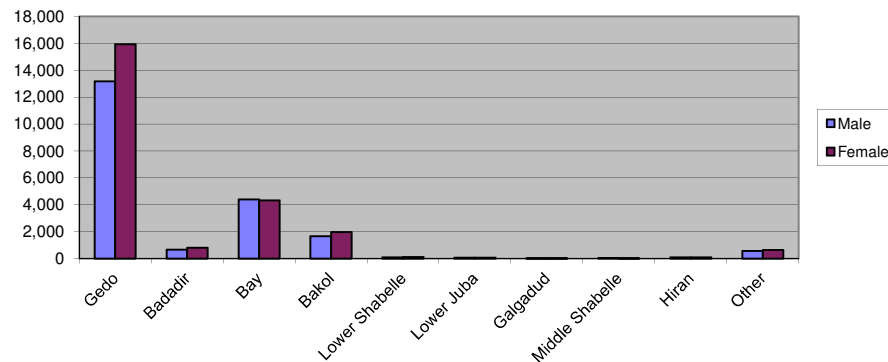

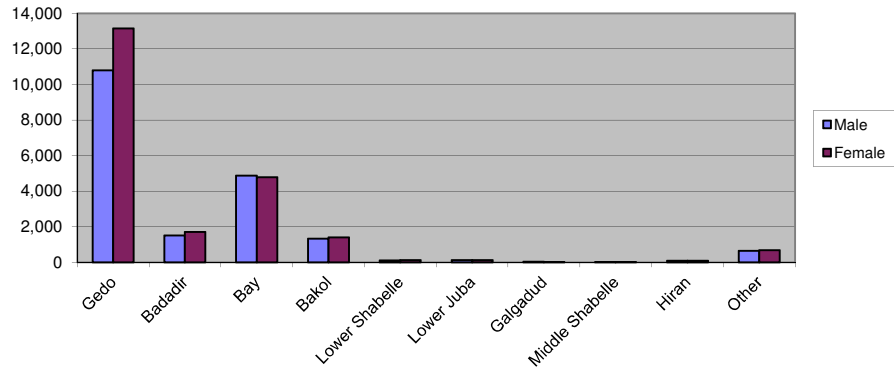

Figure 7.5 - Kobe Camp Places of Origin

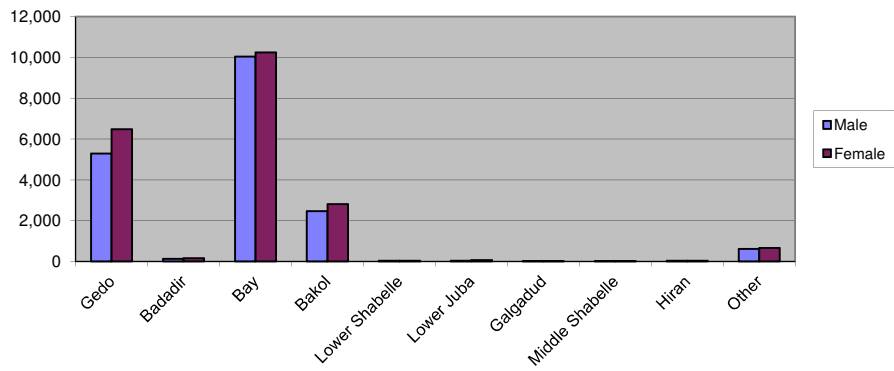

Figure 7.6 - Hilaweyn Camp Places of Origin

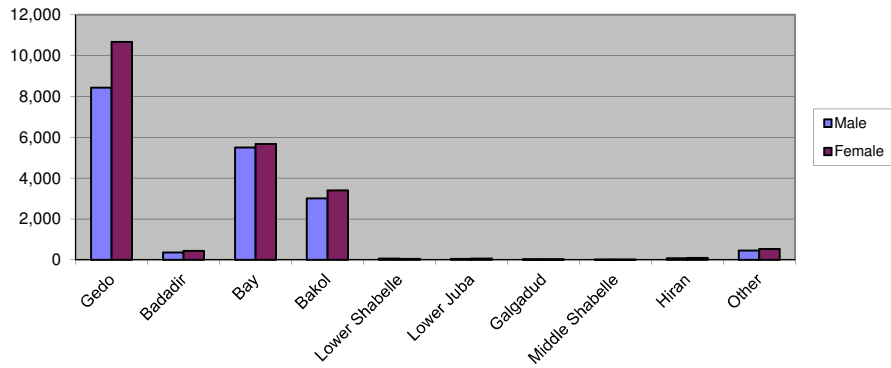
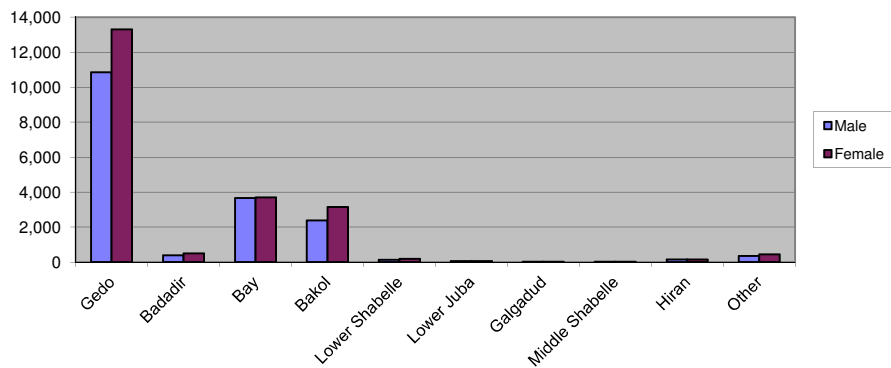

