ISSUE



627,000 Registered Syrian Refugees currently in Jordan (Mar 2015)



Of the approximately 220,000 school aged Syrian refugee children:

- 129,354 children enrolled in formal public schools (2014/15 school year) including 1,500 in KG
- 30,000 children accessing various forms of alternative education
- Over 60,000 children either have no access to learning out of which an estimated 15,000 are on waiting lists
- Lack of opportunities for adolescents and youth
- Persisting PSS needs (also within Jordanian communities)

WHAT IS MAKANI?



Services and activities for children and adolescents

- IT IS A COMPREHENSIVE APPROACH TO CP EDU AND YOUTH FOR ALL VULNERABLE CHILDREN
- IT IS CENTER BASED WITH COMMUNITY OUTREACH
- IT HAS COMMON CONSISTENT STANDARDS
- USE EXISTING CP-EDU-YOUTH CENTRES TO MAXIMIZE OUTREACH
- IT LOOKS AT MAINSTREAMED SOCIAL COHESION
- PROVISION OF ONE PACKAGE (3 ELEMENTS):
 PSS/REFERRALS+ALTERNATIVE EDU (informal + non formal) + LIFE
 SKILLS

WHY MAKANI?



1. TO RECOGNIZE THAT CHILDREN HAVE MULTIPLE NEEDS AND TO OFFER TO OFFER A COMPREHENSIVE SET OF SERVICES IN ORDER FOR THEM TO REACH THEIR FULL POTENTIAL

2. TO MAXIMIZE COVERAGE THROUGH EXISTING 200+ CENTERS

3. TO ENSURE COST EFFECTIVE INTERVENTIONS

OUR COMMON TARGETS



- 1. 203,000 children reached with PSS
- 2. 16,000 children reached by CP-GBV case management
- 3. 90,000 children reached with alternative education
- 4. 58,000 10-24 years old completing life skills training

- APPLY THE THREE COMPONENTS (PSS/Referrals; alternative education and Life skills/civic engagement)
- APPLY COMMONLY AGREED STANDARDS ON:
 - INFRASTRUCTURE
 - COMMUNITY OUTREACH
 - PSS-referrals (incl. staffing)
 - ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION (incl. staffing)
 - LIFE SKILLS (incl. staffing)
