



#### **UAC** shelters

- Current: 49 UAC shelters with total **1,101** places

#### Safe zones\* (short-term)

- Current: 10 Safe Zones for UAC with total 300 places

#### Hotels\*\* (emergency)


- Current: 6 Hotels for UAC with total 310 places

Safe Zones are designated supervised spaces within accommodation sites which provide UAC with 24/7 emergency protection and care. They should be used as short term (maximum 3 months) measures to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Safe Zone priority is given to UAC in detention as well as other vulnerable children, in line with their

\*\*Hotels are emergency accommodation spaces being used as a measure to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Priority is given to UAC in Reception and Identification Centers.

Available places by type and region