Figure 7.7 - Buramino Camp Places of Origin



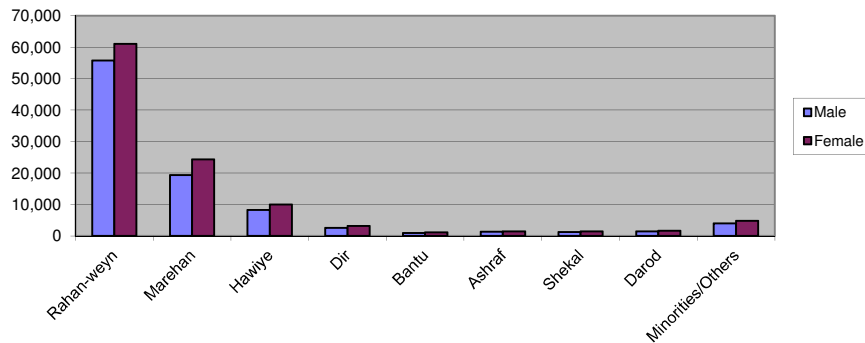

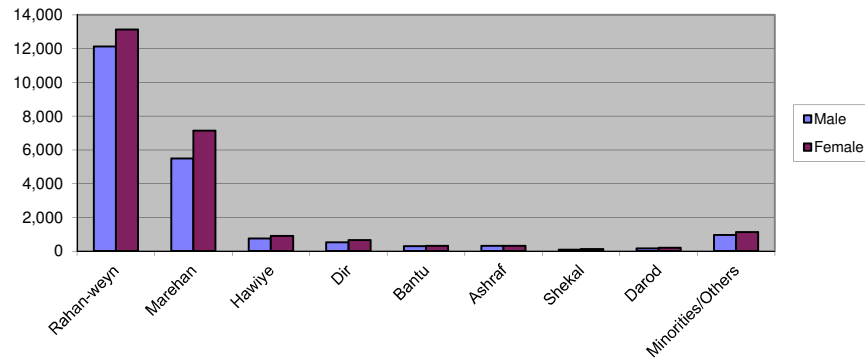
**Figure 6.1 - ALL CAMPS Ethnic Breakdown**

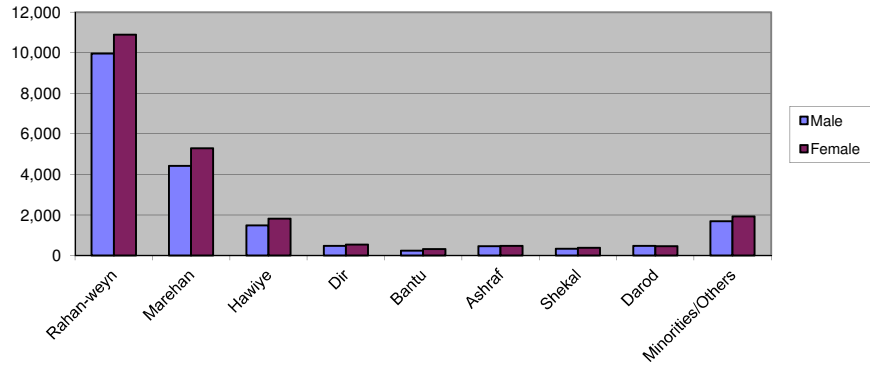

**Figure 6.2 - Melkadida Camp Ethnic Breakdown**



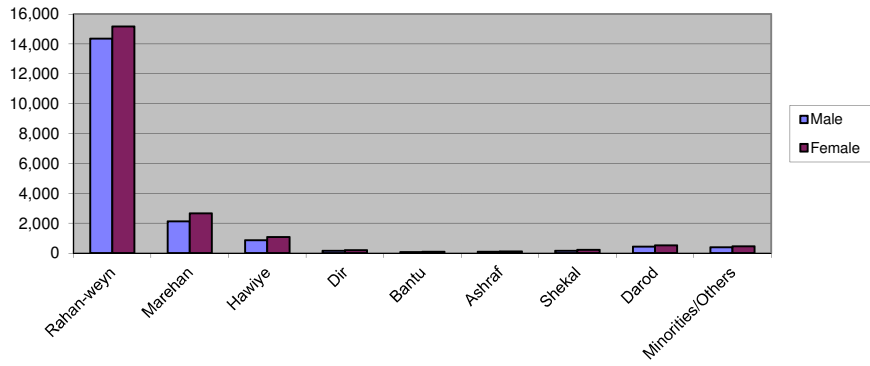

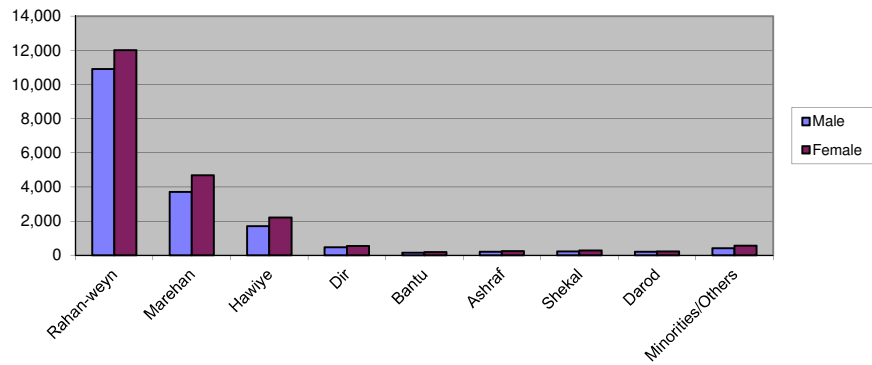
Figure 6.5 - Kobe Camp Ethnic Breakdown
